SIC Goals and Action Plans

- Notes for SIC from Mr. Hasinger were reviewed
- SIC goals from the SIC Brochure were reviewed
- One goal was to increase parental participation in the EOC survey
- There was discussion regarding the survey – does EOC stand for End of Course or Education Oversight Committee
- Debbie Kinder will follow up with Mr. Hasinger to determine what EOC stands for
- Falicia Harvey suggested that a listing of all surveys be created along with the time they are given.
- The district and school need to make parents aware of survey so they can be completed
- Before action plans are set for the SIC goals more information needs to be shared about surveys
- SIC also needs to see the School Renewal Plan as the SIC goals and School Renewal plan go hand in hand
- The SIC goal(s) should focus on all grade levels not just 11th and 12th grades
- Another SIC goal is to increase the percentage of parents who respond positively to home – school relations.
- There was discussion regarding ways to enhance parental completion of surveys
- One suggestion was to provide incentives for students if their parent(s) complete and return the survey.
- Another suggestion was to create a checklist for parents for upcoming surveys, events
- The Dreher website will also be used to communicate with parents
- The one role of the SIC is to help facilitate communication
- Other points of discussion included parent involvement/engagement and how to measure that
- Forms of measuring this included a teacher log from P/T conference night, another was to create a point system and finally to merge PTO memberships forms
