

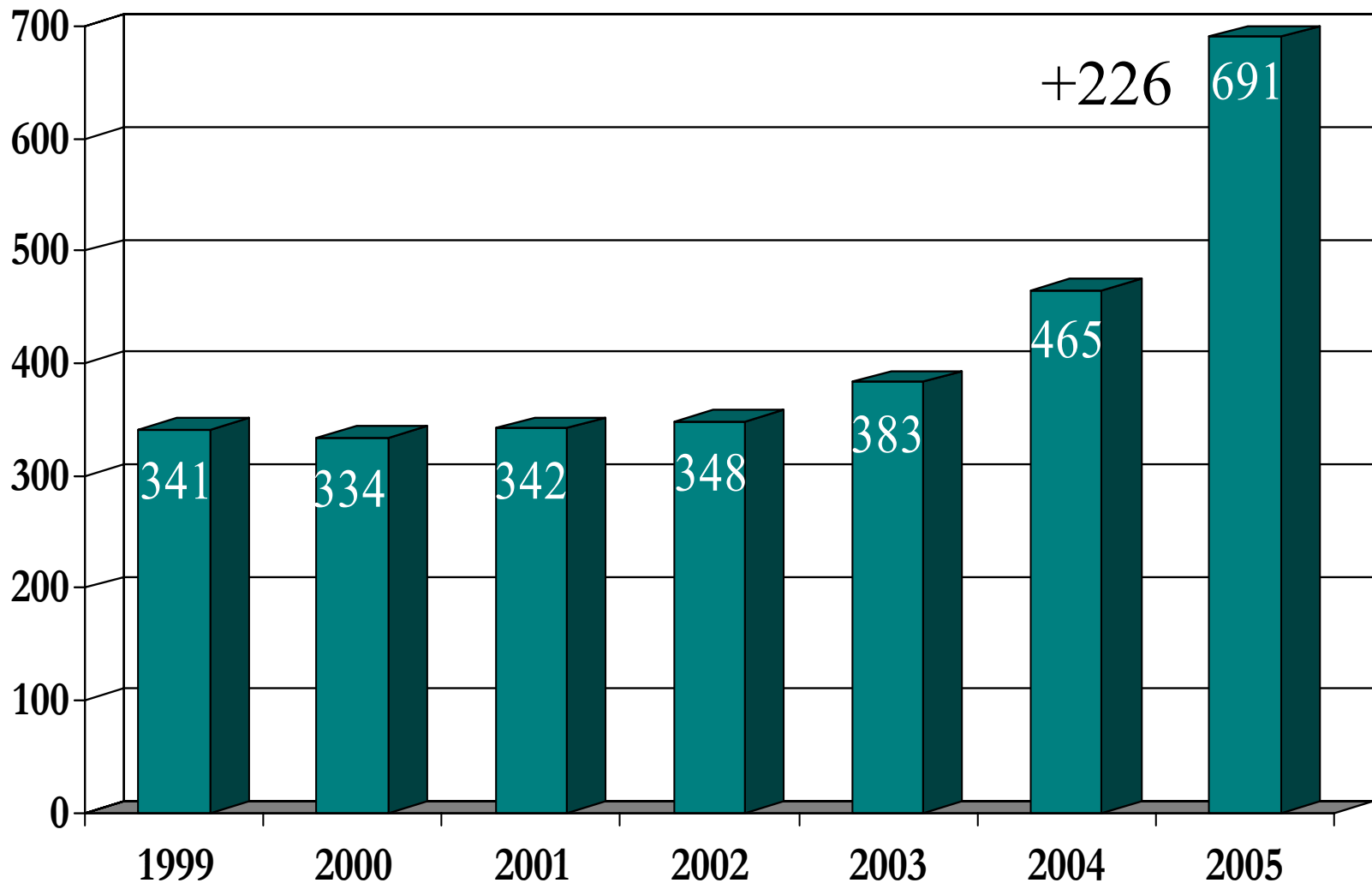

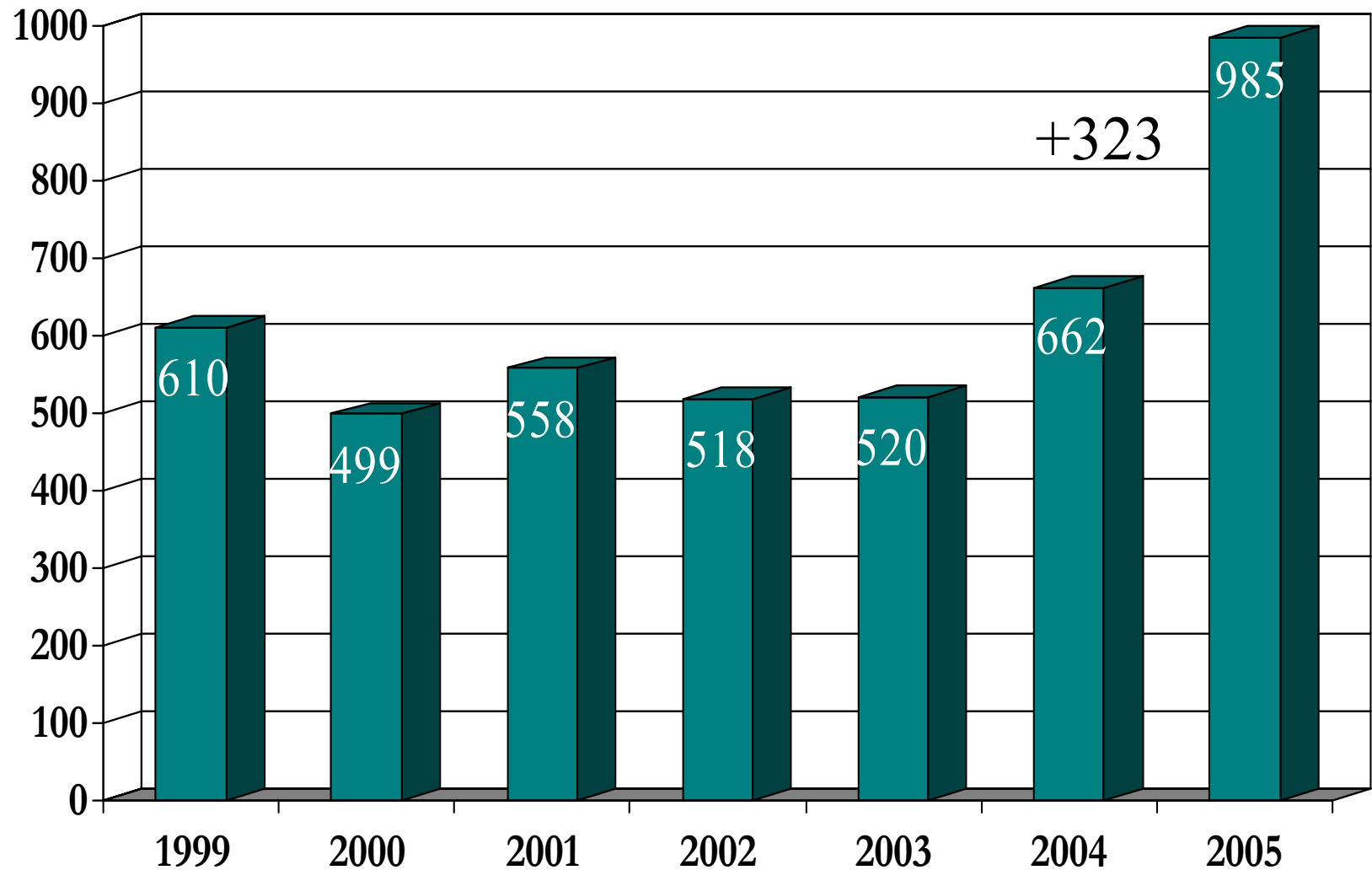

