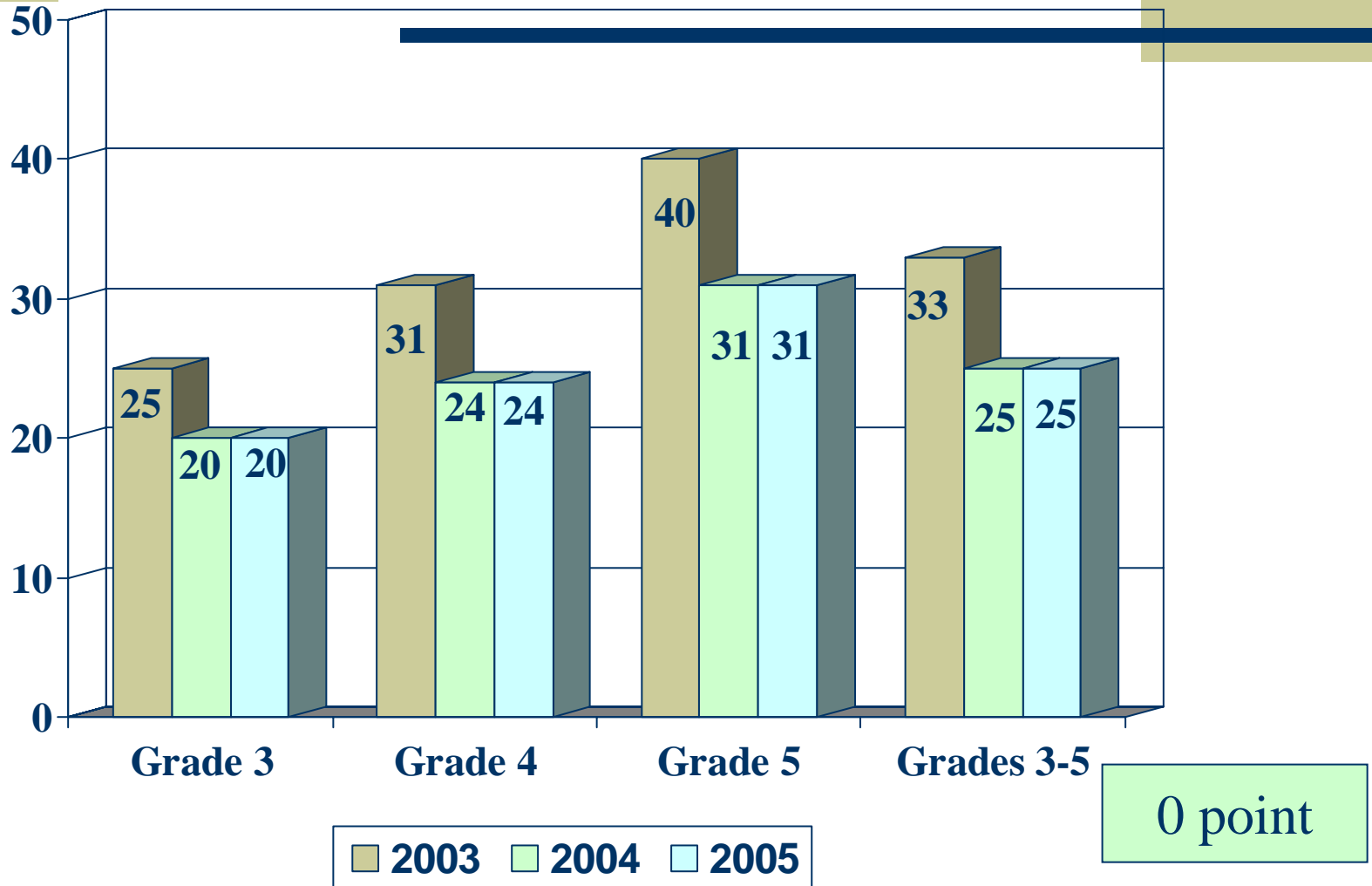




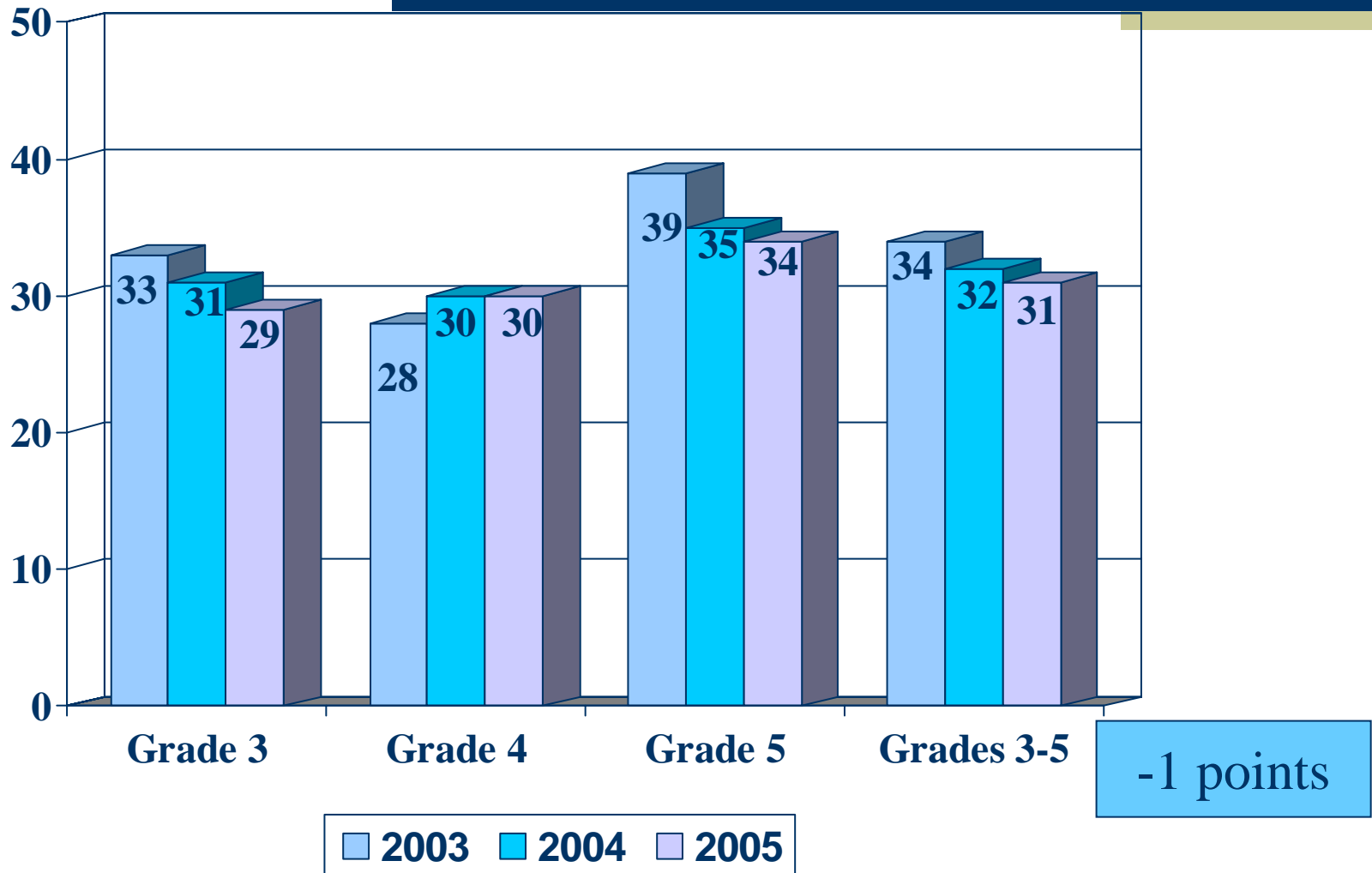
I. Reduction of Percent of Below Basic Students

- ◆ comparing 2004 and 2005 data

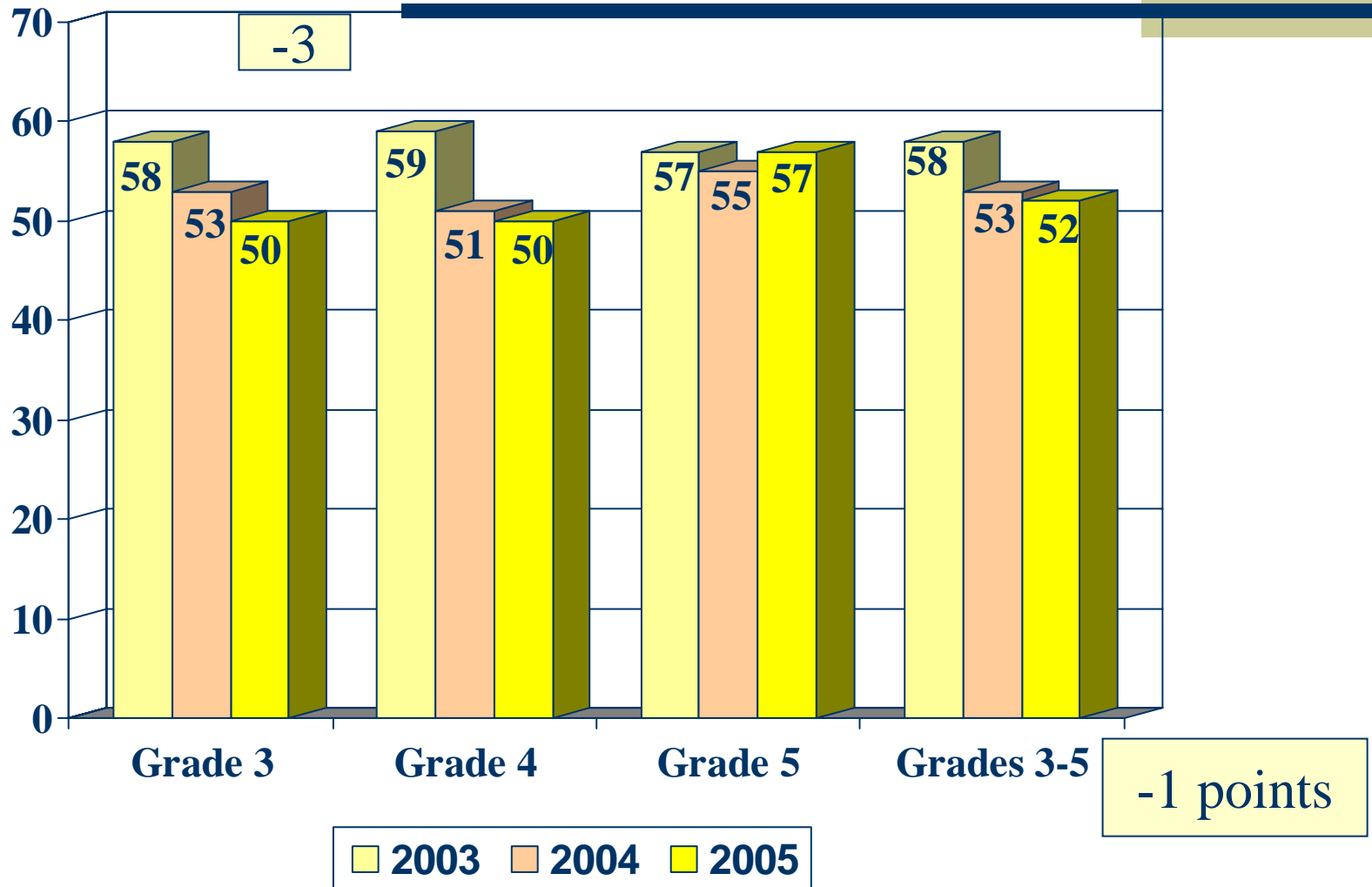
Grades 3-5 PACT English/LA Percent of Below Basic



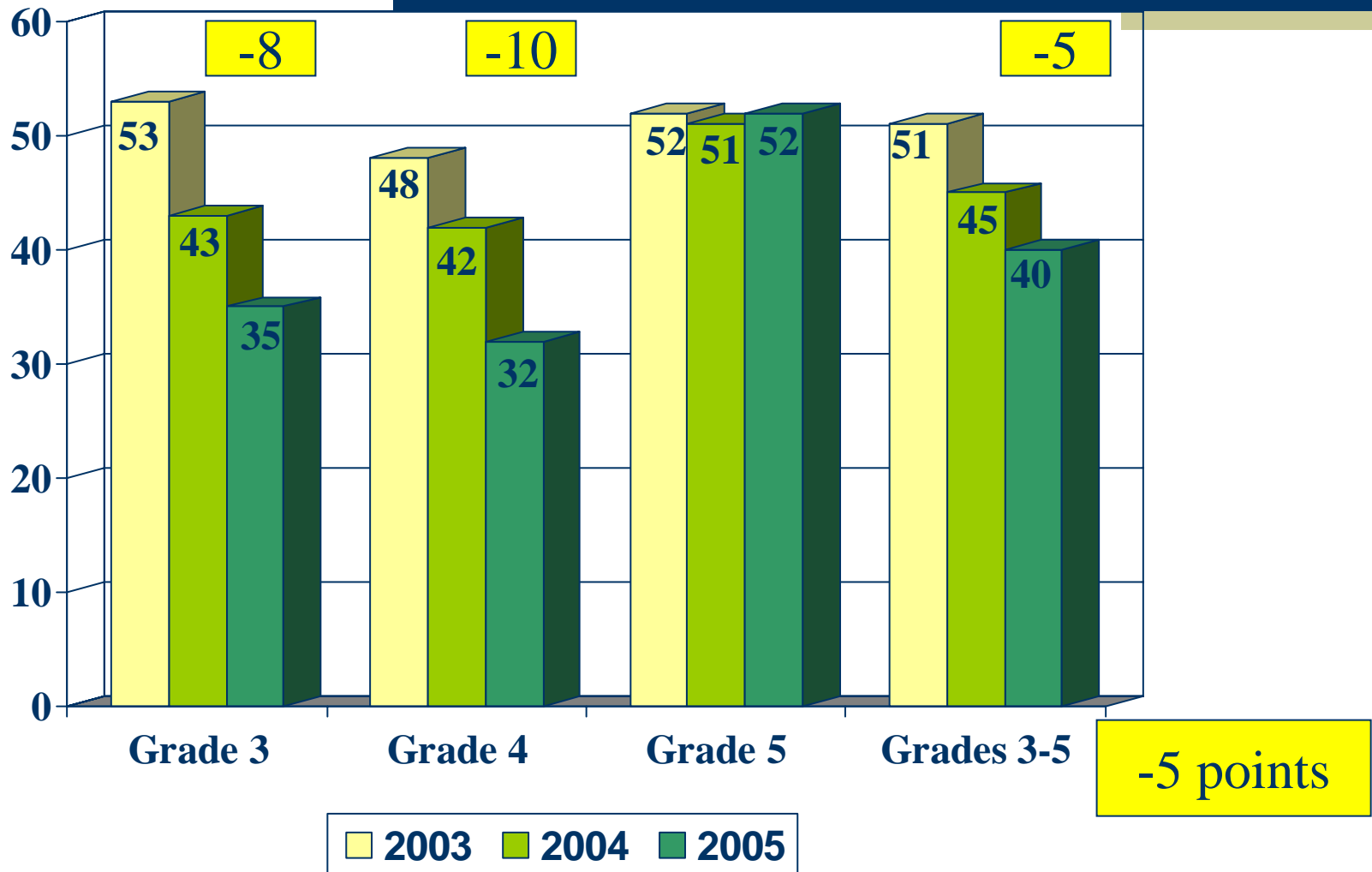
Grades 3-5 PACT Math Percent of Below Basic



