

<b>Achieve3000</b>		<p><b>Achieve3000</b> provides cloud-based solutions that deliver daily differentiated instruction for nonfiction reading and writing that are tailored to student Lexile levels. Students take an initial placement assessment to determine Lexile levels.</p> <p><u>Special Services Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: High school (Grades 9-12) Credential Students with Disabilities</i></p>
<b>ALEKS</b>		<p><b>Assessment and Learning in Knowledge Spaces (ALEKS)</b> is a web-based, artificially intelligent assessment and learning system that uses adaptive questioning to determine student knowledge and instructs students independently on the topics they are most ready to learn. ALEKS periodically re-assesses students to ensure that topics learned are retained.</p> <p><u>Secondary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades 6 - 12</i></p>





<p><b>Attainment</b></p>		<p><b>Attainment</b> is a research and standards-based curriculum for literacy, mathematics, employability, and transition. It combines blended learning solutions with traditional methods to provide unique learning opportunities.</p> <p><u>Special Services Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: 9-12 Grade High School Credential, Post-Secondary, and Transitional Students with Disabilities</i></p>
<p><b>BookFlix</b></p>		<p><b>Bookflix</b> is an online literacy resource that pairs classic video storybooks from Weston Woods with related nonfiction eBooks to reinforce reading skills and introduce children to a world of knowledge and exploration.</p> <p><u>Elementary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades PreK-3</i></p>
<p><b>DeltaMath</b></p>		<p><b>DeltaMath</b> is an online resource which allows students to practice problems covering topics from middle school math (6th – 8th), Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, and Computer Science. It allows teachers to combine modules of lessons to create high-leverage assignments for their students to complete at their own pace and track their learning. Teachers can mix and match problem-sets, control rigor, vary due dates, create tests and problems of their own.</p> <p><u>Secondary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Algebra I (CP and Honors), Foundations in Algebra, and Intermediate Algebra</i></p>

<p><b>Discovery Education</b></p>		<p><b>Discovery Education</b> is a K-12 resource available to all subject area teachers with text, video, audio, and interactive resources that are standard aligned and can be directly assigned to students in the classroom. Teachers can build, share, or find pre-made lessons or activities and assign these to students directly through the Discovery platform. Teachers can use Discovery to personalize learning opportunities for students. This resource can be used as a whole class, small group, or individual resource to meet the needs of all learners.</p> <p>This resource includes the opportunity for students to participate in virtual field trips offered throughout the year and for teachers to find new strategies to use in the classroom.</p> <p><u><i>Elementary and Secondary Resources</i></u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades K – 12</i></p>
<p><b>Dreambox</b></p>		<p><b>DreamBox Learning</b> is an interactive, adaptive, self-paced program that provides engaging activities for students to learn and practice skills in mathematics. It delivers "learning units" where students learn <i>and</i> practice important mathematical concepts with an emphasis on conceptual understanding and algebraic thinking.</p> <p>Students are required to complete 5 lessons per week with proficiency.</p> <p><u><i>Elementary Resource</i></u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades K – 5</i></p>
<p><b>Edgenuity</b></p>		<p><b>Edgenuity</b> provides online and blended learning solutions including online courses, credit recovery, intervention, test preparation, and more.</p> <p><u><i>Secondary Resource</i></u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades 6-12</i></p>




<p><b>ExploreLearning Gizmos</b></p>		<p><b>Gizmos</b> is aligned by indicator in secondary science district curriculum documents. Teachers should plan personalized blended lessons that incorporate this resource to meet varying needs of students. It can be used for whole classes, small group, or individual instruction. Teachers can edit resources provided to meet their students' needs.</p> <p><u>Secondary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades 6-12</i></p>
<p><b>Flocabulary</b></p>		<p><b>Flocabulary</b> is a K-12 ELA, math, science, and social studies resource aligned by indicator in district social studies curriculum documents. Teachers should plan personalized blended lessons that incorporate this resource to meet the varying needs of students. It can be used for whole classes, small group, or individual instruction. Teachers can adapt the resources provided to meet the needs of their students.</p> <p><u>Elementary and Secondary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades K-12</i></p>
<p><b>Follett Destiny</b></p>		<p><b>Follett Destiny</b> provides K-12 schools with the ability to manage their library resources and media assets. <p><b>Goalbook Toolkit</b></p>		<p><b>Goalbook Toolkit</b> guides educators to vary the levels of instructional support in the areas of ELA, Math, and SEL. It supports designing learning goals and instructional plans that respond to the diverse ways students learn and their individual needs.</p> <p><u>Special Services Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Teachers of PK-12 Students with Disabilities</i></p>