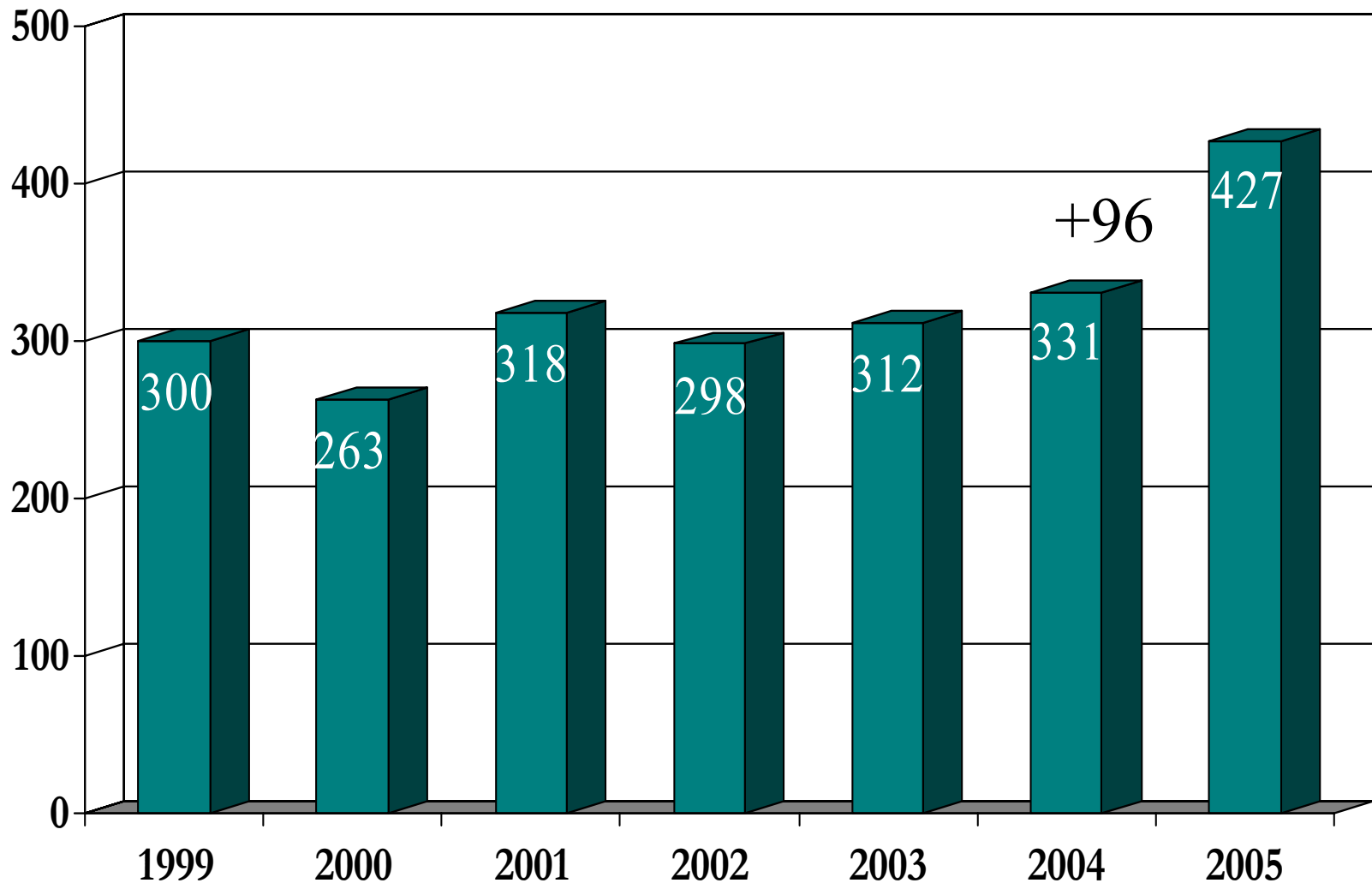
Number of Students Taking One or More AP Exams