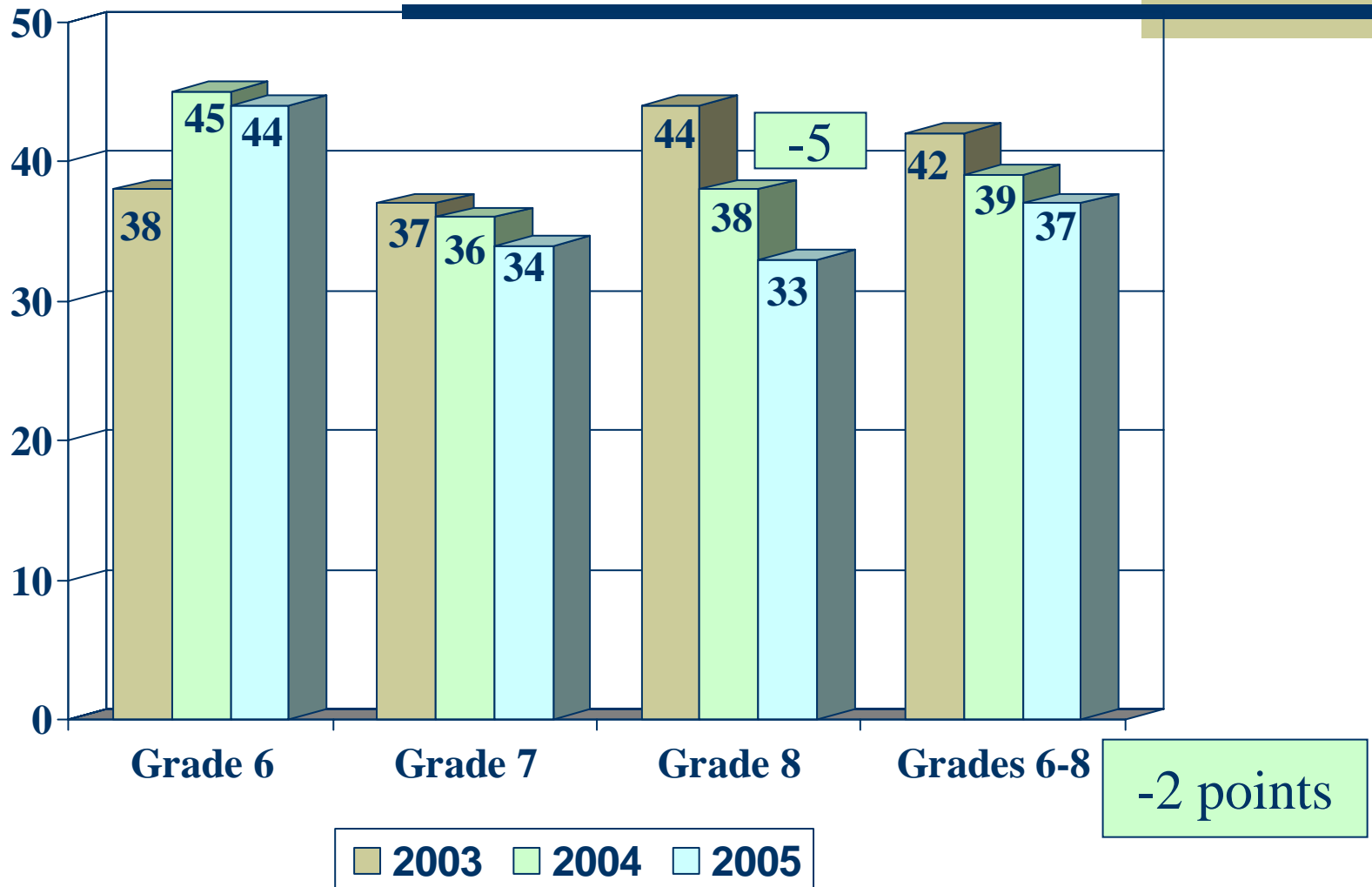
Grades 3-5 PACT Science Percent of Below Basic



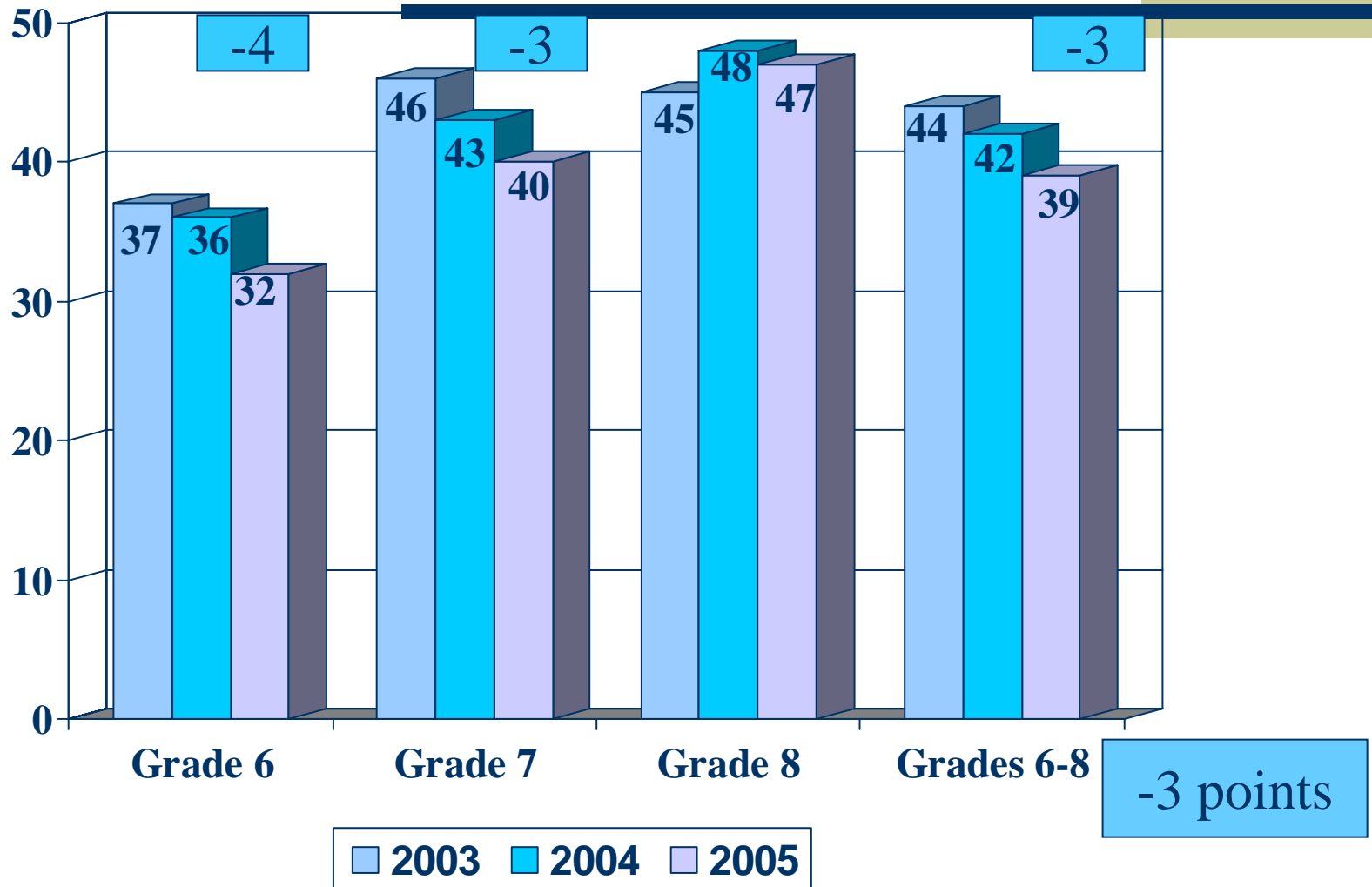
Grades 3-5 PACT Social Studies Percent of Below Basic



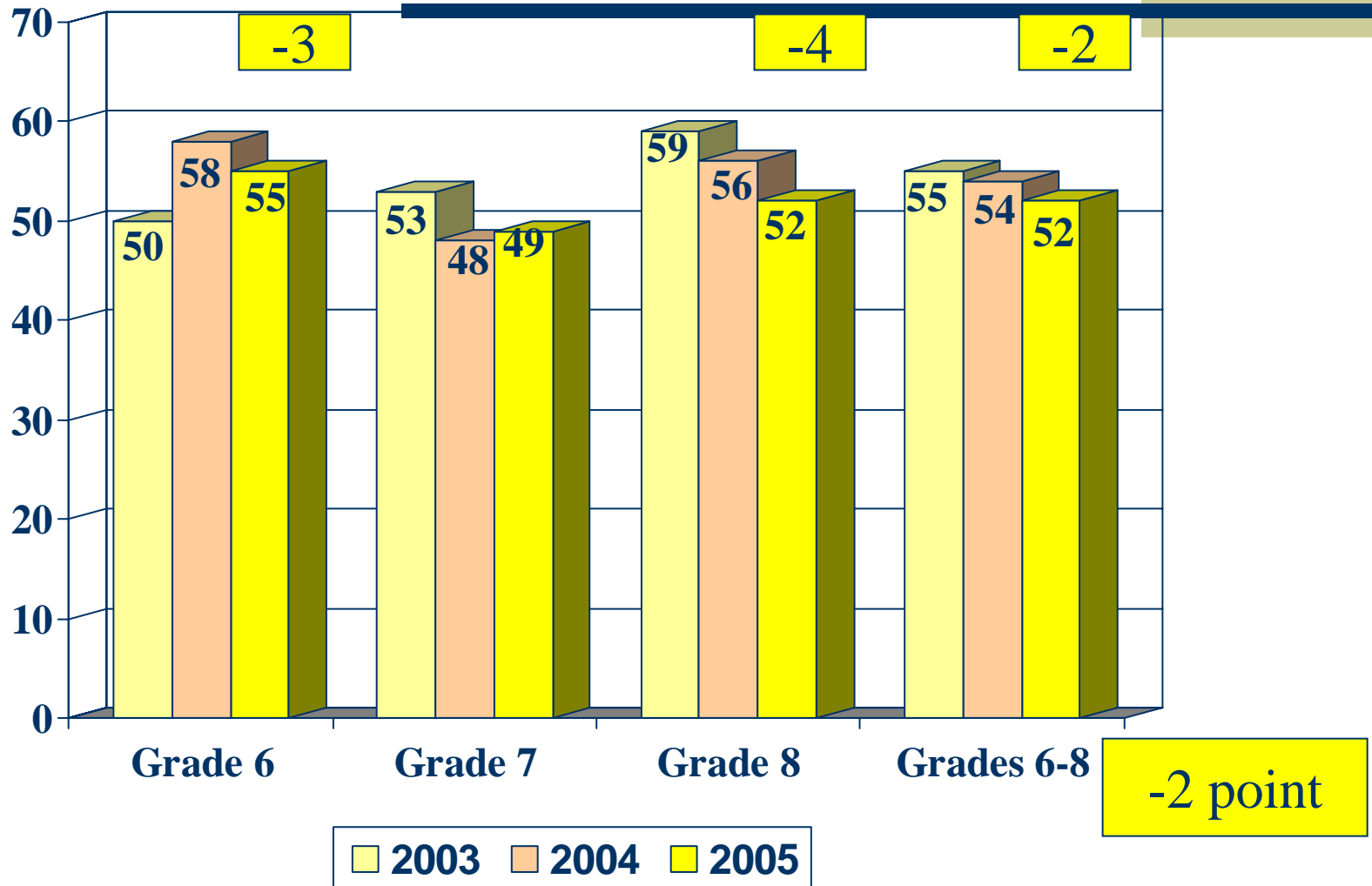
Grades 6-8 PACT English/LA Percent of Below Basic



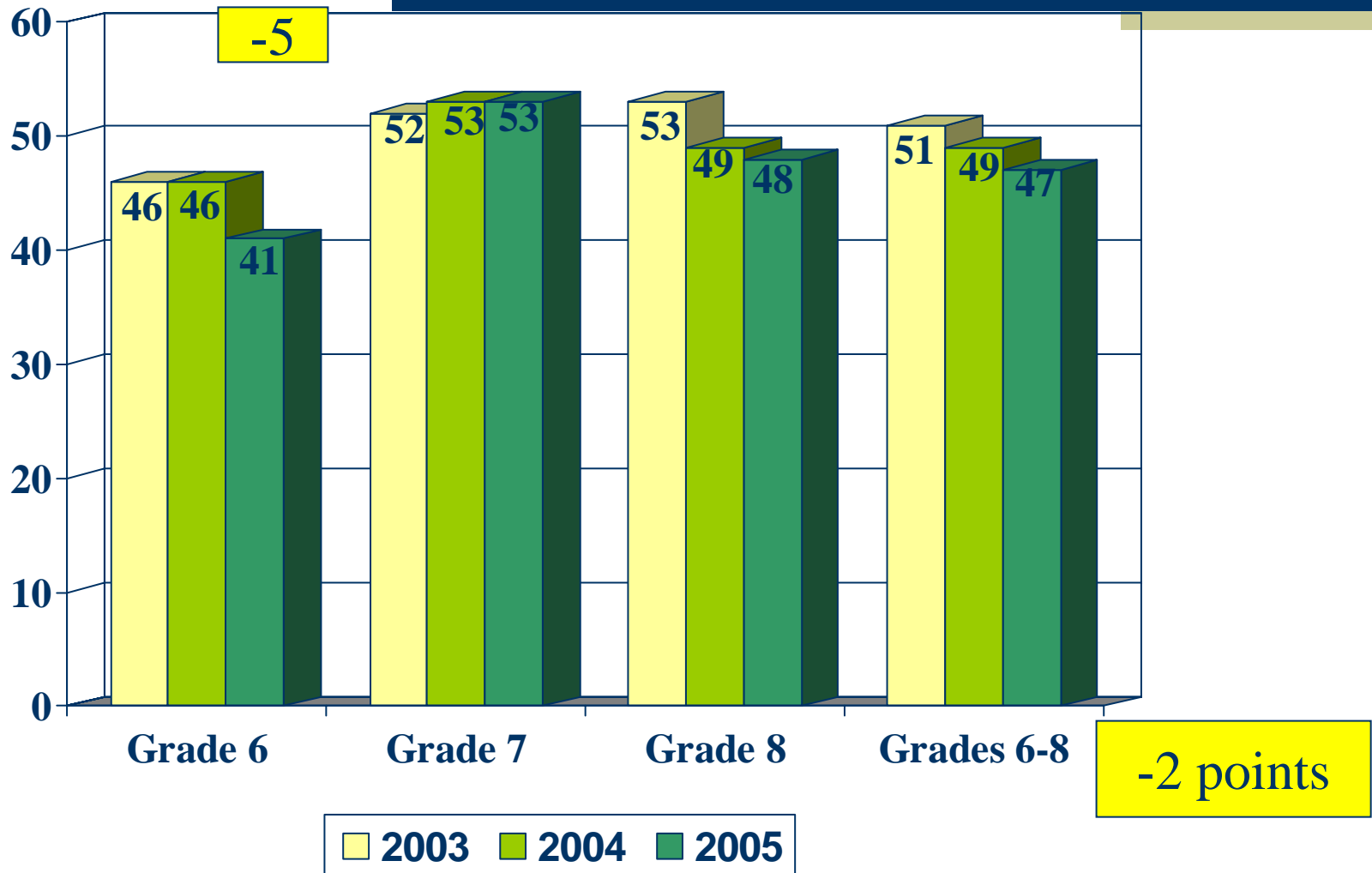
Grades 6-8 PACT Math Percent of Below Basic

