## **What is R.E.S.E.T?**

R.E.S.E.T is a short-term, therapeutic program for students in grades K-5 that are experiencing behavioral issues that interfere with their ability to succeed academically and socially.

The goal is to transition students back to their home school with a plan that will aid in decreasing suspensions, reducing the number of students being recommended to the hearing board, and improving their overall academics outcome

R.E.S.E.T uses a positive behavior model with clear and consistent expectations to create a safe learning environment where progress on social and academic goals will occur for all children.

## Referral Process

- Referrals are accepted through the elementary schools' administration.
- If you wish to have your child enrolled in the R.E.S.E.T Program, you will need to first discuss specific concerns with your child's school administrator to determine the appropriateness of the program and to begin the application process.
- The complete R.E.S.E.T Referral Application along with the required documents must be submitted to Ms. Suber and Ms. Vogt before an observation can take place.

## \*Parents

Are an essential part of the R.E.S.E.T Program. It is imperative that we have parental involvement. Parents are expected to:

- Be available by phone while the student is at school

- Be available to pick the student up from the program if he/she is a danger to self or others.
- Be committed to communication daily through the child's folder.
- Be able to participate in weekly sessions and monthly parenting meetings.
- Be willing to follow through and support the suggestions and therapeutic interventions suggested by the R.E.S.E.T staff.