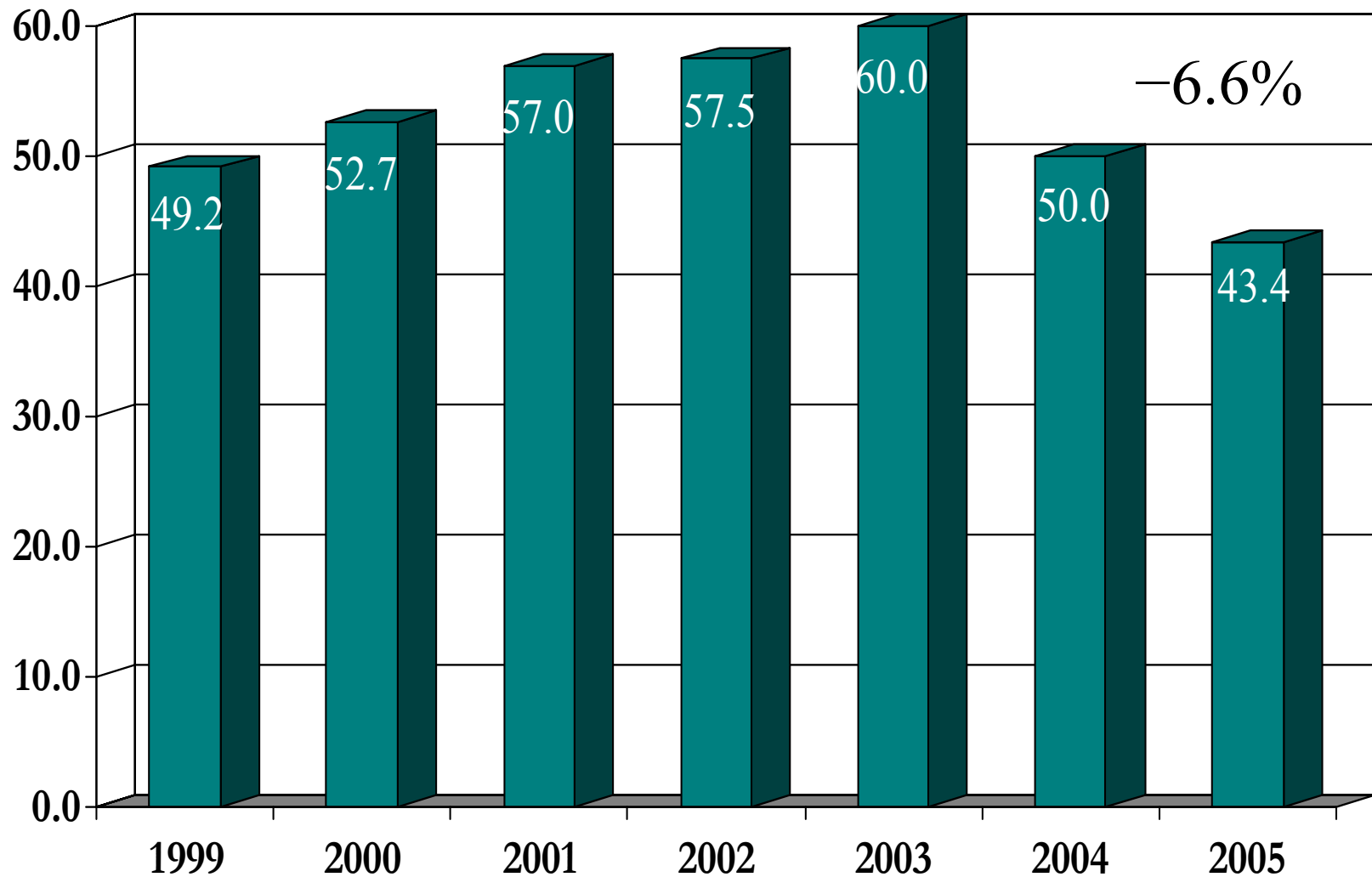
Number of AP Exams Taken

National*	57.6%

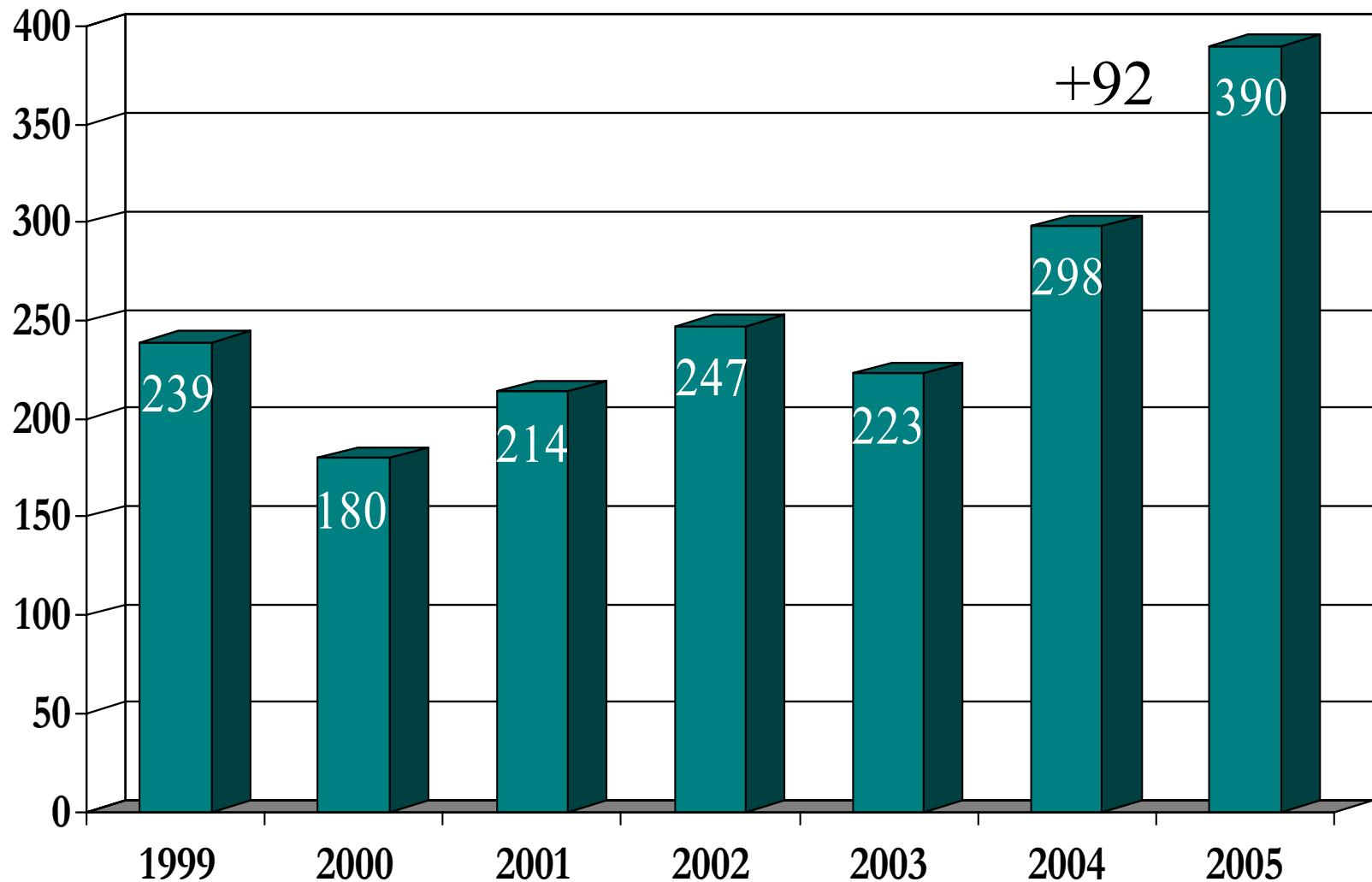

