2 These counts excluded pre-kindergarten (CD/PCD) students. The Adjusted F/R Lunch Total was computed by adding the numbers of students eligible for free or reduced lunch (all grades) and then subtracting the number of pre-K (CD/PCD) students eligible for free or reduced lunch.

3 These 135-day ADM counts exclude the pre-kindergarten (CD/PK) students at all elementary schools.

4 F/R Lunch total for Middle College represents the most recent known student participation in the school lunch program from the past 3 school years.
