My child wasn't selected. What do they need to do to qualify? Nothing, the GPAs have already been confirmed. They are from the 6th and 7th grade years. If the child is not on the list then they didn't qualify. (See the question regarding transfers below)

What is the minimum GPA? 3.50, which means a 3.46 does not make the cut.

What is this assignment all about? The assignment is a reflection of the students' qualifications. In years passed we have simply inducted the members based on GPA only.

What if they don't do the assignment? They will not meet the qualifications for induction.

When is the assignment due? It is due at the end of the 3rd nine weeks. The district calendar on Richland One's website has that set as March 22nd, 2019.

Does the assignment need to be typed or handwritten? Typed, Times New Roman 12 pt (Which means they need to make arrangements to print their assignment)

When is the induction ceremony? A date has not been officially been set. When the date is set we will notify the students/parents and put the information on the website as well.

Who do we contact if our child transferred in and might have been overlooked? Contact your counselor, then the counselor should work with Mrs. McDaniels to figure out the child's GPA for their 6th and 7th grade years. Then contact Mr. Davis. They will be added to the list and a letter/assignment will be given to them.
