Dreher earns an "A"

Scores 93.4%

Dreher was named to Newsweek's List of America's Best High Schools in 2013.

The Department of Education awarded Dreher two "Cum Laude" ratings for excellence in performance on the 2011-2012 SAT and ACT.

The Department of Education awarded Dreher a 2012-2013 Palmetto Gold Award for General Performance.

Dreher has six 2013 **National Merit** Finalists, three **National Merit** Commended Scholars and a **National** Achievement Scholarship winner.

Out of the senior class of 221, forty-seven students were named 2013 High School Scholars and/ or Richland One Academic All- Stars.

Six dozen seniors scored 1100 or higher on SAT or 24 or higher on ACT to meet one qualification for the Life Scholarship.

Seventeen seniors are candidates for the **Palmetto Fellows** Scholarship.

Eleven seniors were named AP Scholars with Distinction, four are AP Scholars with Honor and thirteen are AP Scholars.

Academy graduates include eighteen seniors in the **Engineering and** Science Academy; seventeen in the **Humanities Academy**; sixteen in the AP Institute; and fortyone in the Fine Arts Institute.

Achievement in Academics

Alessandra Tuel was invited to apply to the prestigious US Presidential Scholar program on the strength of her perfect score on the math portion of the SAT.

Makayla Roberts placed first in the Dialogue Foundation's Essay Contest and won a trip to Turkey this summer.

For two summers Jaleel Jefferson conducted research in the Anatomy lab of the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine.



Isabel Gwara received honorable mention in the 2013 competition for the Skylark Prize, given by the Poetry Society of South Carolina.
