| Resource  | Description   |
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| <p><b>ALEKS</b></p>  | <p><b>Assessment and Learning in Knowledge Spaces (ALEKS)</b> is a web-based, artificially intelligent assessment and learning system. <b>ALEKS</b> uses adaptive questioning to quickly and accurately determine exactly what a student knows and does not know in a course. <b>ALEKS</b> then instructs each student independently on the topics he/she is most ready to learn. As a student works through a course, <b>ALEKS</b> periodically re-assesses the student to ensure that topics learned are also retained. <b>ALEKS</b> courses provide topic coverage and do not include multiple-choice questions. A student who shows a high level of mastery of an <b>ALEKS</b> course should be successful in the actual course he/she is taking. ALEKS also provides one-on-one instruction, 24/7, from virtually any web-based computer or device.</p> <p>All 6th grade – High School Probability and Statistics students are expected to complete a minimum number of topics learned weekly as established in the district protocol for mathematics. Teachers can build, share or find pre-made lessons or activities and assign these to students directly through the Discovery platform. Teachers can use Discovery to personalize learning opportunities for students. This resource can be used as a whole class, small group or individual resource to meet the needs of all learners. 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| <p><b>HMH Math Inventory (MI)</b></p>    |     | <p><b>Math Inventory</b> is a research-based, adaptive math assessment that measures math abilities and longitudinal progress from Kindergarten through Algebra II. Teachers can access reports of student’s data to better understand students’ progress and needs, intervention strategies, and ensure students are on a reliable path to college and career readiness. | <p><b>HMH Reading Inventory (RI)</b></p> |    | <p><b>Reading Inventory</b> is an adaptive student assessment program that measures reading skills and longitudinal progress from kindergarten through college readiness. | <p><b>IXL Learning ELA</b></p>           |  | <p><b>IXL Learning ELA</b> provides students with personalized plans for individual interventions through explicit and systematic reading instruction that results in confident readers. IXL uses insights from student work within the platform and Real-Time Diagnostic to generate personalized guidance for each learner. These personalized action plans seamlessly link students to the skills that will help them build on their knowledge and remediate gaps in understanding.</p>  |

Each week students should reach proficiency (a Smart Score of at least 80) on two recommended skills to maximize academic gains. Research shows that answering at least 15 questions per week on IXL has a positive impact on students' state test performance.

All resources are accessible online and available in printable, projectable, and digital formats. Within Learning A-Z, there are multiple products such as *Reading A-Z*, *RAZ Kids*, *Science A-Z*, *Vocabulary A-Z* and *Ready Test*.

**Reading A-Z and RAZ Kids** are referenced in the district curriculum units and should be used daily to support literacy instruction during components of the ELA block. Prekindergarten will use this resource monthly (some will use weekly depending on student needs).

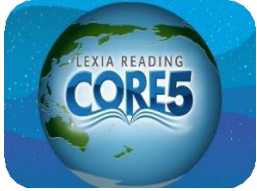