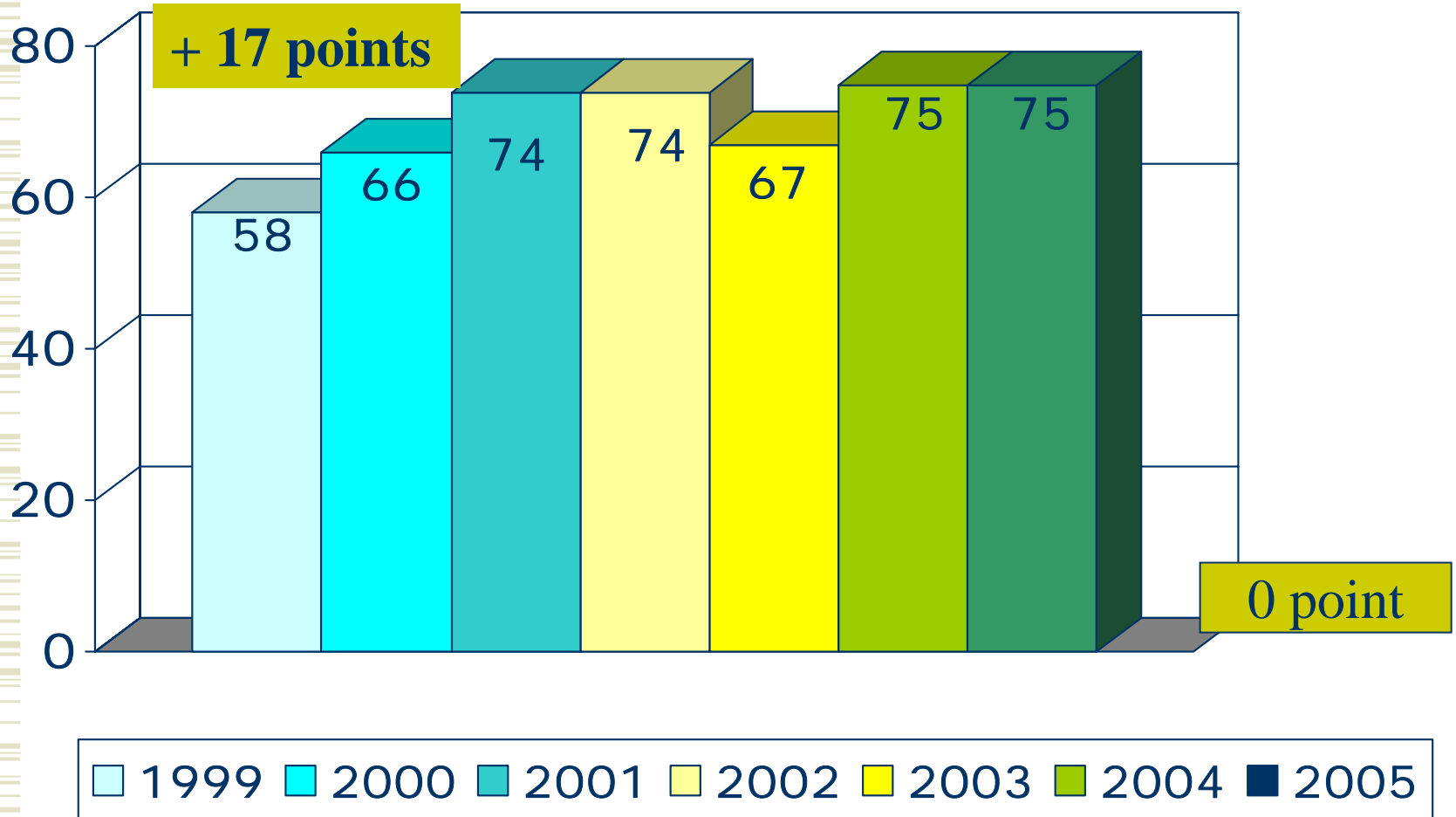

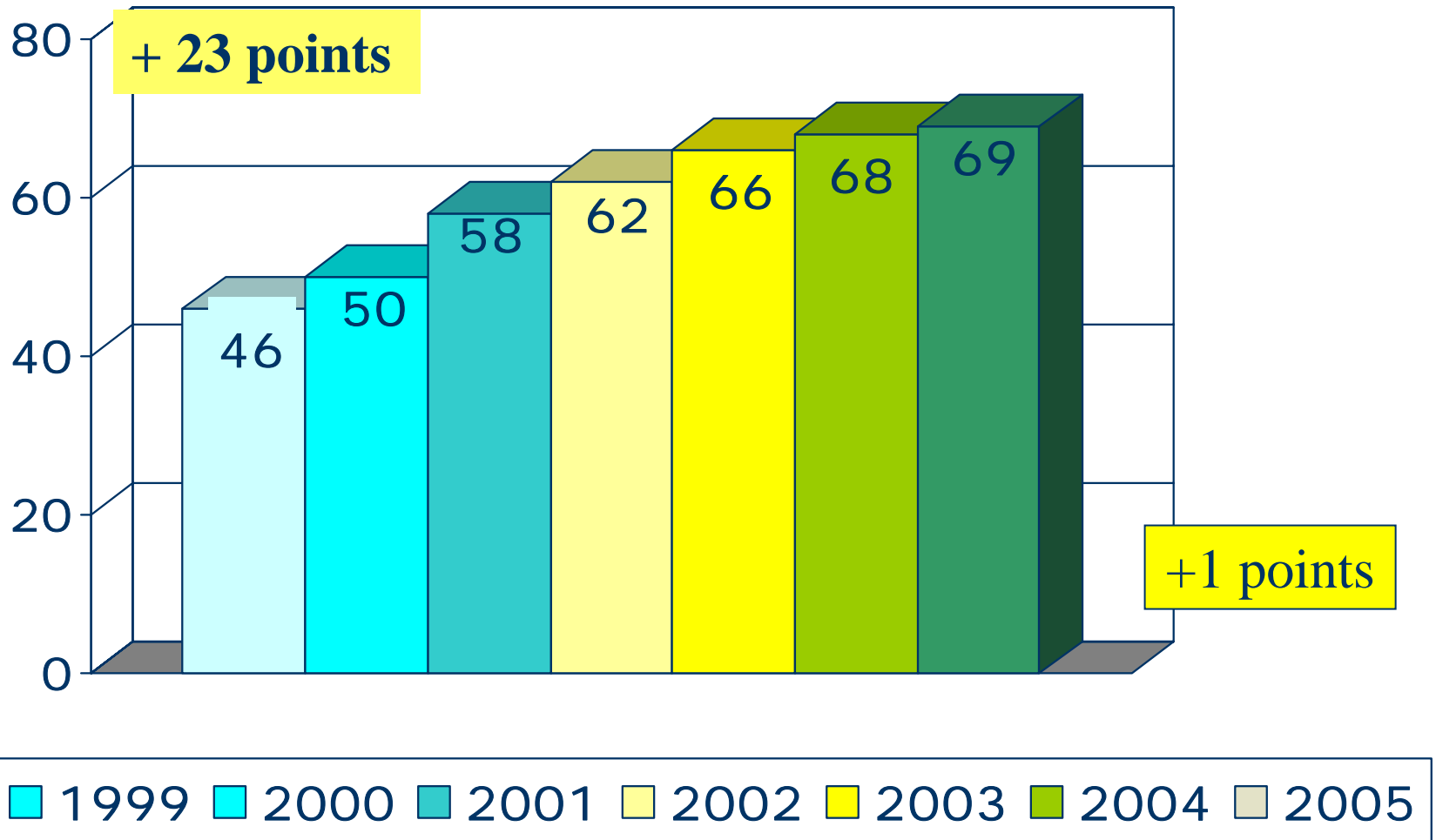
II. Historical Trend of Percent of Basic and Above Students

- ◆ comparing 1999 through 2005 data

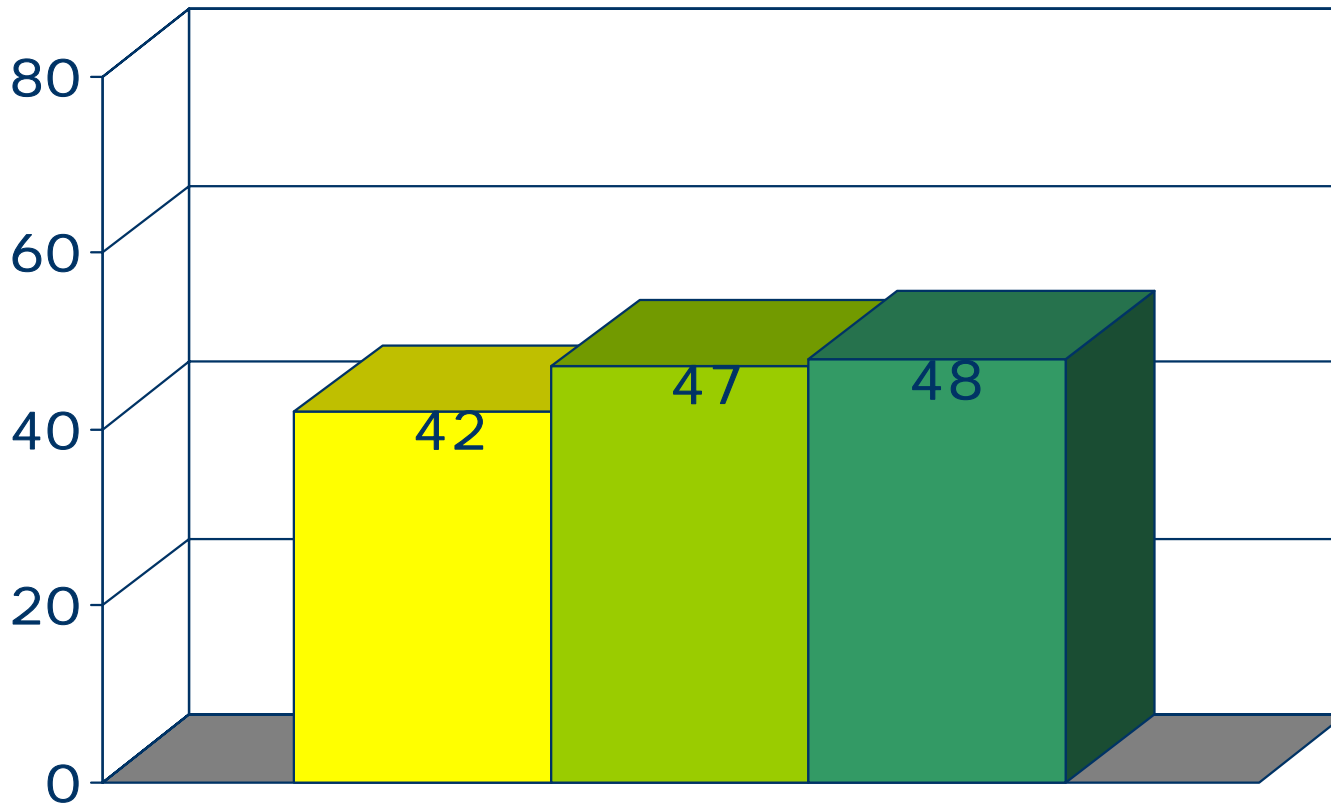
Grades 3 – 5 PACT English/LA Percent of Basic and Above



