Performing Arts Scholarships	Performing Arts scholarships are awarded to band and ensemble participants that are selected by the Director of Bands. Performing Arts Scholarship Awards vary. Note: Includes flag line and dancers.		
UNCF Scholarship	The United Negro College Fund is the nation's largest minority education organization. Allen University is one of the 37 UNCF member institutions. UNCF recommends that students applying for any of its scholarships apply also for the UNCF General Scholarship, which requires undergraduate and graduate college students to have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5. The submission of the student profile automatically submits the student for the scholarship. Please visit www.uncf.org today to complete your profile and apply for scholarships.		
Athletic Scholarship	At the discretion of the Athletic Director, head male/female coaches, Allen University awards Athletic Scholarships to impact players on the university's NAIA sports teams. Athletic Scholarship award amounts vary.		
Academic Division Scholarship	Academic division scholarships are awarded by the Dean of Enrollment Management. Students must have a 3.5 or higher GPA. The amount of the scholarship is up to \$3,000.00 for the academic year. This scholarship is non-renewable and the awards may vary.		
Yellow Jacket Scholarship	Yellow Jacket Scholarships are awarded to transfer students who have a 3.0 GPA. The amount of this scholarship is up to \$2,500.00 for the academic year. This scholarship is non-renewable and the awards may vary.		
International Scholarship	International scholarships are awarded to international students who have a 3.5 or higher GPA. The amount of this scholarship is up to \$5,000.00 and is awarded by the Dean of Enrollment Management to ten (10) international students per academic year. This scholarship is non-renewable and the awards may vary.

State Scholarships & Grants

Palmetto Fellows Scholarship

Annual value: up to \$6,700 for the first year

You are eligible to apply for this state-awarded scholarship, worth up to \$6,700 for the first year and up to \$7,500 for the next three years, if you are an S.C. high school student with exemplary academic credentials. For more information, contact your high school guidance counselor or the S.C. Commission on Higher Education.

LIFE Scholarship

Annual value: up to \$7,500

The Legislative Incentives for Future Excellence (LIFE) Scholarship is a state-awarded scholarship valued at \$5,000 to \$7,500 per year. If you meet two of the following three requirements, you are eligible for this scholarship:

- 1) your final, cumulative grade point average is at least a "B" (3.00); 2) your SAT score is at least 1100 on critical reading and math sections combined (ACT composite score of at least 24); or 3) you graduate in the top 30 percent of your class

HOPE Scholarship

Annual value: \$2,800

The S.C. HOPE scholarship is state-awarded and valued at \$2,800 for the freshman year only. If your final, cumulative GPA is at least a "B" (3.00) and you do not qualify for a Palmetto Fellows or LIFE scholarship, you are eligible to receive this scholarship.

South Carolina Tuition Grant

Up to \$3,600 per academic year (\$1,800 per semester for 8 semesters only)

Student must meet one of the three requirements:

- Graduate in the top 75% of high school class or
- SAT score of at least 900 (Math and Critical Reading sections only) or ACT score of at least 19 Composite or
- Final high school GPA of 2.7 or higher on the SC UGP

*The amount of the Grant is determined yearly by the SC State Legislators.
