Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a safe, supportive, and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the state's student academic achievement standards as follows:

Encouraging faculty and staff to integrate a blended learning environment which will require students to demonstrate their ability to explain, apply, and interpret knowledge learned in a variety of ways through the use of technology. The faculty is dedicated, hard-working, and committed to the success of each student.

Instruction will also encompass: Visual and hands-on strategies, reading comprehension strategies, Bloom's Taxonomy, Webb's Depth of Knowledge, multiple response strategies, students actively engaged in lessons, support ESL students in the mainstream classroom, collaboration with mainstream teachers, planning, reflection, co-teaching, professional learning communities, and technology integration.

The school keeps parents informed of the progress of their children through the use of PowerSchool Parent Portal, student agendas, phone calls, email, interim reports, and conferences.

The school invites parents to attend Parent-Teacher conferences on an as needed basis in addition to the two district-mandated conferences each school year.

Parents are free to discuss their children's academic and behavioral concerns at the end of the school day or at a time convenient for teachers and parents.

Parents have the opportunity to volunteer contingent upon district approval. Parents are encouraged to attend all school-related events.

Arden Elementary School families will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- *Monitoring attendance/truancy*
- *Ensuring that children arrive to school on time and are picked up in a timely manner*
- *Making sure that homework is completed.*
- *Monitoring the amount of television my child watches*
- *Upon district approval, volunteering in my child's school*
- *Participating in decisions relating to my children's education (i.e. IEP, MTSS, Retention meetings, etc.)*
- *Promoting positive use of my child's extra-curricular time at home (i.e. sports, dance, chorus, arts & crafts, etc.)*
- *Staying informed about my child's education and communicating with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district either received by my child, by mail, email, school district auto dial, and responding, as appropriate.*
