

Supply list for Mrs. Johnson's Classroom 2019 – 2020

NOTE: Please **DO NOT** label with a name unless specified! Thanks!

ALL STUDENTS:

- ❑ 1 purple **plastic pocket** folder with 3 metal fasteners & inside pockets
 - ❑ Put your child's name on a **post-it note** on the inside front pocket and we will label & number the outside! This will be our daily communication notebook! ☺
- ❑ 1 pencil keeper (pouch/box) with **regular** and/or **mechanical** pencils to bring to and from school daily:
 - ❑ Child is responsible for sharpening and/or replacing lead at home prior to class.
 - ❑ Regular pencils recommended for all 1st level students.
 - ❑ **ALL** pencils must be labeled with the student's name and last initial (in permanent marker).
 - ❑ Students should have 3-5 pencils prepared for daily use.
 - ❑ 1 small personal pencil sharpener (if using pencils that need to be sharpened)
 - ❑ 1 pack of colored pencils (Twistables are recommended/ they are a self-sharpening brand)
- ❑ 2 boxes of Kleenex
- ❑ 1 framed family photo (medium sized – this will be returned at the end of the school year)

Please bring the following according to your child's grade level:

First Level

- ❑ 1 blue plastic pocket folder with fasteners (put your child's name on post it inside & we will label)
- ❑ 1 white binder (1" size 3 ring w/pockets) – this will become a 3 year portfolio (post it with name inside)
 - ❑ 1 package of tabbed dividers for the 3 year portfolio (you can clip these into the binder rings)

Second Level

- ❑ 1 package of disinfecting wipes (like bleach free "Clorox" wipes)

Third Level

- ❑ 1 white binder with clear front cover pocket & inside pockets (1" size)
 - ❑ This will be your SC studies folder! (post it with name inside)

Wish List: The following are optional items but would be greatly appreciated in our classroom:

- ❖ spring mix lettuce seeds for our hydroponic garden
- ❖ set of flameless tea candle lights
- ❖ hanging plant – easy to care for like a pothos plant
- ❖ house plants (easy to care for)