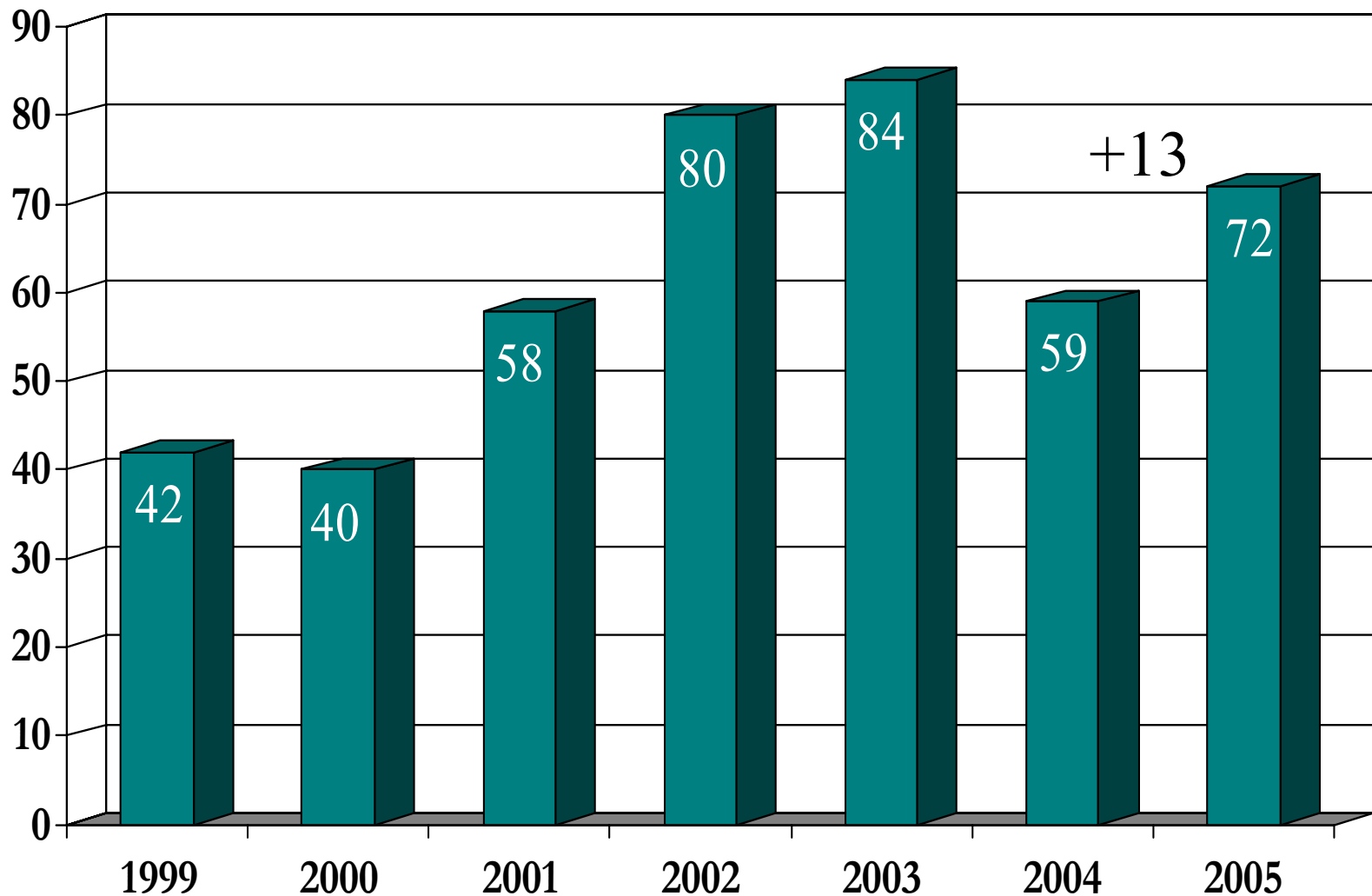

By Race

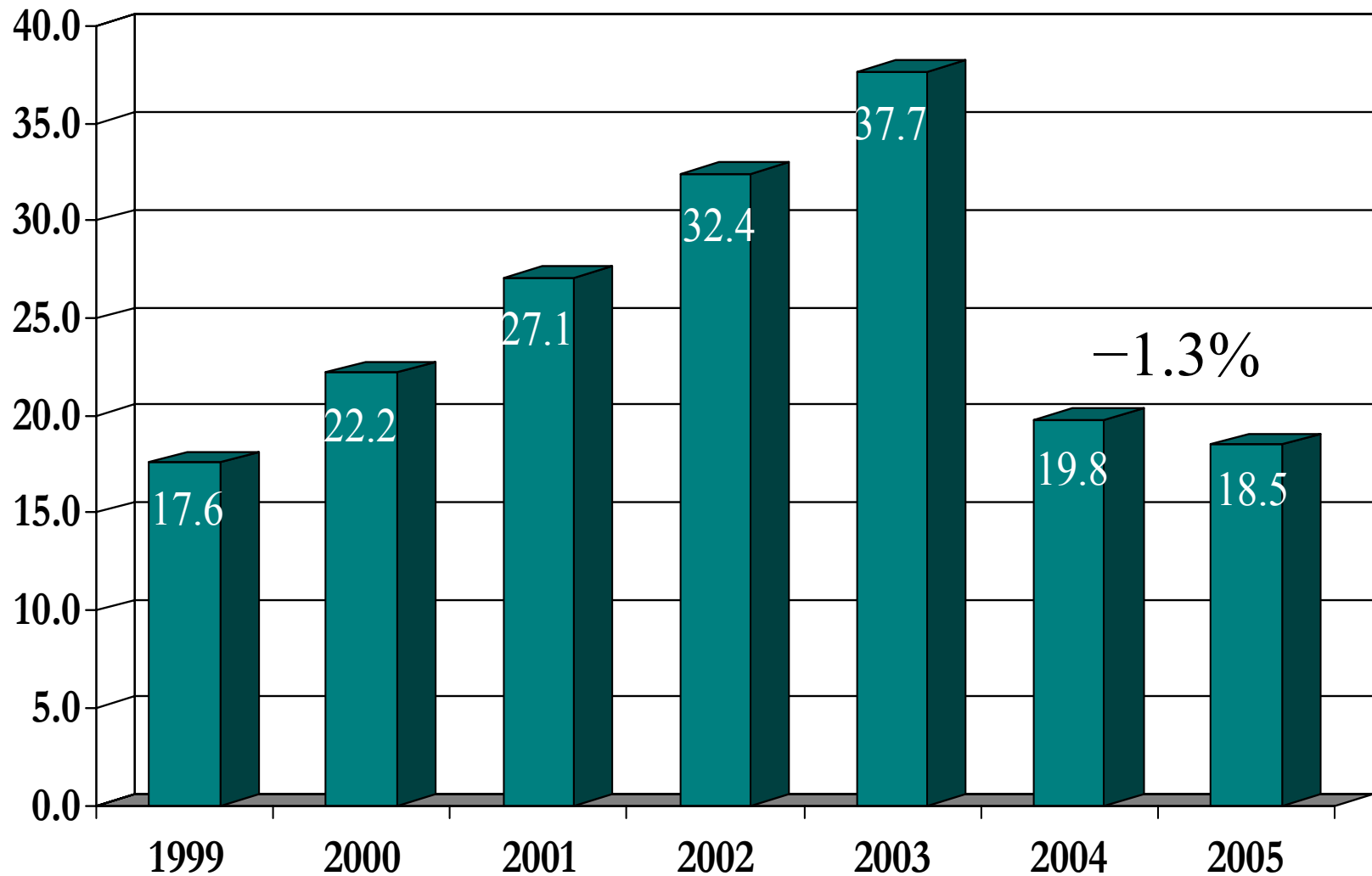
Number of Exams Taken By African-American Students



