Goal for Week: To create your own Photoshop/GIMP tutorial

Main Standard Covered: Depends on what type of tutorial you create

To-Do List:

1. This time, you are going to create your very own Photoshop/GIMP tutorial from scratch. We're going to keep this first one simple.
2. Choose a picture for your tutorial. This will serve as the "Before" picture.
3. Modify the picture using techniques that we have learned in class.
 - a. You can focus on one main topic (i.e. color) or incorporate several topics that we covered (i.e. color, masking, and the healing tools).
 - b. You must incorporate at least 3 steps for this tutorial. Each step needs a screenshot of your progress. You can use the Avatar tutorial that we did as a reference. Just think back to the first three steps of that tutorial. That is basically what you are creating-a 3 step tutorial with screenshots. Very simple.
 - c. You will submit a document with a title, the "Before" picture, the three typed steps (be detailed), a screenshot of each step, and the final "After" picture. You can easily get this done on one page.
