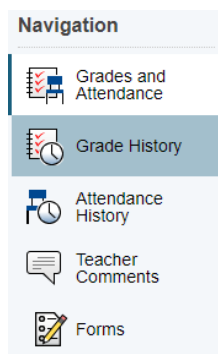

Accessing the PowerSchool Parent Portal:

1. Visit the PowerSchool Parent Portal at <https://richland1sc.powerschool.com/public/home.html>
2. Log in using your unique username and password. If you have forgotten your login information or need assistance, please contact the database specialist at your child's school.
3. Once logged in, you will be able to view and download your child's report card.
 - a. Once you are logged into your Parent Portal account, click on **Grade History**, under the **Navigation** menu.



- If you are accessing the PowerSchool Parent Portal through a browser on a mobile device, you may need to click the vertical arrow located in the top left corner below the student's name for this menu to pop out.



- b. On the **Grade History** page, the student's grade history will be displayed.