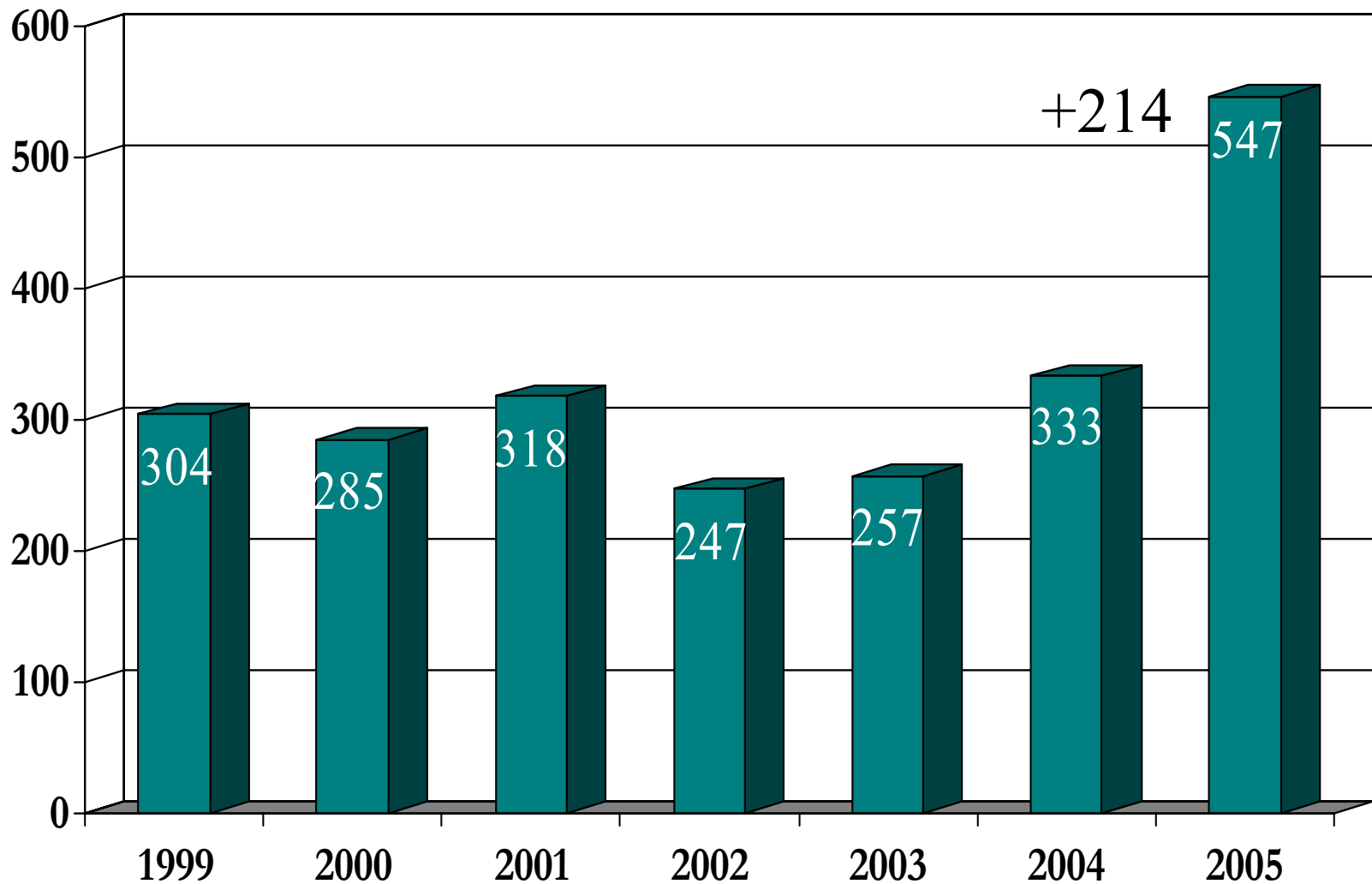
Number of Exams Passed By African-American Students



