

AR GBEBAR Staff Dress Code

The following serve as guidelines for dress code enforcement for Richland County School District One:

- Jeans, t-shirts, wind suits, and shorts are acceptable dress for Richland County School District One personnel at the discretion of the principal or immediate supervisor, and only on paydays and for special events.
- Skirts, dresses, and shorts should not be shorter than three inches above the knee.
- Physical education teachers and career and technology educators should wear attire appropriate for their instructional environment for the day.
- Custodial, maintenance, food service, nursing staff, and bus drivers should wear attire approved by the district.

The following shall not be acceptable at any time from any employee:

- frayed, torn, slit, and/or extremely faded pants
- excessively form-fitting or revealing clothing
- exercise clothing (allowed for PE teachers only) flip-flop or beach style shoes
- strapless tops or halter tops
- leggings
- overalls
- sheer clothing
- spaghetti straps or shoulder out attire sweat suits
- (allowed for PE teachers only) jogging/warm-up suits (allowed for PE teachers only)
- visible body piercings that serve as a distraction in the judgment of the principal or immediate supervisor

Tattoos that display inappropriate language or images should be covered.

Special Circumstances

It is recognized that there may be special situations where employees may not dress as they normally would (for example, field days, work days, field trips, etc.). Attire of a questionable nature will be addressed by the principal or immediate supervisor.

The principal's or supervisor's decision is final.