Grades 3-5 PACT Math Percent of Basic and Above

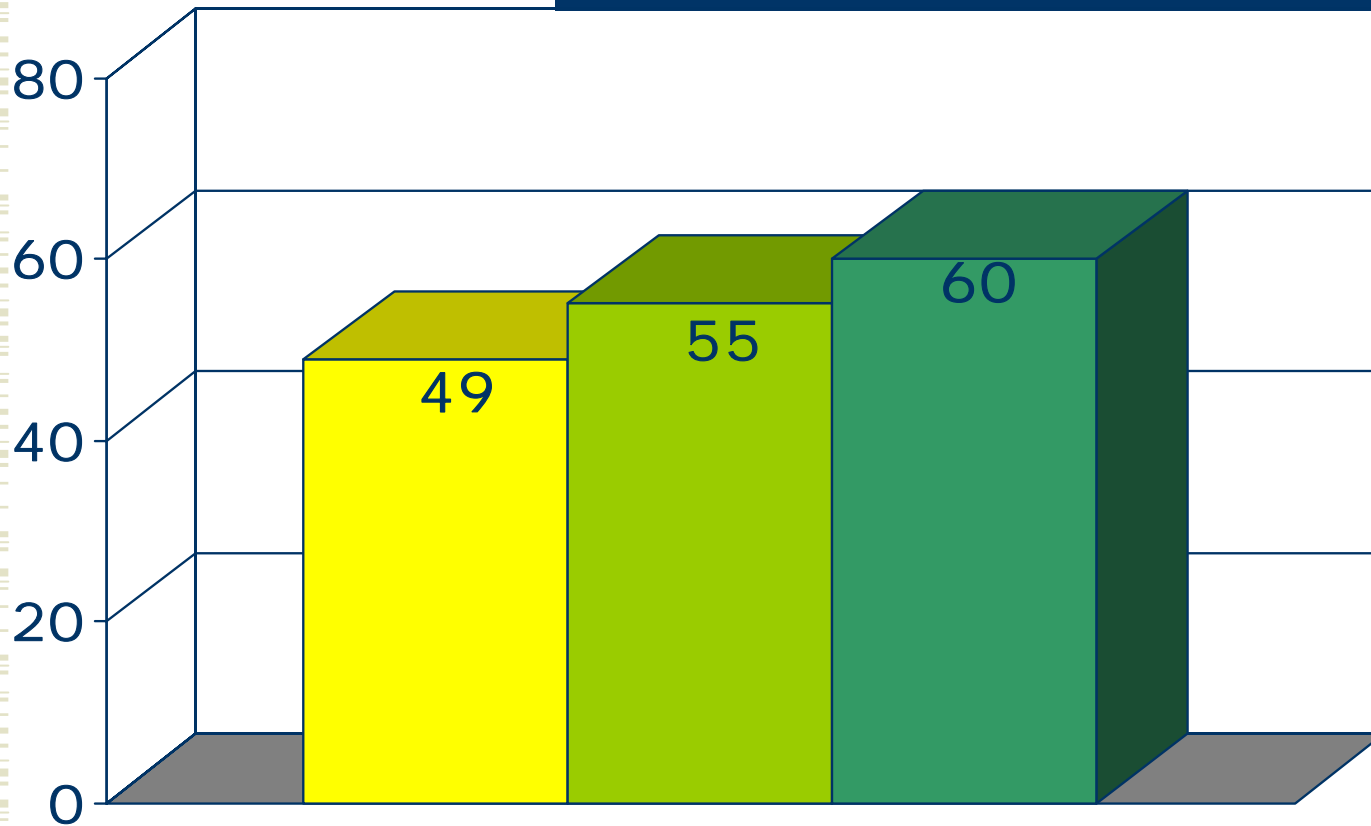


Grades 3-5 PACT Science Percent of Basic and Above



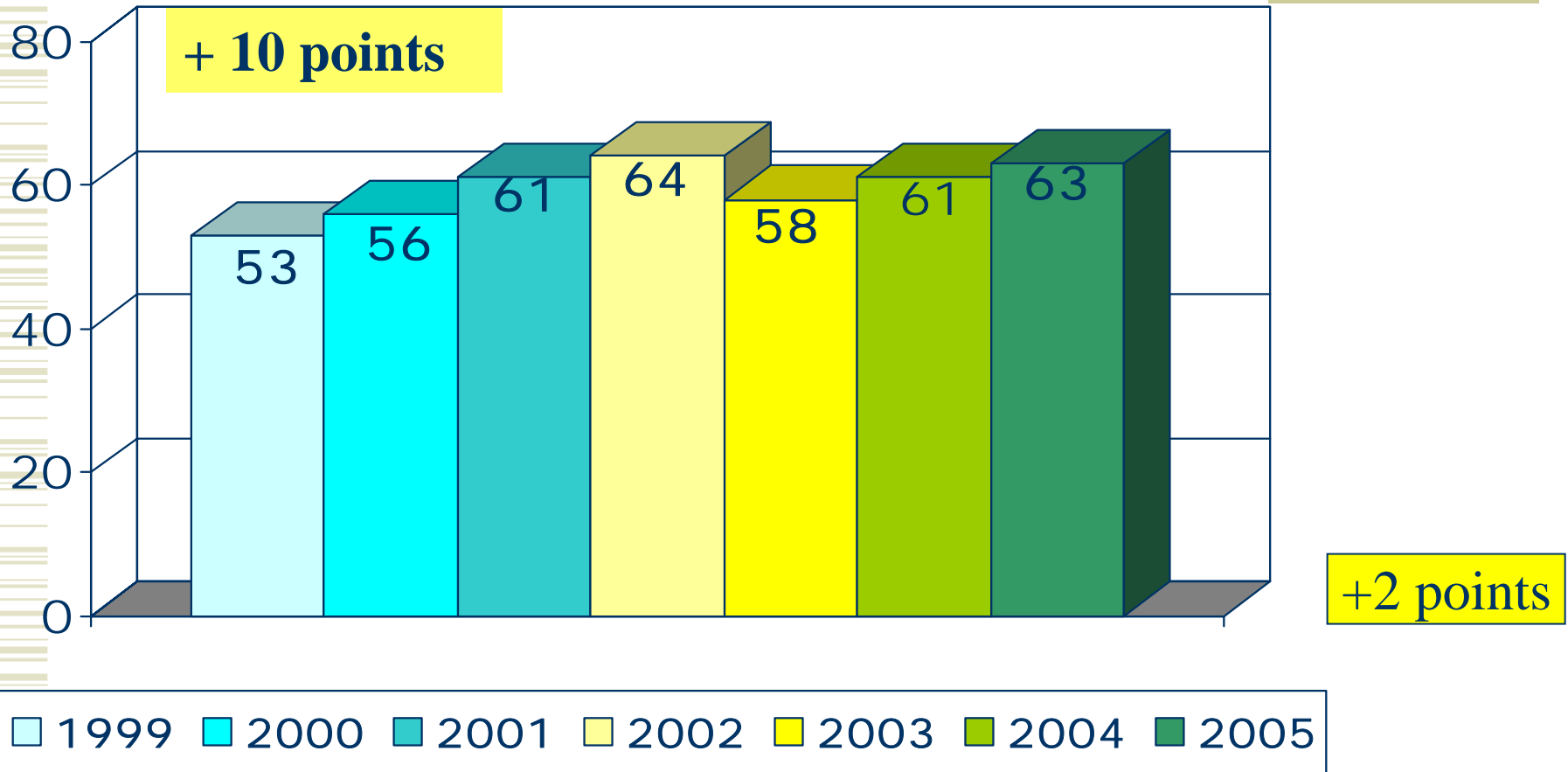

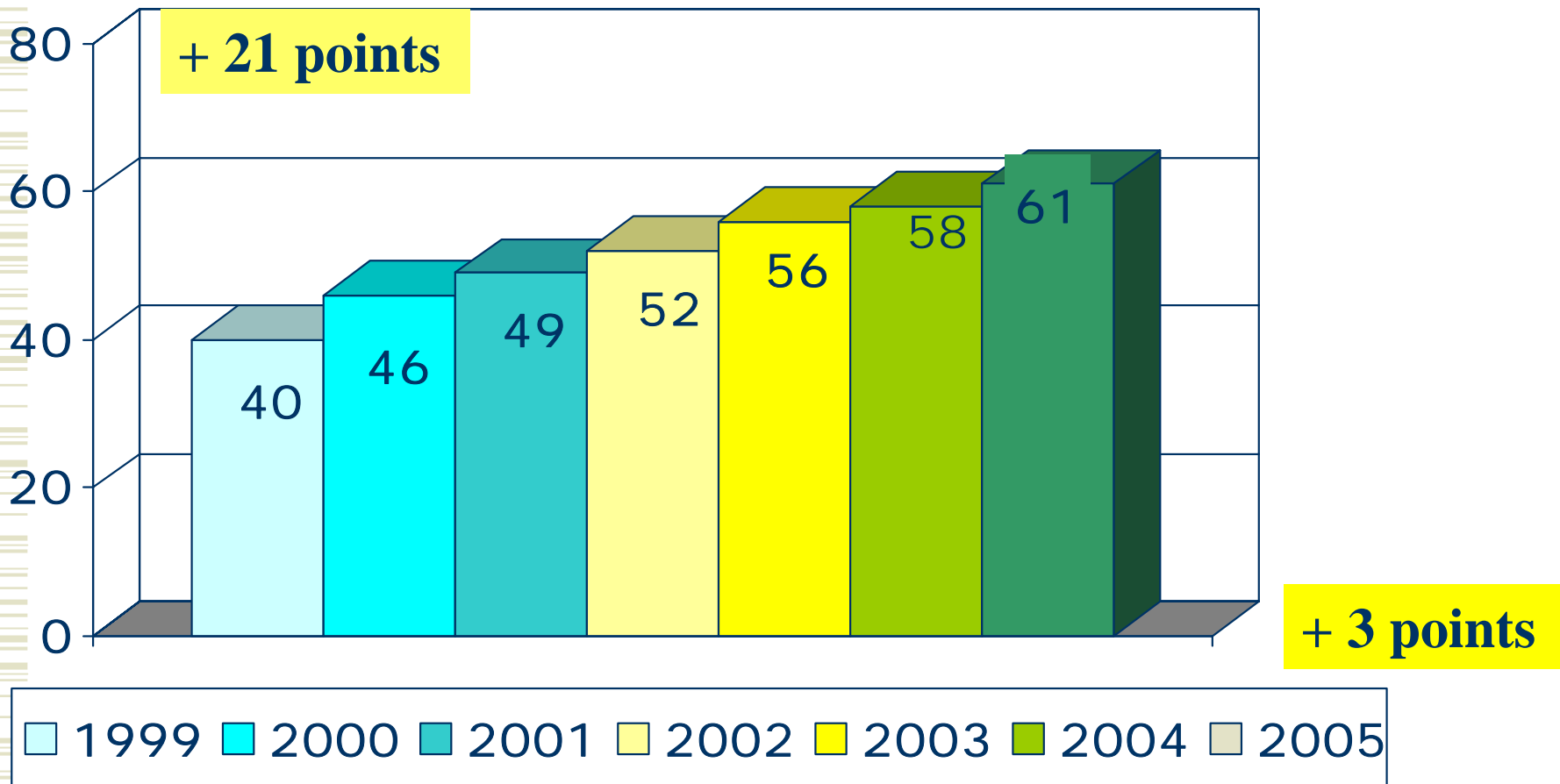

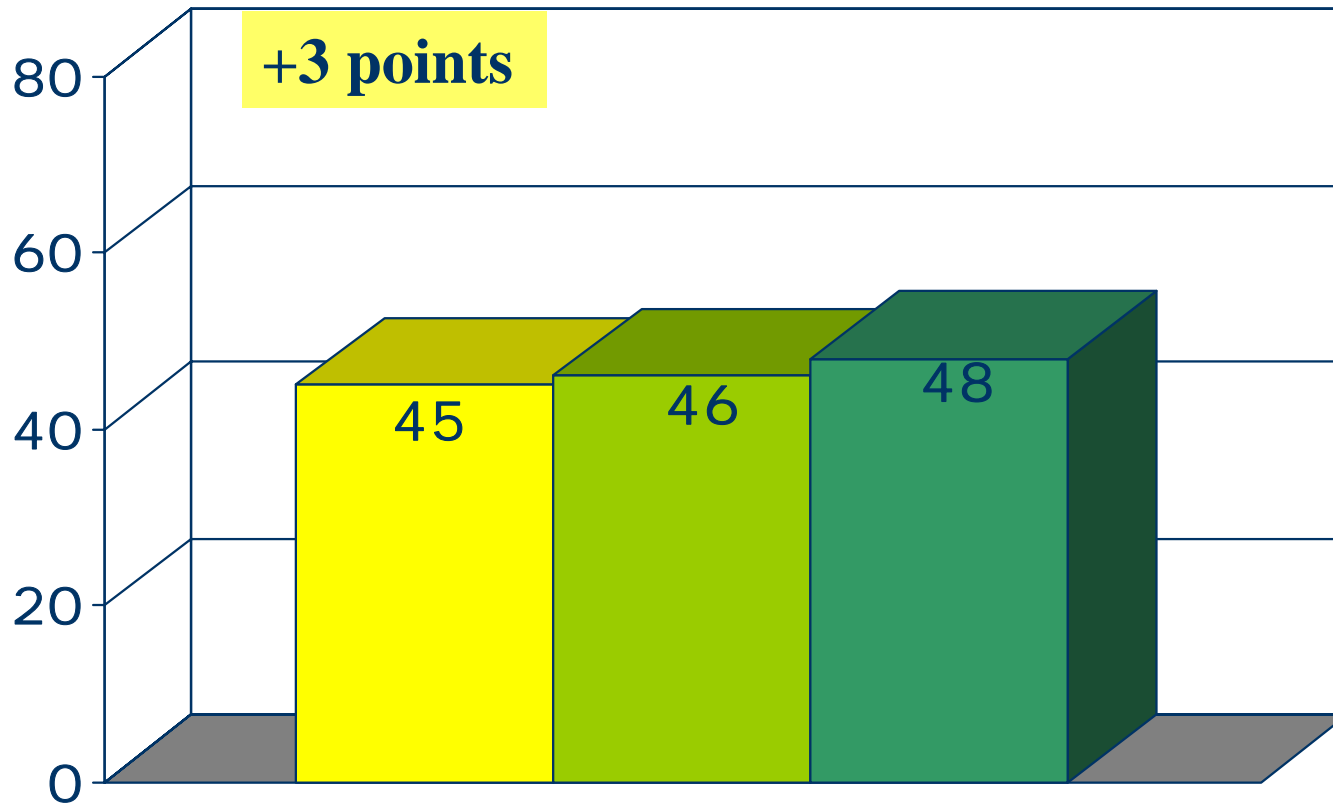
Grades 6 -8 PACT English/LA Percent of Basic and Above