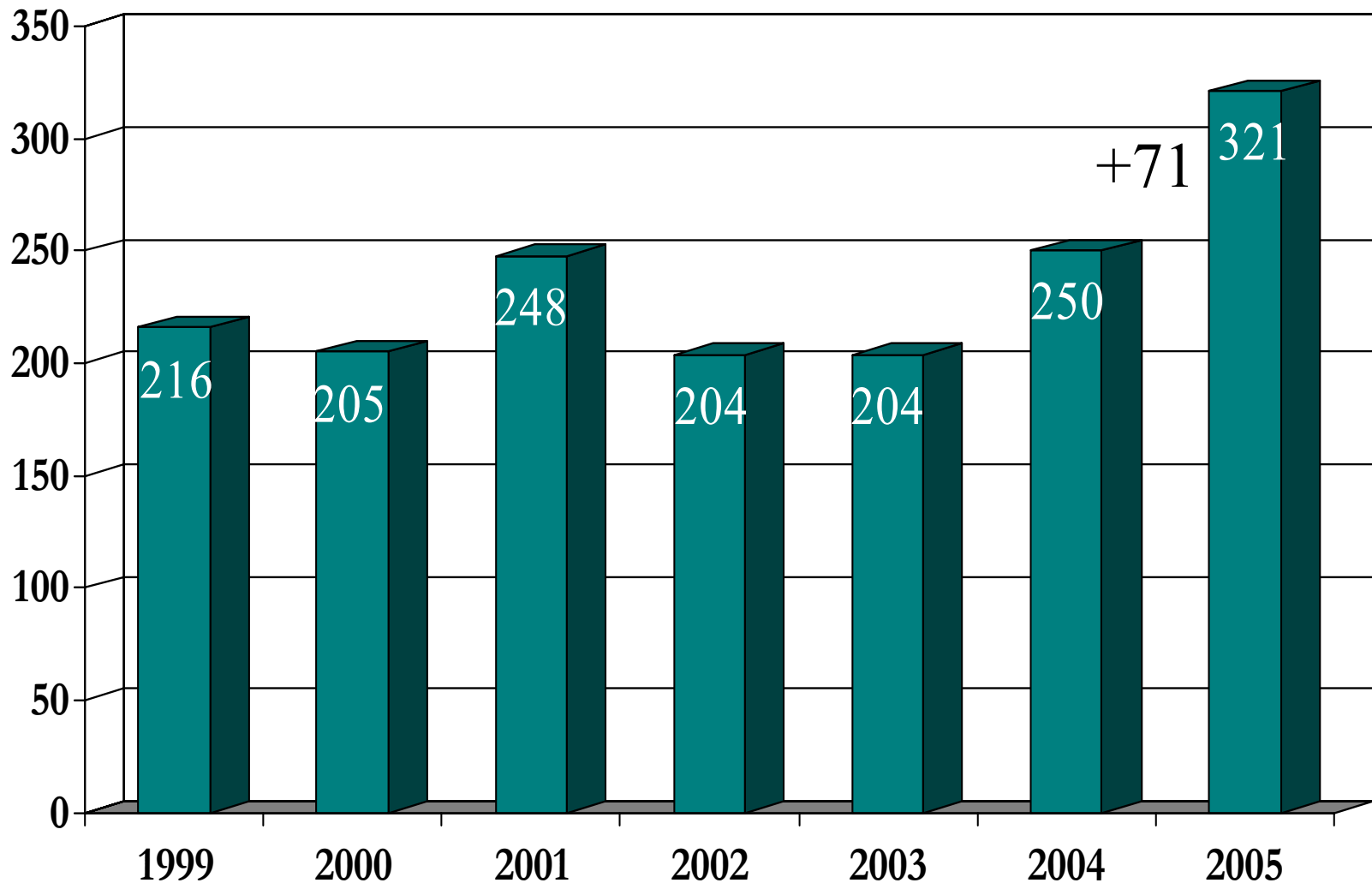
Percent of Exams Passed By African-American Students



