

MORNING ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

The first nine weeks of school is over, and everyone should have their morning routine in place. With over 400 students at Rosewood, most of whom are car riders, the morning carpool lines on Ravenel and behind the school can be challenging. Please be aware that there are NO PARKING signs posted at the corner of Moss and S. Ott, as well as the block off S. Walker that extends from Rosewood Drive to Hope Avenue. Children who are being driven to school are car riders and should be dropped off in the car line at either the drop off located behind the school or on Ravenel Street. Please do not park in a NO PARKING area to walk your child to the building every morning. To keep the car line moving efficiently, parents should not get out of their cars while in the car line, and students should be ready to exit the vehicle promptly when they reach the designated drop off area.

Also, please be mindful of your speed in our school zone! We have many students who walk or ride bikes to school every day!

PLEASE REMEMBER:

Students who eat breakfast at school may be dropped off at the cafeteria between 7:00 - 7:10 a.m.

Students who are not eating breakfast at school should not arrive before 7:10 a.m., which is when adult supervision begins in the auditorium.