Grades 6 -8 PACT Math Percent of Basic and Above

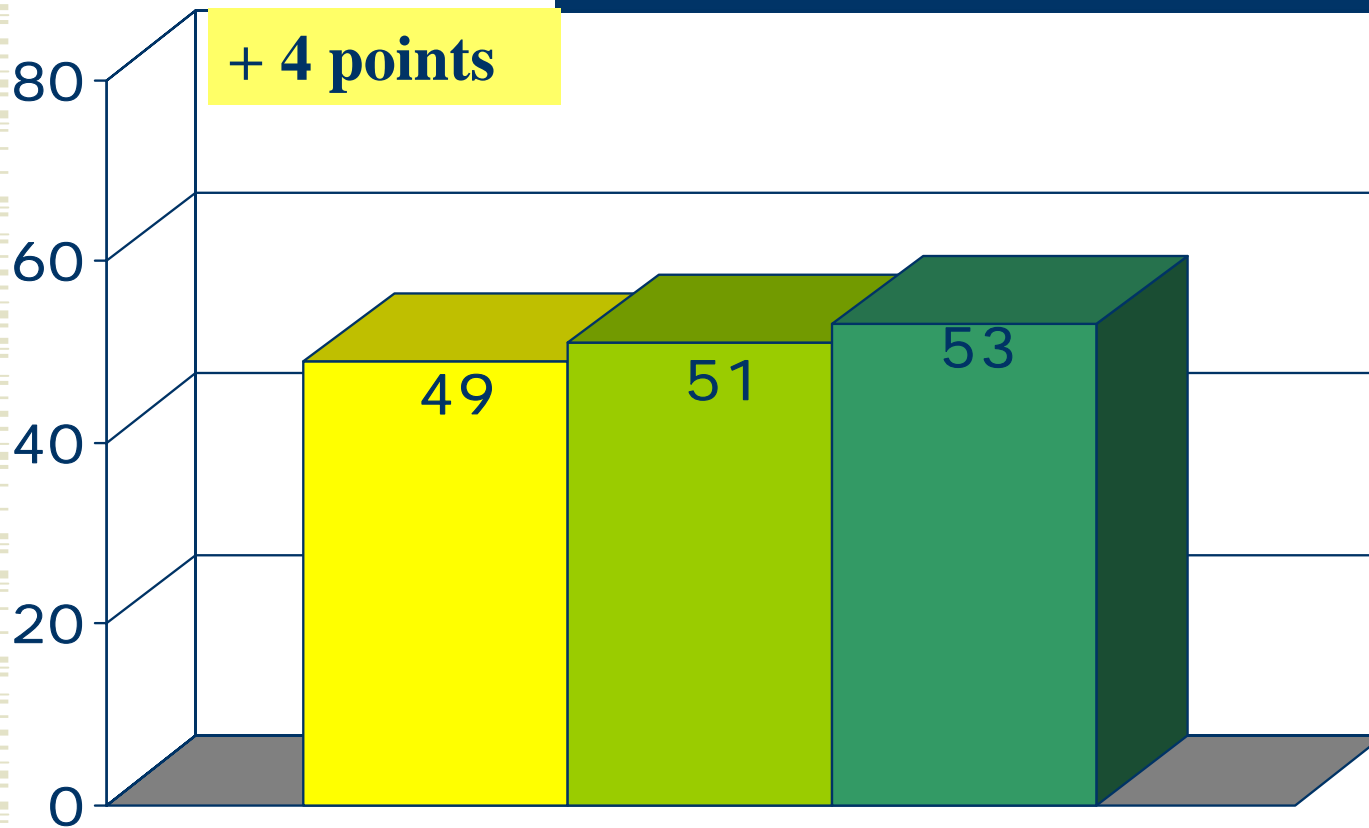


Grades 6-8 PACT Science Percent of Basic and Above

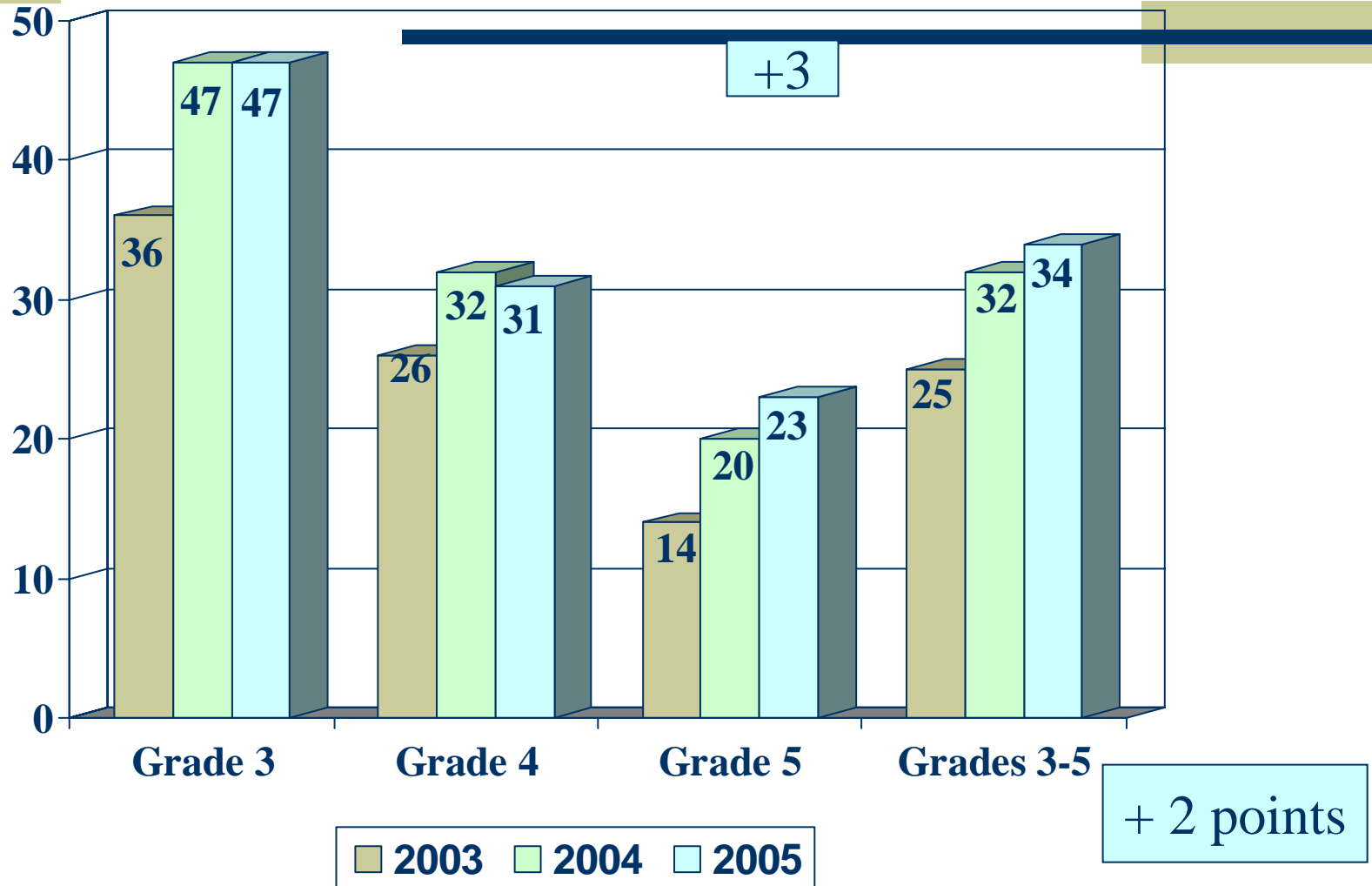

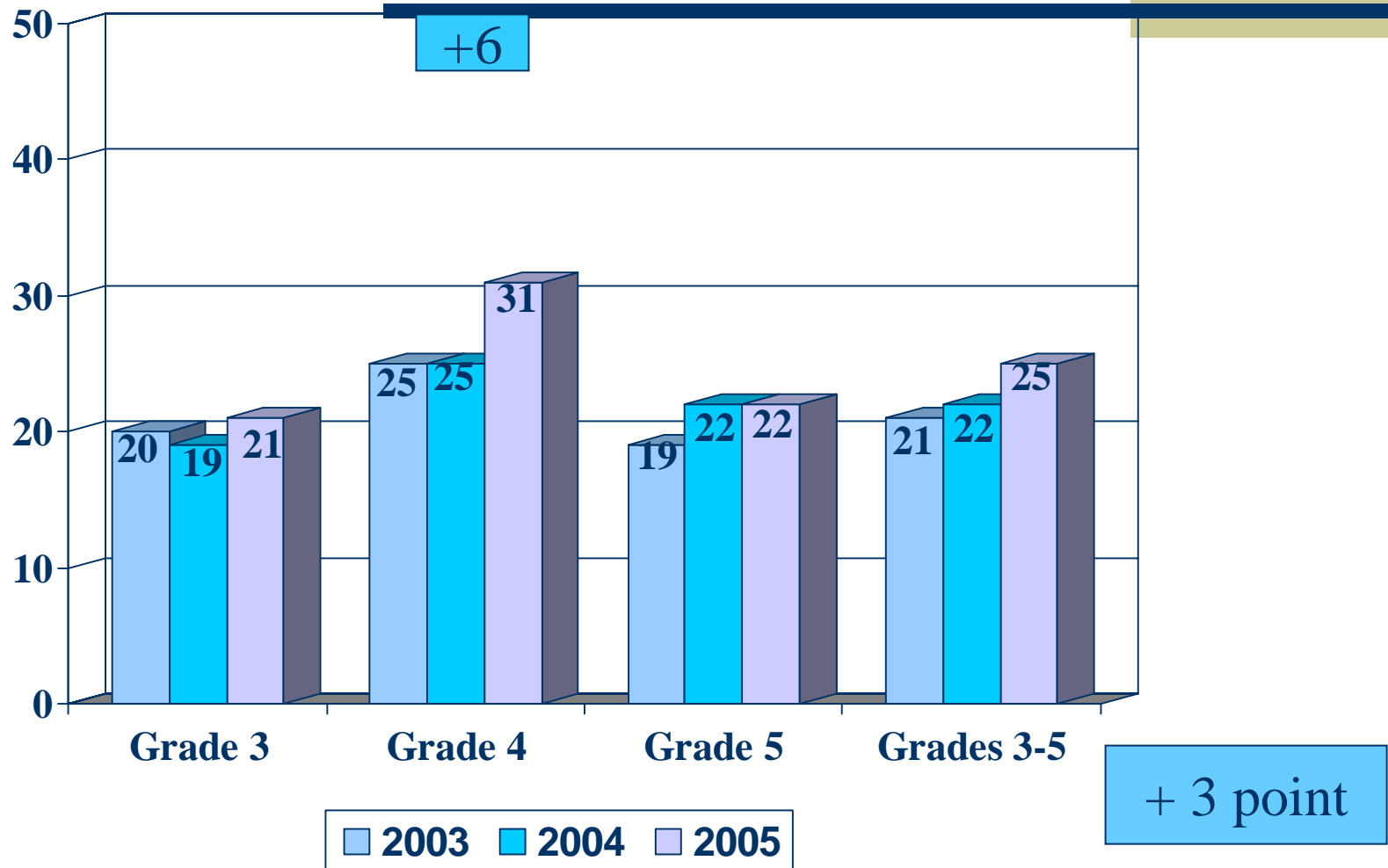
III. Increase of Percent of Proficient and Advanced Students

- ◆ comparing 2003 and 2004 data

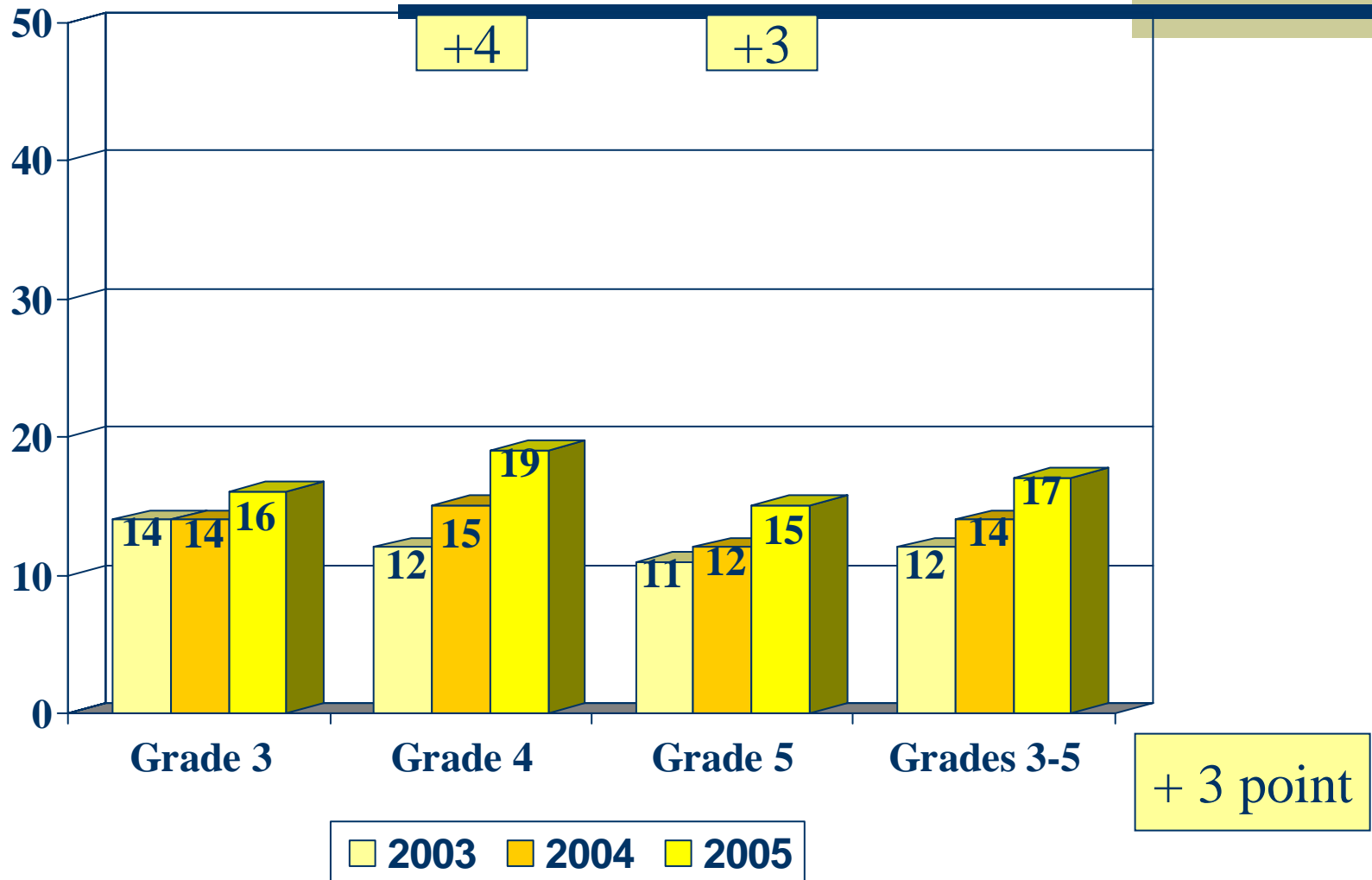
Grades 3-5 PACT English/LA Percent of Proficient and Advanced



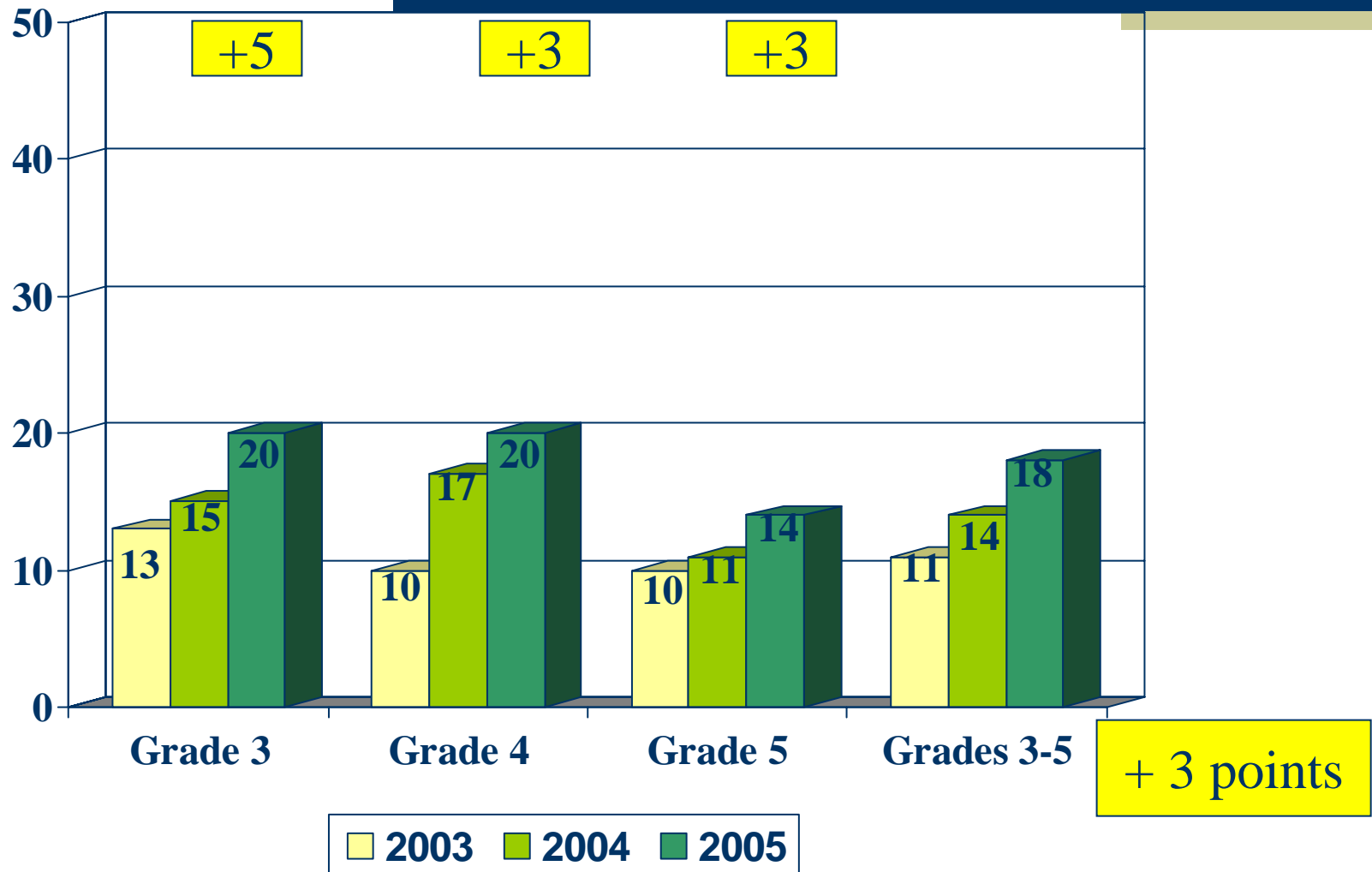
Grades 3-5 PACT Math Percent of Proficient and Advanced



