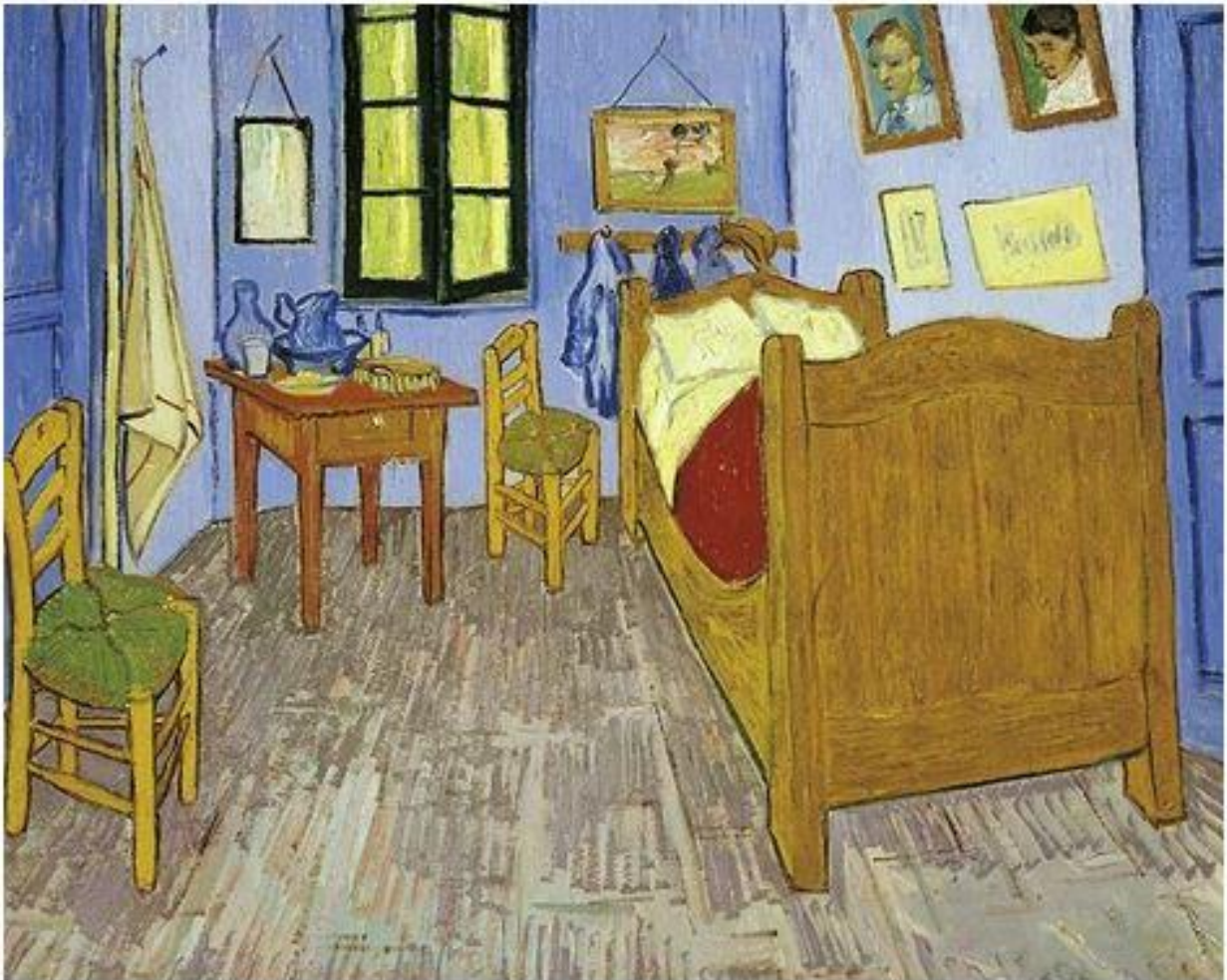


Supporting Document- eLearning Day 1 Visual Art Packet – Kindergarten



In 1888, the Dutch artist Vincent Van Gogh painted *Bedroom in Arles* (pictured above). Study the painting and consider how the artist applied the following three elements of art: line, color, and shape. Next, talk with a family member and discuss the different ways that the artist included lines, colors, and shapes in the artwork. (See the sample below.)
