Dear Families,

We would like to welcome you to the 2019-2020 Pre-Kindergarten school year. I am certain with this being your child's first experience with school, there will be many questions about what to expect. So many great things will happen in our class! Our objectives this year are to help prepare your child for kindergarten emotionally, socially, and academically in a positive and nurturing environment.

Class Expectations

On the first day of school, your child will be bringing home a Behavior/Communication Folder. This folder is a way that we can communicate with one another daily. We ask that you sign and return it every day. Please feel free to jot notes as well as any transportation changes in this folder. Students will also have homework this year. The homework folder will come home every Monday. All homework should be returned in the folder every Friday.

Birthdays are very important to young children. Parents may send cupcakes for the class on these days. We will have this treat at lunch. Please do not bring balloons and such. We are not able to have parties.

Our classroom rules are pretty basic and easy to remember.

For safety reasons, please have your child wear sneakers or close-toe shoes to school every day. No flip-flops, crocs, or sandals.

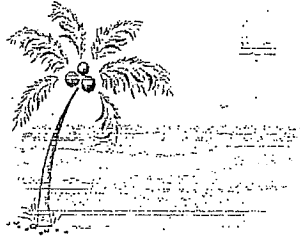

Ride the Wave In To Kindergarten



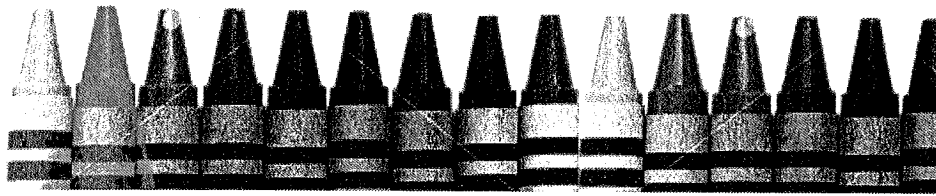
Dear Parents and/or Guardians,

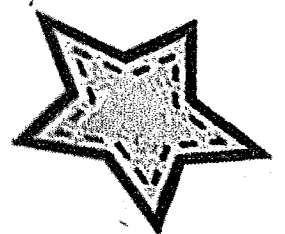

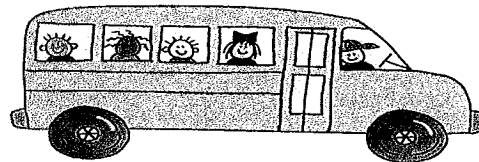

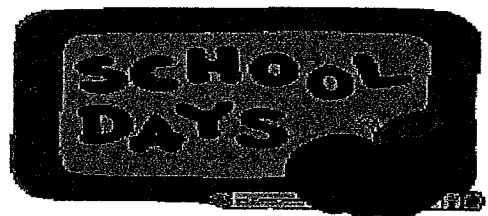

We have created a supply list for your student to start 4th grade prepared. Please make yourself aware of the needs for the grade, so that the expense is not a burden in the beginning of the year.

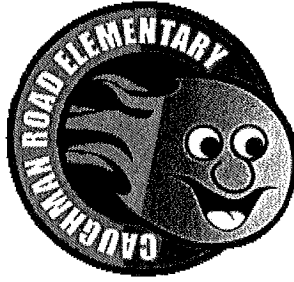