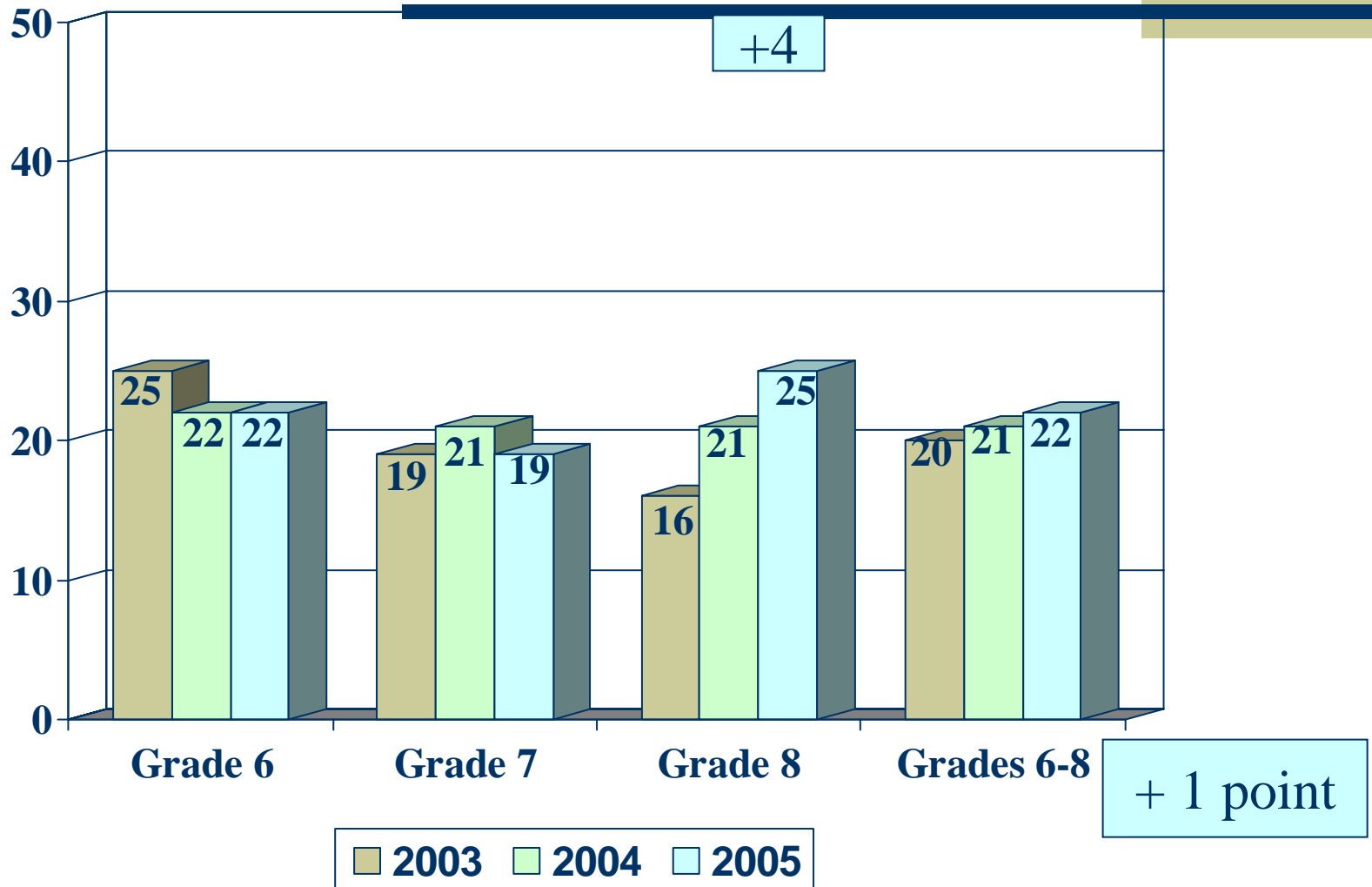
Grades 3-5 PACT Science Percent of proficient and Advanced



