

2023 AC FLORA PROM INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

Please read all information in this document carefully. This document is meant to serve as a general guide for students wanting to attend Prom. Specific questions should be directed to Ms. Ortner or Ms. Michel. This document should be signed by the student and their parent/guardian, and returned to Ms. Ortner or Ms. Michel no later than Thursday, April 20th. You will not receive an access code to purchase a ticket until you have returned this paperwork.

The Prom, an annual school sponsored event, is a celebration. There is a rich tradition at AC Flora High School for an evening that all attendees enjoy. The guidelines provided support the activities of the evening and the associated positive experience.

There is zero tolerance of alcohol or drugs for those attending. Any attendee found to be either under the influence or in possession of alcohol or drugs is subject to school, district, and law enforcement policies and consequences.

Once attendees enter the Prom they are not permitted to leave and reenter. No loitering is allowed in the parking lot during, before, and/or after the Prom. No smoking (including vaping) is allowed on the premises. Only AC Flora students who have purchased a ticket, completed the necessary paperwork, and can show a current photo ID will be allowed to enter the Prom. Outside guests must be escorted by a Flora student and they also must complete all necessary paperwork before they present both their ticket and a photo ID in order to enter the Prom.

The Prom concludes at 11:00 pm. All attendees are expected to vacate the premises immediately. As a school sponsored event, the Prom comes under the auspices of all AC Flora High School, Richland School District One, and local law enforcement regulations, policies, and laws. Please anticipate enforcement of all these.

Attendance at Prom is a choice, not a requirement. Your choice to attend indicates that you fully understand and are fully aware of the inherent risks of infection from the COVID-19 virus and pandemic, among other communicable diseases, in all public spaces. Your choice to attend also indicates that you fully understand and are fully aware that attendance at Prom may result in an increased risk of exposure to COVID-19.

General AC Flora Prom Guidelines

- Prom is Saturday, April 22nd, 2023 from 8:00-11:00 pm at 701 Whaley.
- Prom is for current members of the AC Flora senior and junior classes.
- A Flora student is permitted to bring one outside guest.
- AC Flora Administration reserves the right to deny **anyone** entrance to the Prom. Richland County Sheriff's Deputies will be patrolling the parking areas and will be inside the Prom for the entire evening. Please do not do anything before, during, or after Prom that would cause you to be suspended, expelled, or arrested!
- ALL students must present a current, official picture ID along with their electronic/mobile ticket at the door. Acceptable forms of ID include a CURRENT School ID, driver's license, military ID, etc.
- There will be no at-the-door ticket sales, and ticket prices cannot be discounted. Tickets must be purchased by publicized deadlines. Purchase of a ticket does not guarantee entry into Prom. **Students must be in**

good disciplinary standing, correctly fill out and return all required paperwork, and bring proper identification.

- AC Flora students are responsible for their behavior and choices surrounding Prom. All school/district policies and procedures are in effect and will be enforced.

AC Flora Prom FAQ's

When is prom?

Prom is Saturday, April 22nd, 2023 at 8:00 pm. Prom will end at 11:00 pm.

Where is prom?

Prom will be at 701 Whaley. Students should carefully follow all posted signs regarding allowable parking. Parking lot space is very limited. Street parking is allowed on Catawba and Wayne Streets, but not on Whaley Street.

Where/when can I buy tickets?

Tickets may be purchased online ONLY via the link on the AC Flora website. This link will ask you to enter an access code. You will receive an access code when you turn in your paperwork. Each access code is only good for the purchase of one ticket. There will be no ticket sales at the door. You must purchase your ticket no later than Friday, April 21st at 11:59 pm.

How much are tickets?

Prom tickets cost \$40 per person.

Who can attend prom?

AC Flora juniors and seniors. Seniors and juniors also have the option to bring one outside guest. All students must submit all required paperwork by Thursday Apr. 20th in order to attend. In order to be admitted, all attendees must also bring a current photo ID when they display their electronic ticket.

Are tickets refundable?

We are unable to refund the cost of any ticket for any reason. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.
