

Board Briefings

June 14, 2005 • an abbreviated board action report prepared by Richland One's Office of Communications

Richland One's school board, meeting at the Stevenson Administration Building, made the following administrative appointments for 2005–06:

- Shenequa Coles will be assistant principal at Columbia High School. She is a former Richland One teacher.
- Dr. Vivian Gehlken will be assistant principal at Keenan High School. She was a media specialist at the school from 1999-2003.
- Dr. Beryl Brooks-Goines will be the director of certified employment services. She has served previously as an assistant superintendent in Kershaw County and in recruiting and staffing this spring.

Consent Agenda

The board approved the following contract extensions:

- Elevator Maintenance Services for elevator maintenance
- Wolverine Exterminating Company for pest control services

Reports

- A hearing was held on Acceptable (Internet) Use Policy IJNDB. The board approved first reading of revisions to this policy.
- The board reappointed the 11 members of the Richland One Hall of Fame Selection Committee. Members were assigned staggered terms to the committee seats.
- The board heard reports on Richland One Middle College and Midlands Math and Business Academy. The charter for Richland One Middle College was renewed. Charter renewal for Midlands Math and Business Academy will be considered at an upcoming board meeting.

Other Matters of Interest

- The board approved a bid for bulk purchase of sound system equipment and installation from Gattis Pro Audio, Inc. for eight middle schools.
- Bids were approved from Corley Construction (demolition and utilities) and Burriss Electrical (electrical work) at A.C. Flora High School.
- First Citizens was awarded a contract to provide banking services for the district.
- The board approved a recommendation for modifications to soccer fields adjacent to Memorial Stadium.
- The board heard a report on the Small/Women/Minority Business Enterprise Program (SWMBE).
