

Good Afternoon,

I hope everyone is doing well and enjoying the extra time with your little ones! Here are several updates:

1. Week 3 packets will be available for pick up at Caughman Road on Tuesday and Wednesday from 9:00-1:00. This will be a drive-thru process. You will remain in your car, and Mrs. Hall will bring the packet to your car for you. **If you are unable to go to school during these hours, please let me know ASAP.**
2. I am strongly recommending that you pick up Week 3 packets as the materials have been printed in color for you. The materials need to be in color in order for the children to complete the work appropriately. If you have access to a color ink printer, you may use the packet online.
3. Office hours are Monday-Friday from 9:30-11:00 and 1:00-2:30. Please reach out to me if you have ANY questions, comments, or concerns. I am here for you!
4. Please continue to sign off on your child's weekly work log. Hold onto all work logs and student work until further notice. All lessons need to be completed each day.

Specific information about Week 3 packets:

1. **Week 3 begins on Tuesday, March 31st.**
2. The Montessori materials printed in color need to be cut out and kept together. I recommend putting them in Ziploc bags, bowls, or cups so that no pieces are lost. I am attaching pictures of how you might want to keep your materials together.
3. Several different writing papers have been included in your packet. Please use whichever paper you see fit for your child's lesson. We wanted to provide options.
4. We have included some of the extension worksheets that we use in the classroom to go along with our Montessori materials. These worksheets are not mandatory, but your child may use them to reinforce the concepts, practice fine motor skills, and review independently once completing the lesson. Some worksheets have been included in the packet that your child may not have used before/had the lesson on. You may still do them with your child or you may omit them.
5. I have attached pictures of how the lesson should look when using the paper materials. They match real lessons in our classroom.
