Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your child is eligible to participate in the After-school Comprehensive Remediation Program (CRP). The purpose of the program is to provide academic assistance to identified students.

This program will be provided free of charge at Hopkins Middle School. After school instruction will focus on individual student deficiencies and student progress will be shared with you each marking period. **The program will start September 14, 2021 and will operate three days weekly: Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday (except on early dismissal days) from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm. Our Saturday Academy option will be offered later in the school year.** The program will not operate for (3) intersessions (Thanksgiving, Winter, and Spring Breaks), and it tentatively ends Thursday, April 28, 2022. Transportation and a dinner meal will be provided. Car riders are to be picked up at 6:00 pm in the car loop. Parents who are excessively late for pick up can result in dismissal of their students from the program.

We believe the After-school Comprehensive Remediation Program will be the most effective way to improve your child's academic performance. Therefore, it is essential that your child attend daily. In order to offer all children an effective instructional program, early dismissals are discouraged. Additionally, all students are expected to follow the rules as outlined in the *Richland District One Student Code of Conduct* booklet. Failure to comply with these attendance and discipline policies will result in your child's dismissal from the program.

Please complete the attached registration and bus transportation request forms and return to school by Thursday, September 2, 2021. Spaces are limited so students will be waitlisted if all CRP openings have been filled.
