- Twelve high school seniors were present and recognized as National Merit Semifinalists, National Merit Commended students and National Achievement Semifinalists. The district had a total of 16 students selected.

- Six employees were honored for having achieved at least five consecutive years of perfect attendance.
- Richland One received the highest honors in financial reporting and accounting from the Government Finance Officers Association and the American Association of School Business Officials for the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) for fiscal year ending June 30, 2004.