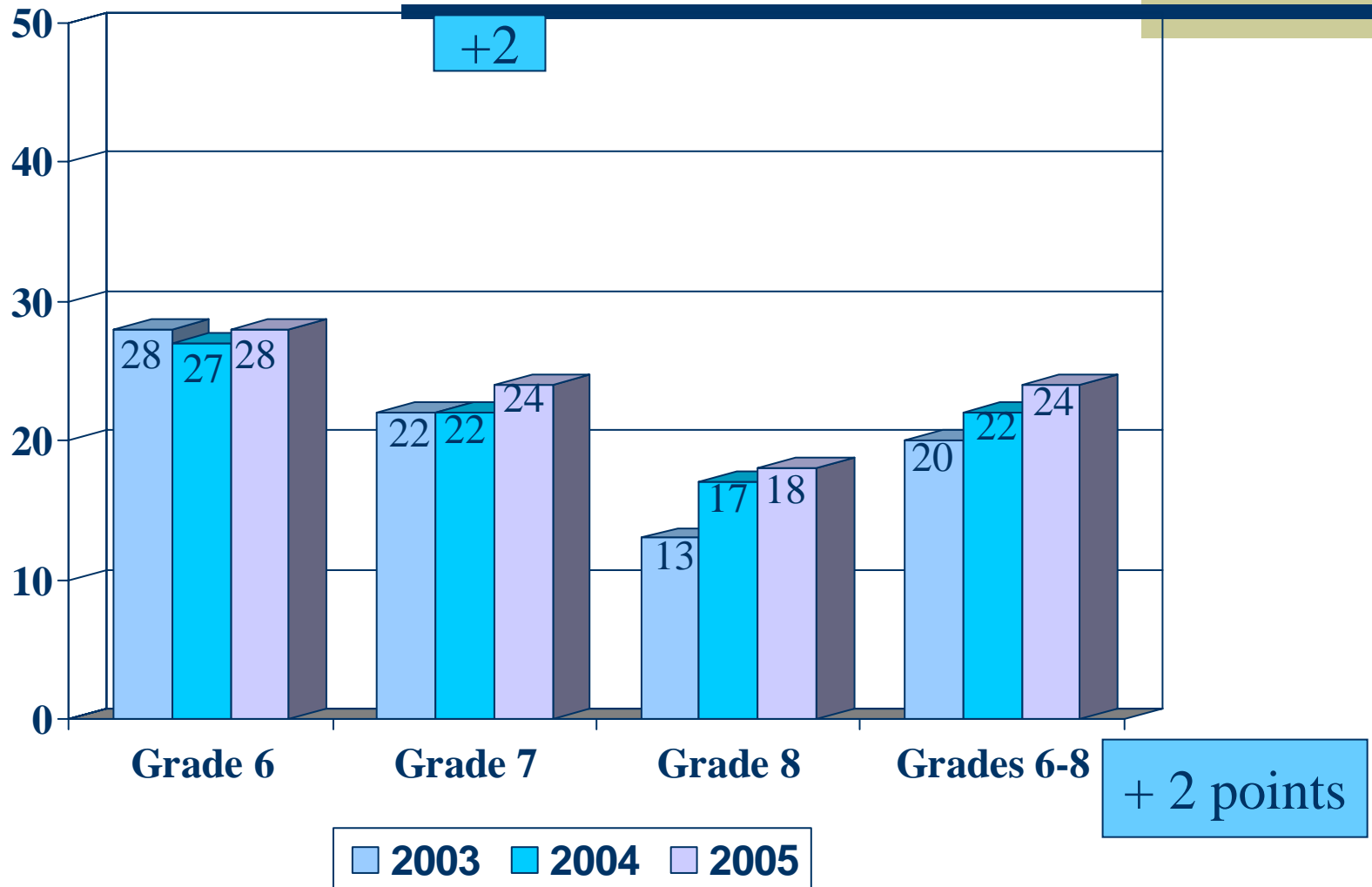

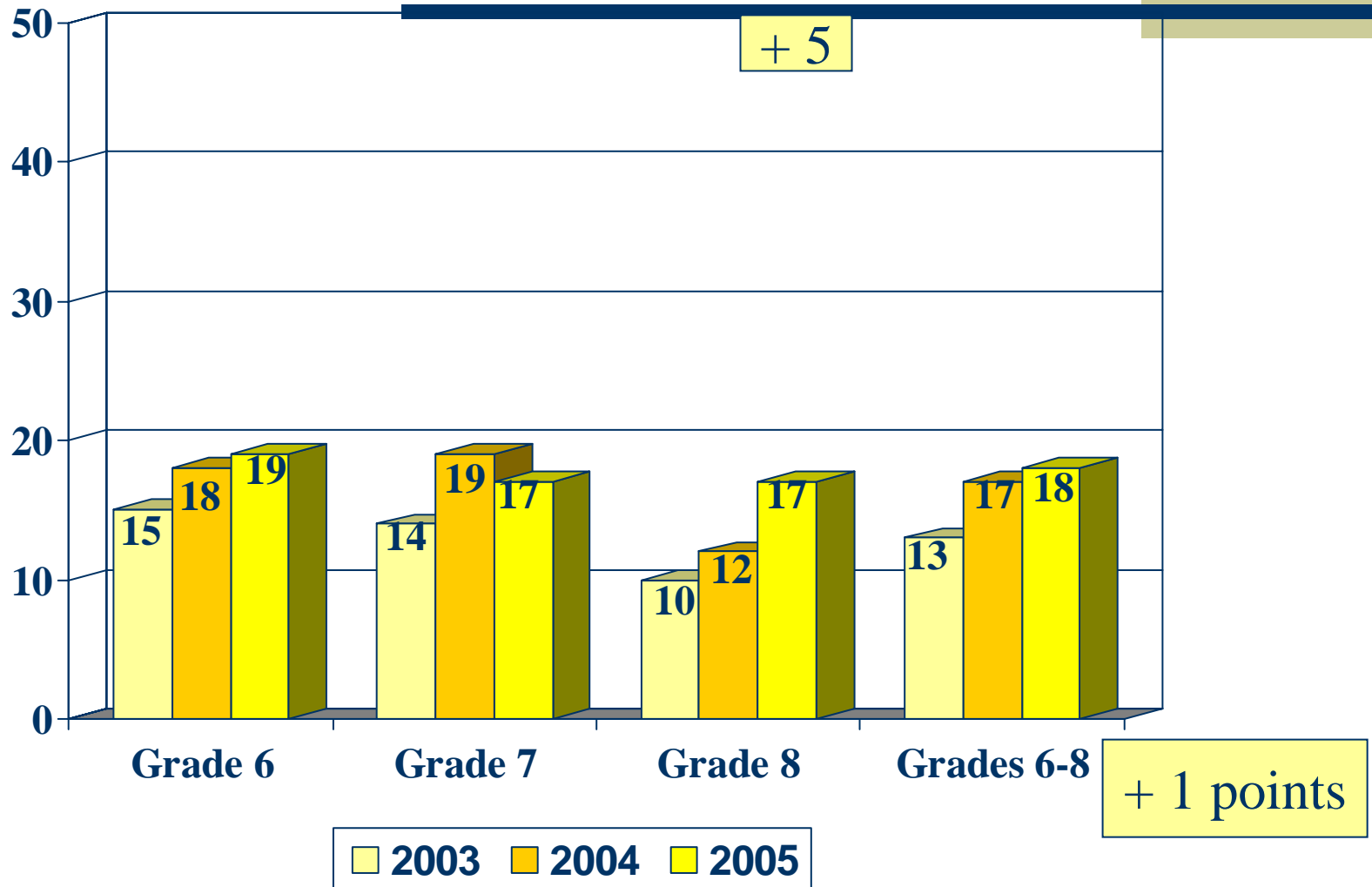

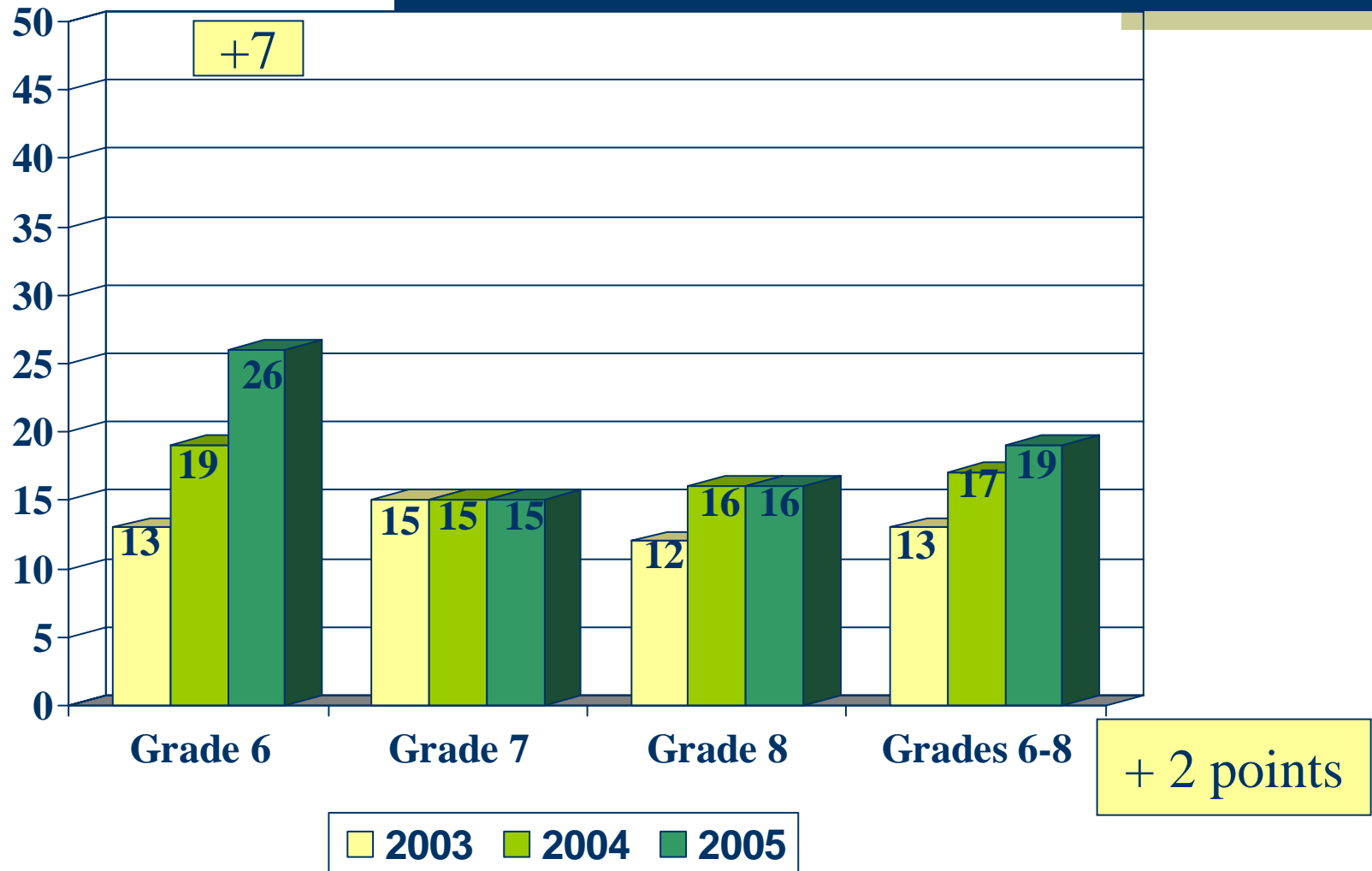

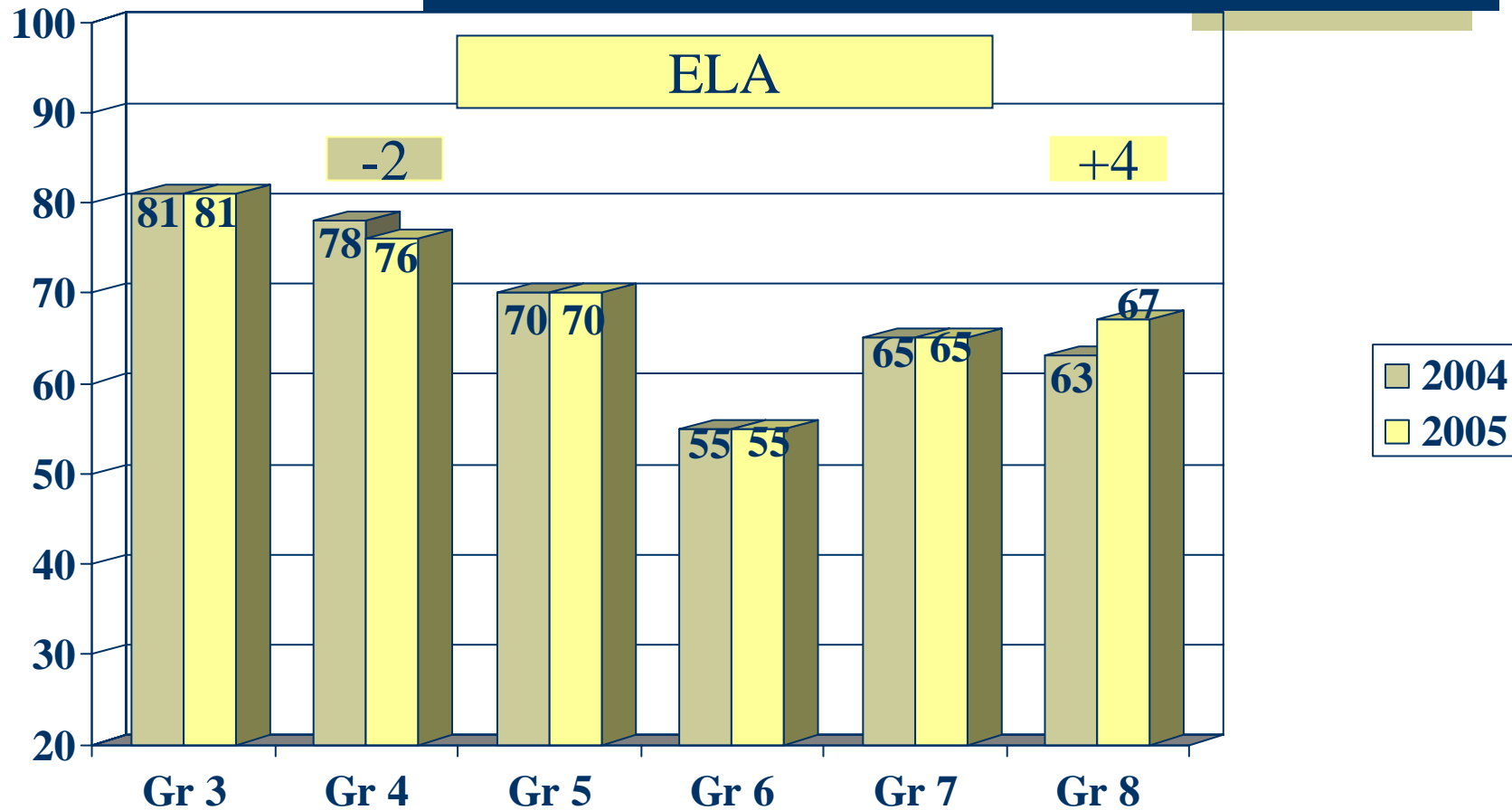


IV. Comparisons with SC

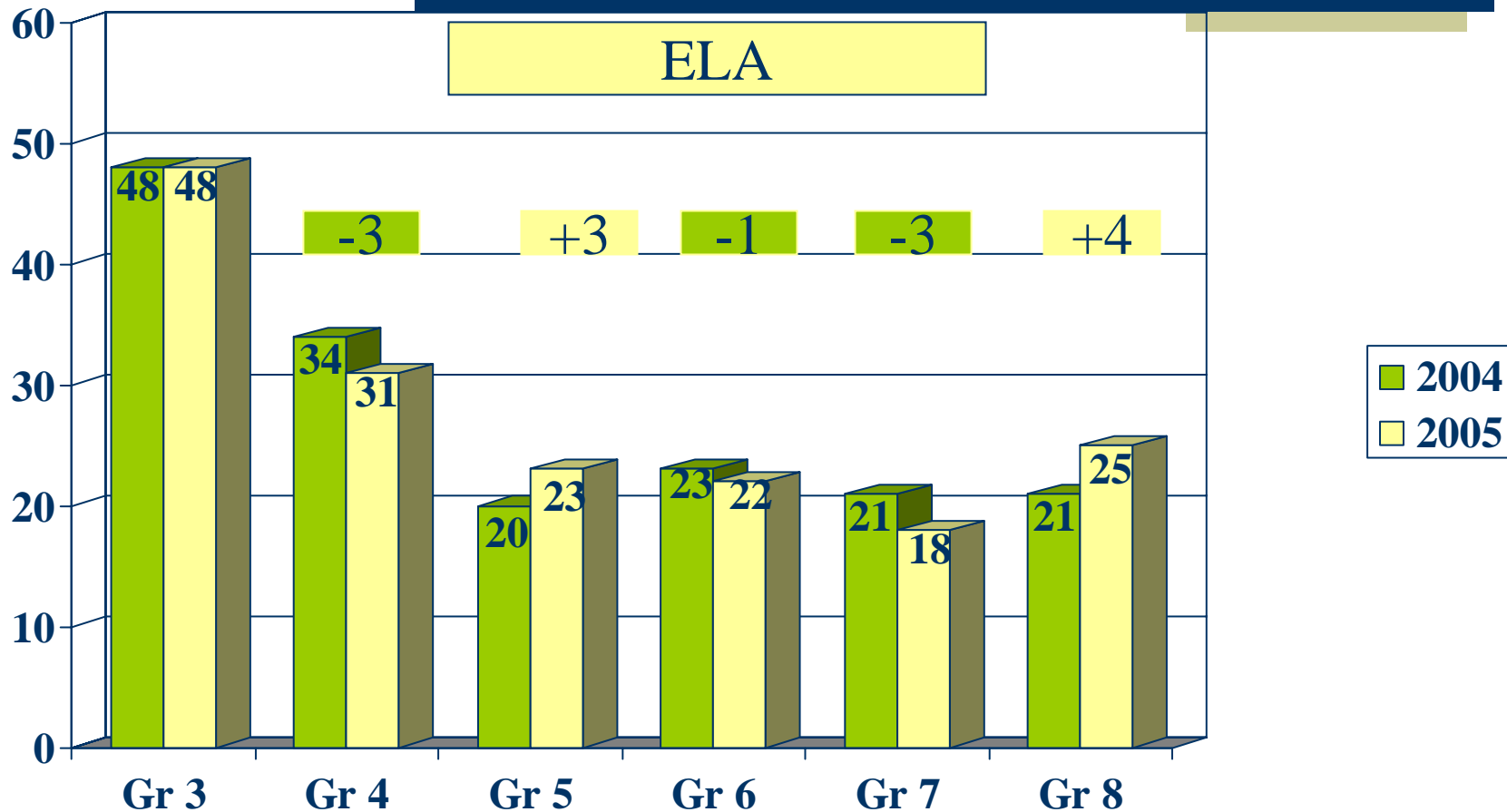
- ◆ Included all students who took on-grade level tests without modifications; special education students who took off-grade level tests were not included

