Learning Activities or Experiences	<p>Listen to your favorite song and imagine what it LOOKS like.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Draw at least FIVE symbols/figures that represent the song and its message throughout your drawing paper.- In the negative space around the symbols draw at least EIGHT different line variations to create various patterns.- Make some of your lines thicker or fill in certain shapes with value (or color) to create contrast and variety.- <i>Your entire 8.5"x11" drawing page should be filled.</i>- <i>Apply values and fully shade throughout. You may also apply any Color Media.</i>- <i>Entire Illustration is to have value/color. No white space.</i> <p>Write the title and artist of the song at the top or bottom of the drawing.</p> <p>Optional: You can include lyrics into your design. (No profanity) You can include collaged elements (cut paper).</p>