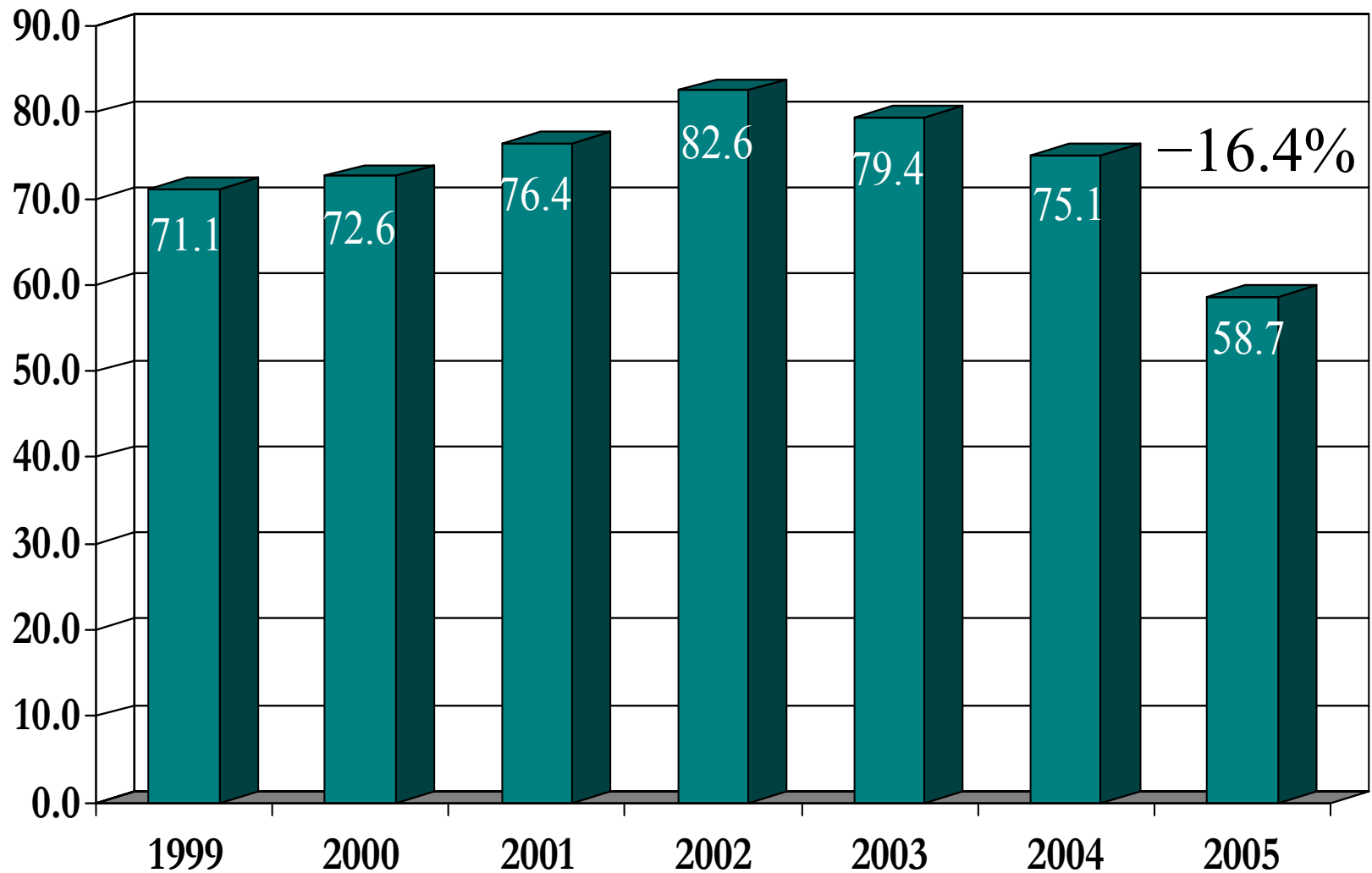
Number of Exams Taken By White Students

Percent of Exams Passed By White Students



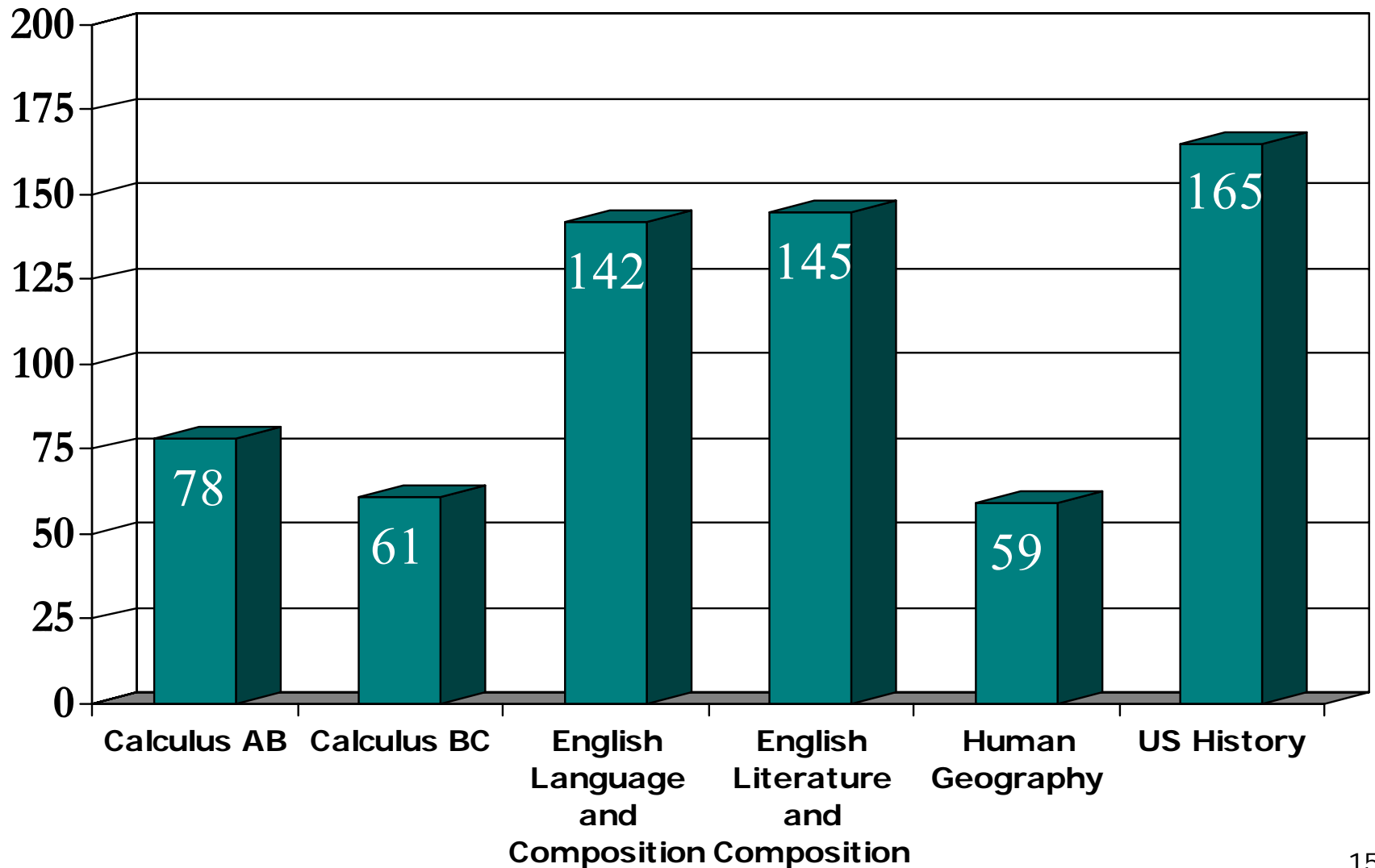

2005 AP Results by Course

