

The Brockman Elementary After-School STEM Class

Enrollment Information

Return enrollment forms to Ms. Huffstedler in the front office. Classes will be filled first come, first serve.

Spring class begins February 14, 2018, Thursday at 2:30 PM.

1. The Brockman PTO is instituting a single STEM class offering for 4th and 5th grade children this spring. The course was first offered last year in the spring, and this year, there will be some modifications to improve it and make it available to a larger group of children.
2. Seats are limited and filled on a first-come, first-serve basis with an effort to accommodate all interested students. If a minimum number of students do not register for the class, it may be cancelled.
3. Enrollment is for the spring semester only. There will be approximately 8 sessions.
4. This program is free to students. The PTO is funding the teacher supervision. Three students who took the course last year, will help teach the course this year. Students who take the course this year (4th graders) may be permitted to help teach the course next year.
5. CONFIRMATION FORMS will be sent to families by email to verify enrollments.
6. Students attending the BEARS AFTER-CARE program will be walked to the cafeteria by staff after their class. Students not enrolled in BEARS AFTER-CARE may NOT go to the cafeteria and MUST be picked up outside the music room **at 3:45 PM**. There is NO staff available to be with children who are not picked up on time. Repeated late pick-ups will result in a child being removed from the class.

Procedures for after school STEM Activities: Students must follow school rules and follow directions from staff at all times. Students must remain quiet and calm in the hallways at all times and stay with an adult at all times. Parents will park and come in to sign out their children at the entrance beside the primary playground. Send a note with your child to Mr. Stoner regarding any changes in pick-up arrangements. Disruptive conduct or repeated late pick-ups will cancel a student's enrollment.

After School STEM Program Class Description

Learning Computer Programming with CODE.ORG. The goal of the course is to teach 4th and 5th grade students some basic computer programming skills using a programming language very similar to the M.I.T. SCRATCH program developed to teach computer programming. The programming language will be used to manipulate characters and icons to program first screen icon movement and environmental content, then eventually to construct video games, and story boards, from scratch. The students will use the laptop computers issued to them by Richland One. The actual programming will be taught by the program, and augmented by student teachers and faculty teachers. The classes will be held at Brockman from 2:30 PM to 3:45 PM on Thursdays. Brockman classroom conduct will be supervised by a Brockman teacher.
