Beginning in 2017-18, students in grades four, six, and eight completed the science assessment while students in grades five and seven completed the social studies assessment. Due to the change in students tested, comparison is not recommended for all grades combined. Percent results (shown below) exclude students who tested with non-standard accommodations.
