Lesson: Narrative Art

Learning Activities or Experiences	<p><i>Narrative Art tells a story.</i> It uses the power of the visual image to ignite imaginations, evoke emotions and capture universal cultural truths and aspirations. What distinguishes Narrative Art from other genres is its ability to narrate a story across diverse cultures, preserving it for future generations.</p> <p><u>DUE MAY 18th</u> Answer the questions on the <i>Creating Your Own Story worksheet</i>. (Type answers on Microsoft Word)</p> <p><i>Based on your answers to the questions, make at least THREE thumbnail sketches</i> (small, quick drawings) to explore ideas for your ORIGINAL illustration. You will choose your favorite idea to develop into your final artwork.</p> <p>Consider these questions as you create your sketches:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What is the setting?• What is the time of day?• What is in the foreground, middle-ground and background of the artwork?• What colors/values will you use to tell your story and create a mood?• What emotions do you want the artwork to communicate? How will you show these emotions?

DUE MAY 20th

Read Feedback on your thumbnail sketches on Teams before proceeding to this step.

Based on feedback, make the necessary revisions and draw a **Contour Line Drawing** of your Narrative Art.

This version of the artwork should be fully detailed and neatly drawn.

Use photo images as references at this stage. Poorly drawn figures will detract from your grade!

DUE MAY 22nd

Read Feedback on your Contour Line drawing before proceeding to this step.

Based on feedback, illustrate the final version of your Narrative Art.

Apply values and fully shade throughout. You may also apply any Color Media.

Entire Illustration is to have value/color. No white space.
