As a parent or guardian you are responsible for ensuring that your child attends school either in person or virtually every day that school is in session.



Attendance

Richland One schools are recording absences for all students for both in person and virtual learning. Attendance will be taken daily by teachers.



Expectations

Students are expected to be present either in person or virtually when class begins. Parents are expected to contact teachers if there is any problem preventing the student from participating in class.



In-Person

Students are expected to attend school in person every day during face to face learning phases. Students will be notified of their assigned days to attend school during the hybrid learning model.



e-Learning

During e-learning, students are expected to log in and be present for entire class sessions. Your child will be provided breaks but will be expected to return after each break.



Absences

If your child is unable to attend class, your child will be marked absent, and a written excuse must be provided to your child's teacher/school within 48 hours of their return to class.



Computer Problems

If your child has a problem with their computer, internet or hot spot and is unable to log on for class, you must immediately report the problem. Your child will be given up to 5 days to complete an alternate assignment in order to receive credit for the day.