<p><b>i-Ready</b></p>		<p><b>i-Ready</b> is an online program for reading and/or mathematics that helps teachers determine student needs, personalize their learning, and monitor progress.</p> <p><u>Special Services Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: K-12 Students with Disabilities</i></p>
<p><b>IXL Learning ELA</b></p>		<p><b>IXL Learning ELA</b> provides students with personalized plans for individual interventions through explicit and systematic reading instruction that results in confident readers. IXL uses insights from student work within the platform and Real-Time Diagnostic to generate personalized guidance for each learner. These personalized action plans seamlessly link students to the skills that will help them build on their knowledge and remediate gaps in understanding.</p> <p><u>Secondary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Identified Students Grades 6-12</i></p> <p><i>Placement Criteria:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>STAR reading percentile ranking (PR) at Urgent Intervention band (below 10) and the lower end of the Intervention band (10-24).</i></li> <li>• <i>Performance level of Does Not Meet on the most recent SC Ready ELA and/or a grade of F on the English 2 EOCEP.</i></li> <li>• <i>Historical under-performance in ELA.</i></li> <li>• <i>Consider student attendance to make the best decision to support student needs.</i></li> </ul>

<p><b>Learning A-Z</b>  <b>Reading A-Z</b>  <b>Raz Kids</b>  <b>Science A-Z</b></p>		<p><b>Learning A-Z</b> is a blended learning platform that combines teacher-led whole-class and small-group instruction with technology-enabled resources for personalized reading practice. All resources are accessible online and available in printable, projectable, and digital formats. Within Learning A-Z, there are multiple products such as <i>Reading A-Z</i>, <i>RAZ Kids</i>, <i>Science A-Z</i>, <i>Vocabulary A-Z</i> and <i>Ready Test</i>.</p> <p><b>Reading A-Z and RAZ Kids</b> are referenced in the district curriculum units and should be used daily to support literacy instruction during components of the ELA block. Prekindergarten will use this resource monthly (some will use weekly depending on student needs).</p> <p><u><i>Elementary Resource</i></u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades K-5 ELA</i></p> <p><b>Science A-Z</b></p> <p><u><i>Elementary Resource</i></u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Science</i></p>
<p><b>Lexia Core5</b></p>		<p><b>Lexia Core5</b> is a research-proven program that provides explicit, systematic, personalized learning in the six areas of reading instruction, targeting skill gaps as they emerge, and providing teachers with the data and student-specific resources they need for individual or small-group instruction. Each student has prescribed usage based on his/her personalized learning paths.</p> <p><u><i>Elementary Resource</i></u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: PreK-2 and students grade 3-5 in the bottom quartile</i></p>

<p><b>Newsela</b></p>		<p><b>Newsela</b> is an Instruction Content Platform that brings together engaging, accessible content with integrated assessments and insights to supercharge reading engagement and learning in every subject. The content covers topics that are engaging to students and allows teachers to select text sets that are aligned to standards.</p> <p><u>Secondary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades 6-12</i></p>
<p><b>Pathblazer</b></p>		<p><b>Pathblazer</b> is designed to create a unique learning path based on both proficiency and individual learning-objective gaps. Pathblazer provides an initial screener which identifies the approximate level of proficiency for each student. Each student receives a unique learning path and acceleration plan. For reading intervention, a close reading of complex texts with scaffolded supports exposes students to on-grade-level texts.</p> <p><u>Elementary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades K-5</i></p>
<p><b>PowerSchool Professional Learning</b></p>		<p><b>PowerSchool Professional Learning</b> manages district professional development. All professional learning offered by the district (face-to-face, modules, and micro-credentials) is entered into this system. All staff at Richland One are expected to use this system to register for professional learning opportunities.</p> <p><u>Elementary and Secondary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: All district staff (certified and classified)</i></p>
<p><b>Safari Montage</b></p>		<p><b>SAFARI Montage</b> is a K-12 Learning Object Repository, Video Streaming Library, IPTV &amp; Live Media Streaming provider.</p> <p><u>Elementary and Secondary Resource</u></p> <p><i>Target Audience: Grades PreK-12</i></p>



<p><b>Schoology</b></p>		<p><b>Schoology</b> is a learning management system that offers powerful technology to organize content, engage students, and connect families.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teachers may post assignments, messages, and calendar items.</li> <li>• Students and teachers engage in two-way conversations and class discussions.</li> <li>• Teachers can easily share files and links with students, families, and fellow teachers.</li> </ul> <p><u>Elementary and Secondary Resource</u></p> <p>Target Audience: Grades K-12</p>
<p><b>Seesaw</b></p>		<p><b>Seesaw</b> is a platform for student engagement that inspires students of all ages to do their best and save teachers' time. Students document their learning and learn how to use technology.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students use creative tools to take pictures, draw, and record videos to capture learning in a portfolio.</li> <li>• Teachers find or create activities to share with students.</li> <li>• Families can see their child's work and leave comments and encouragement.</li> </ul> <p><u>Early Childhood Resource</u></p> <p>Target Audience: Grades PreK-1</p>
<p><b>TeachingBooks</b></p>		<p><b>TeachingBooks</b> is an online database of thousands of multimedia resources you can use to explore children's and young adult books and their authors. The service includes videos, audio, and online resources to bring books to life.