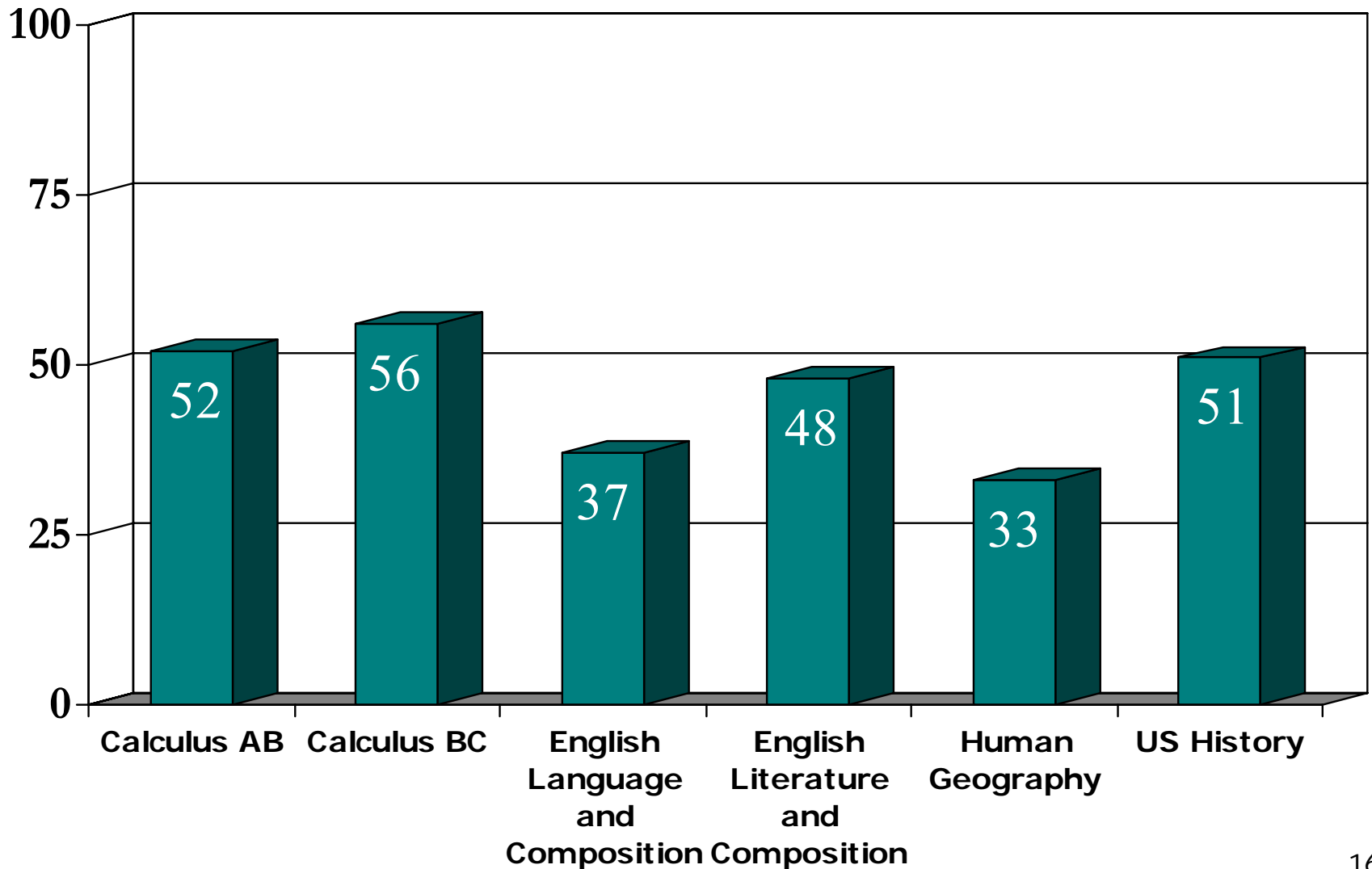
Number of Exams Taken By Course

for 2005 Most Frequent Courses



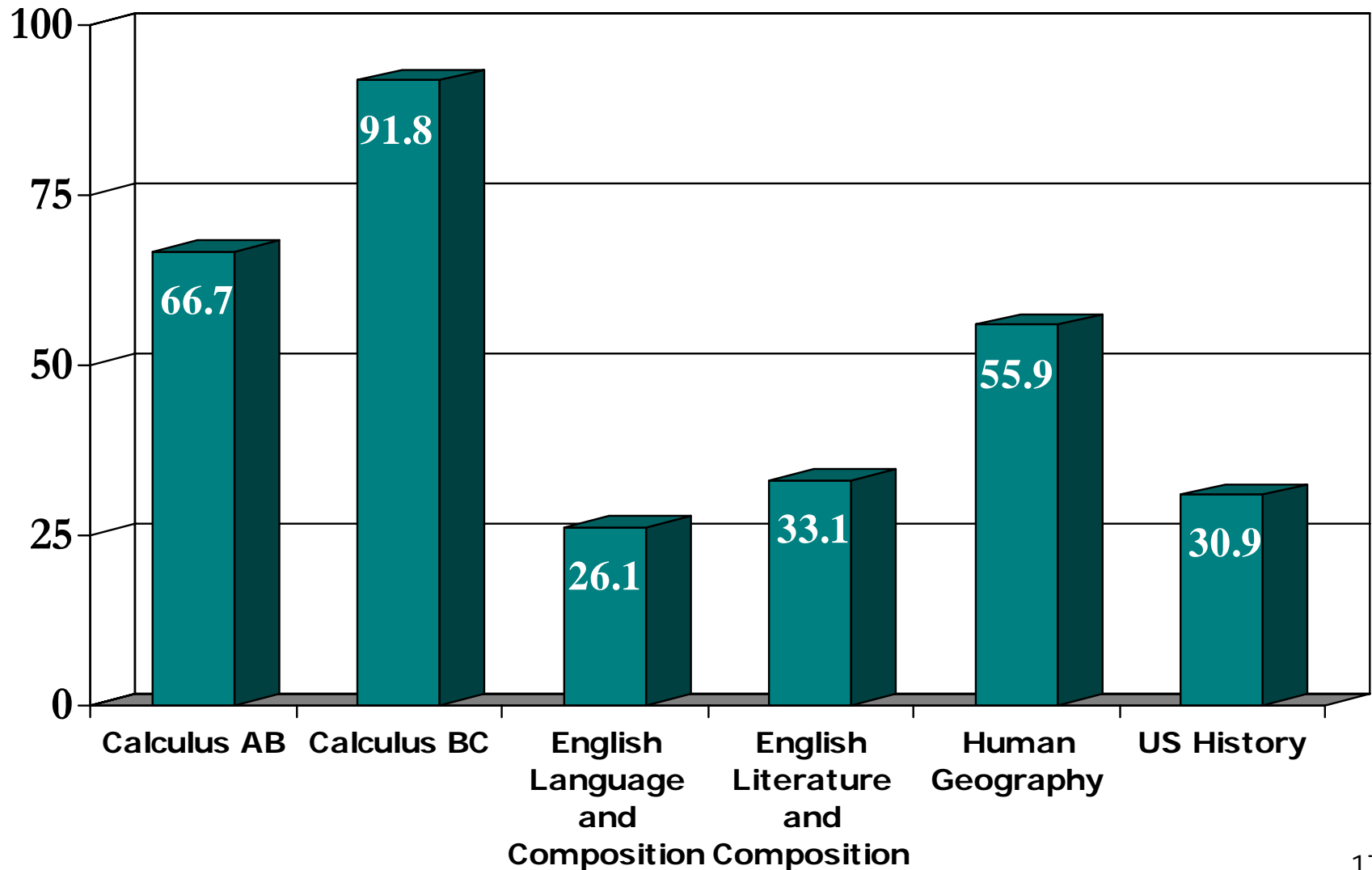
Number of Exams Passed By Course
