## School Board Spotlight

## Consent Agenda

The Board approved the following items:

- Contract extensions for debt collection services, workers' compensation and property/casualty insurance coverage, and arbitrage rebate calculation and compliance services.
- Leave of absence requests
- Hiring of personnel

## Office of the Board

- Chairwoman Wendy Brawley stated that the Board would need to nominate a new member to the Richland One Hall of Fame committee.
- The July 15 Board meeting was moved to Thursday, July 17.
- The Board approved second reading of revisions to the district's discipline code.

## Office of Academics

The Board approved the following items:

- The five-year charter school reauthorization for Richland One Middle College.
- A contract license renewal for Measures of Academic Progress (MAP).

## Office of Operations

The Board approved the following contracts:

- Library shelves and equipment for St. Andrews Middle School
- Purchase of Innovation Grant "Smartboards" and laptops

The Board approved a request to transfer the name of the gymnasium of W.G. Sanders Middle School (the C.E. Rayford Gymnasium) to the new site at the former Keenan High School. The Board also approved a request for renovation of classrooms at Lower Richland.
