#### **Achievement in Academics**




Our pass rate for 290 students who took 584 **AP exams** in 2017 was **72%**, v. 57% statewide and 56% nationwide.

**Gracie Barrineau** and **Samuel Sawyer** were named **National AP Scholars.**Sixteen seniors were named **AP Scholars with Distinction**. Five more were named **AP Scholars with Honor** and six more were named **AP Scholars.** 

Mean composite ACT score for Class of '17 was 19.4 v. 18.4 statewide.


