
• Click "Sign in"





• Type your child's username and click



"Sign in"




#### Microsoft 365

Teams.








• Click on the Teams icon.

• Click on the Class you wish to view.



## Navigating Teams




- 1. **Menu of Teams-** To get back to other teams.
- 2. Current Team- The Class you are currently looking at.
- **3. Chat-** Private chat with teacher.
- 4. **Assignments-** If teacher assigns work through teams, this is one of the places it can be found.
- **5. Calendar-** This is where meetings with the teacher will be found.
- 6. Team Stream- If your student has a question for the teacher that is ok for the whole class to see. This is also for class discussions.
- 7. Tabs- Places that your teacher wants you to easily access (Class text book, Class Notebook, assignments, etc.
