## Parent and Family Engagement Policy

*Logan Elementary School's Title I school-wide program encourages each parent to be engaged in their child's education.*

Logan Elementary's Title I Planning Team, made up of parents, community members, teachers, support staff, administration and Richland One personnel, worked together to develop the Parent and Family Engagement Policy based on ideals the Logan Elementary Community believe will best meet the needs of all Leopards. It is distributed to parents and families during the Annual Title I meeting, sent home with students, and posted on the school's website. The policy describes the means for carrying out the following Title I parent and family engagement requirements.

To engage parents and families in the Title I program at Logan Elementary, the following practices have been established:

- Logan Elementary School convenes an Annual Title I meeting to inform parents and families about Title I requirements and about the right of parents to be engaged in the Title I program. Parents will be informed of the following:
  - Provisions of Title I which inform parents and families of their rights and ways they can become engaged in the educational process of their child.
  - Federal and state programs that assist in raising the achievement level of all students, and the resources available to the parents, families, and their children within the school-wide Title I Curriculum Plan.
  - Grade-level curriculum and any additional programs.
  - Academic assessments and the proficiency levels and requirements.
  - The school improvement identification under Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).
- The school offers several meetings for parents at different times of the day both on and off campus and/or virtually, and to a practical extent, translates and provides services for those with disabilities.
- Parents are encouraged to provide ongoing feedback through suggestions/comments placed in the feedback box located in the Family Resource Center (or on the school website or through Microsoft Teams) and will receive a response within 5 business days either in writing or through verbal communication.