Percent of Basic and Above

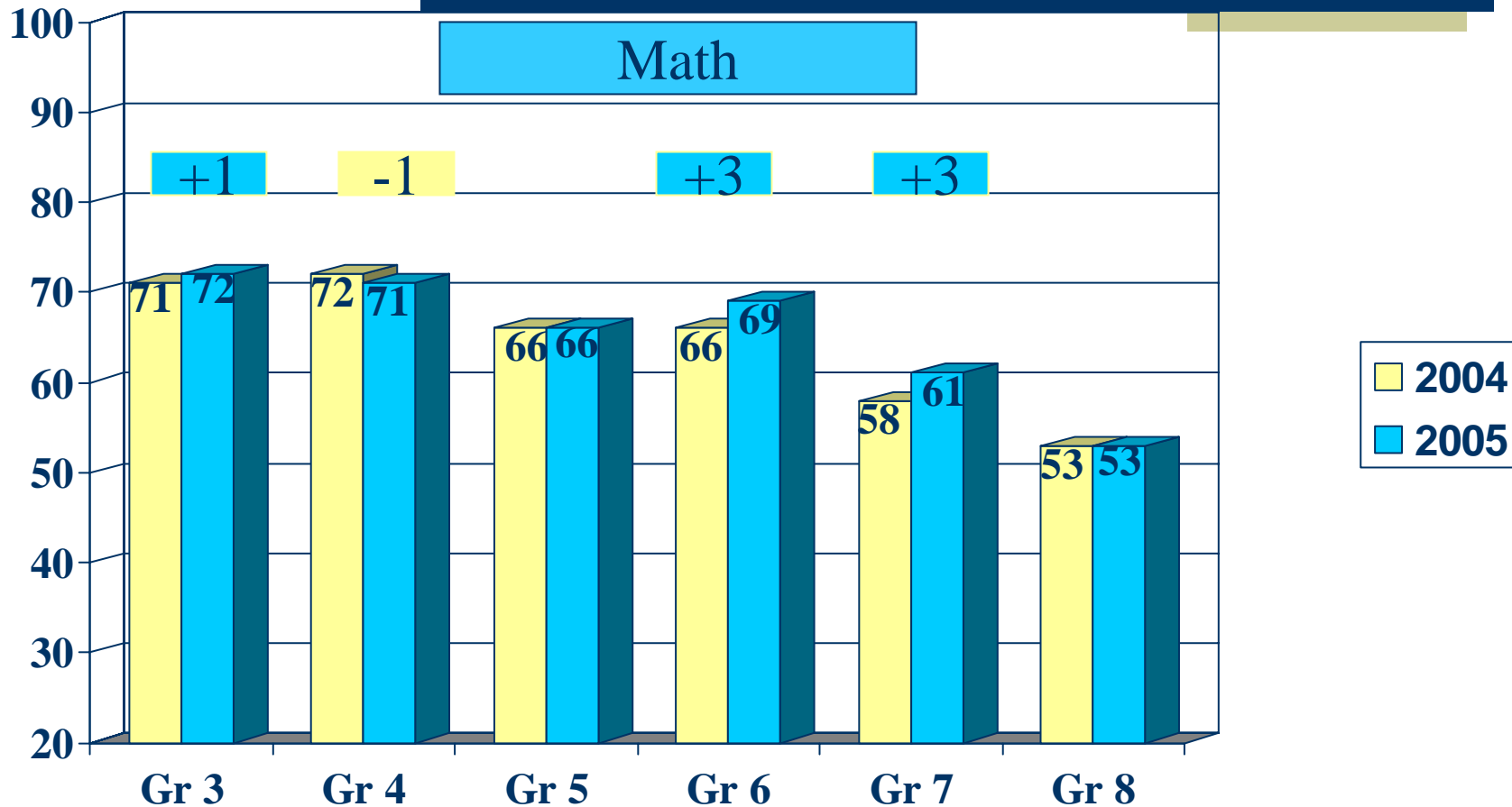


2005 PACT Performance by Grade Percent of Proficient and Advanced

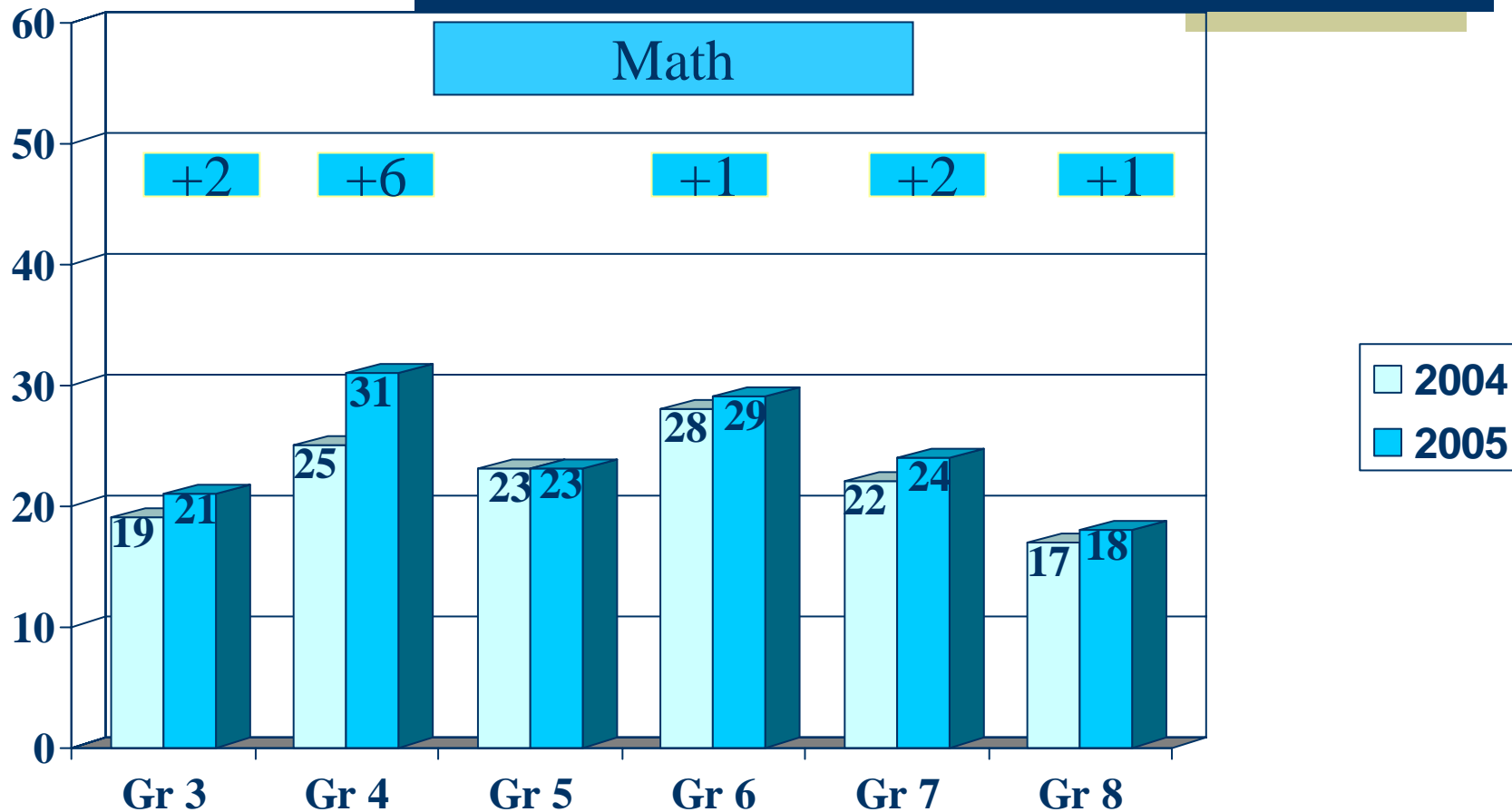

Percent of Basic and Above

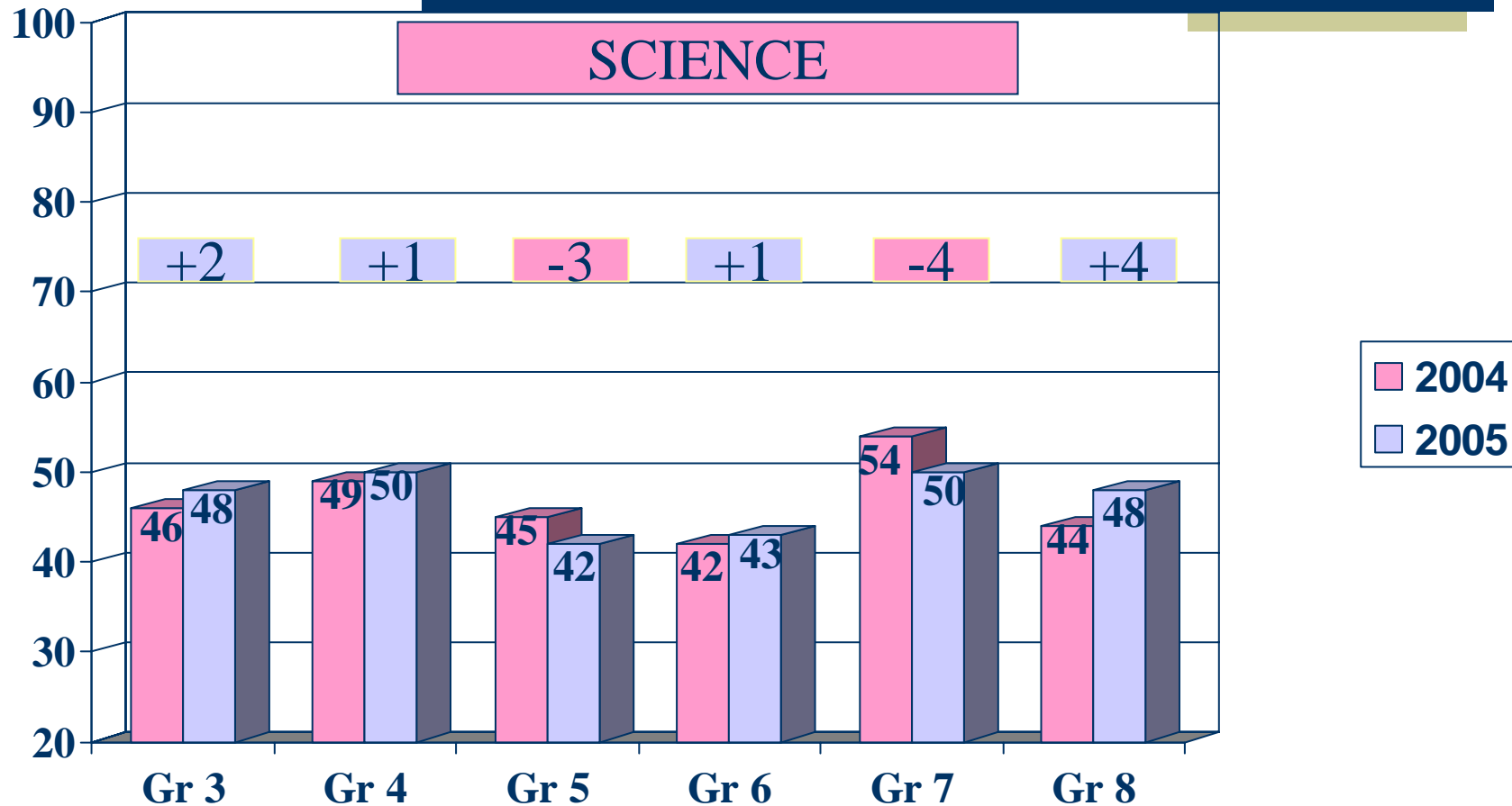


2005 PACT Performance by Grade Percent of Proficient and Advanced

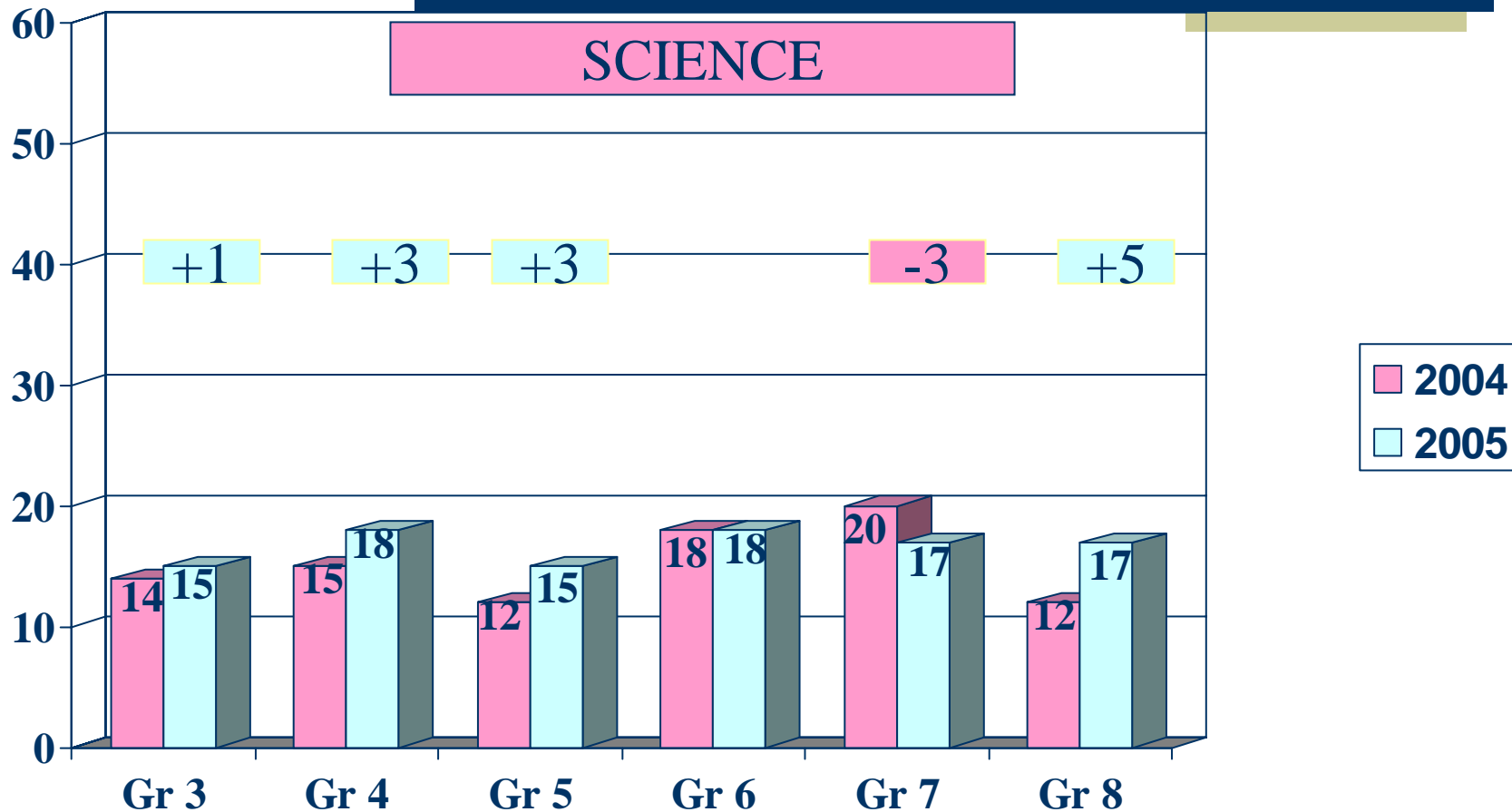

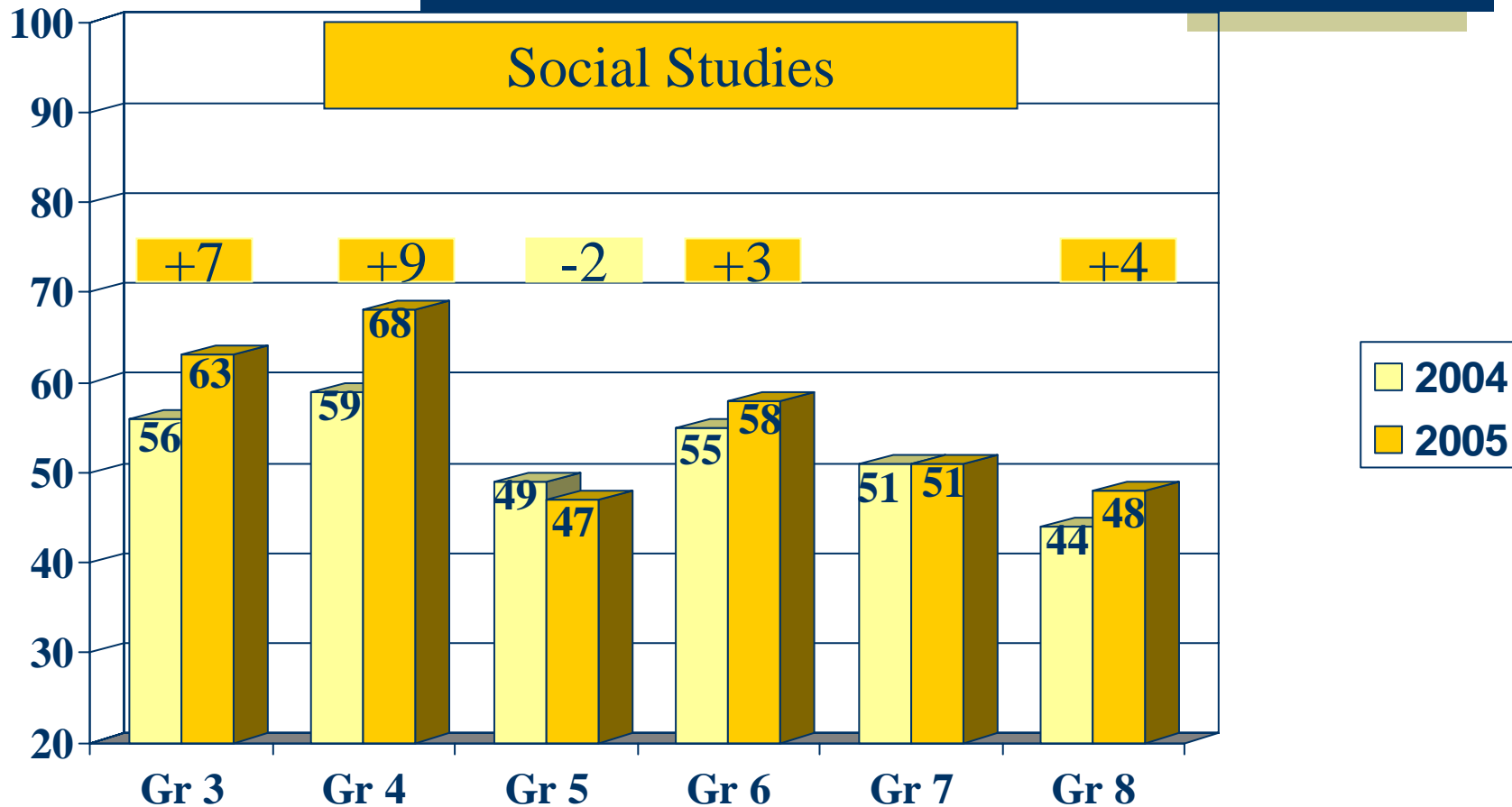


2005 PACT Performance by Grade Percent of Proficient and Advanced



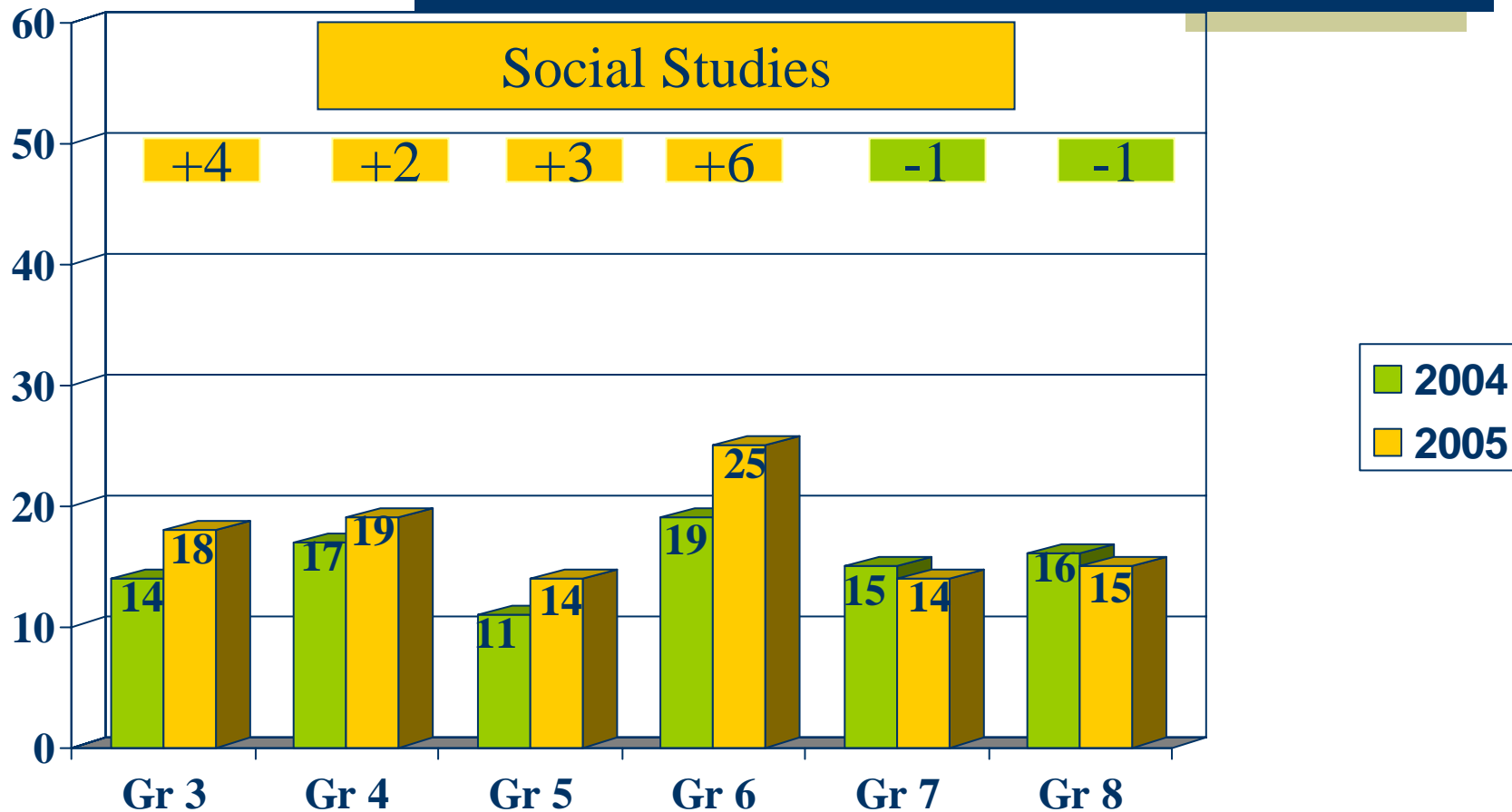

Conclusion

- ◆ The percent of Richland One students performing Basic or better maintained as in 2004 for 7 of 24 measures (6 grades X 4 subject areas)
- ◆ The percent of Richland One students performing Basic or better exceeded that of 2004 for 12 of 24 measures
- ◆ Richland One exceeded SC in 9 measures in terms of improvement gains from 2004

Conclusion

- ◆ The percent of Richland One students performing Proficient and Advanced maintained as in of 2004 for 3 of 24 measures
- ◆ The percent of Richland One students performing Proficient and Advanced exceeded that of 2004 for 15 of 24 measures
- ◆ Richland One exceeded SC in 6 measures in terms of improvement gains from 2004

Conclusion

- ◆ Richland One white students surpassed their SC peers in all measures except grade 3 social studies (Richland One: 88.0%; SC: 88.4%)
- ◆ Richland One African American students surpassed their SC peers in the area of ELA for grades 4, 5, and 7
