

## 2003 Elementary and Middle School AYP Summary

### Background

1. In order to meet the overall AYP, schools are required to meet three major criteria for all student groups and each of the subcategory (that included at least 40 students) for both ELA and Math:
  - (1) Student Attendance Rate (95.3%): for the entire student group only this year
  - (2) Participation Rate (95.0%)
  - (3) Performance Objectives: 17.6% Proficient or higher in ELA; 15.5% in Math
  
2. It is very common that schools need to meet at least 21 objectives to meet the overall AYP status.

### Middle School Level

1. In the middle school level, two schools did not meet the attendance rates; three did not meet the participating requirements, and none of the disabled students and free and reduced meal students met ELA or Math performance objectives.
2. The percentages of meeting the overall AYP objectives ranged from 35% to 81%, and a total of two schools did not meet half of the objectives.
3. A total of seven schools (78%) did not meet ELA performance objective for “All” students while six schools (68%) did not meet Math performance objective.
4. None of the middle schools met the overall AYP status.

### Elementary School Level

1. A total of six schools met the overall AYP status. Of these six schools, four were required to meet 13 objectives.
2. A total of six schools did not meet the attendance rate. All schools met the required participation rate except Satchel Ford, and our office is challenging the SDE on the computation of the participation rate.
3. A total of six schools missed meeting the overall AYP status by only one objective.
5. The percentages of meeting the AYP objectives ranged from 46% to 100%, and a total of four schools did not meet half of the objectives.
6. It was obvious that students who participated in subsidized meals had the most difficulty to meet the performance objectives in both areas.
