AN ABBREVIATED BOARD ACTION REPORT,
PREPARED BY RICHLAND SCHOOL DISTRICT ONE'S

WEDNESDAY A.M., Aug. 11, 2004—Richland One's school board, meeting last night, approved the following administrative appointments: Dr. Bernadette Scott, retired administrator, is the interim principal at Brockman Elementary; Sarah Smith, assistant principal at Satchel Ford Elementary, is interim principal at Carver-Lyon Elementary; and Brian Blease, teacher at Southeast Middle, is assistant principal at Meadowfield Elementary.

Information was presented on a plan being proposed by the A.C. Flora High Athletic Booster Club and the Forest Acres City Council to construct an athletic facility on the Flora campus. The project would be funded by a grant to the Booster Club from Forest Acres; the district would own and control the use of the facility.

Memoranda of agreement were renewed for 2004-05 with the Carolina Children's Home, the Alston Wilkes Society and the Richland County Sheriff's Department, the latter for School Resource Officers. The other two organizations provide alternative education placements for students.

Approval was given to extending a right-of-way to SCE&G at Heyward Career and Technology Center for completion of renovations at that school.

A contract was awarded to W.B. Thomasson Heating Company for replacement of the HVAC system in the computer room of the Stevenson Administration Building. Contracts to furnish and install data cabling on an as-needed basis were issued to A3 Communication, Systems & Services, Communication Management, O.B. One Communication and Veteran Communications.

Teacher Classroom Innovation Grants, funded by Partners In Education, were presented to six teachers for the fall semester. These competitive grants are awarded twice a year. Recipients are required to file evaluation reports on their projects at the end of the grant period.
