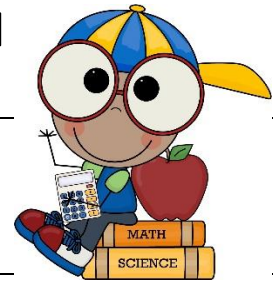

Child Development

- 2 (10 packs) of broad tip CRAYOLA™ brand classic markers
- 1 black composition notebook
- 2 packs of black, fine tip EXPO™ dry erase markers
- 1 box of Ziploc™ bags (any size)
- 2 large boxes of tissue
- 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 large tub of Clorox Wipes™
- 1 REGULAR size towel or small blanket
- 1 regular size book bag
- 2 pairs of headphones (no ear buds)

Kindergarten

First Grade

The following supplies will **remain at school**:

- 1 pack of Expo™ Dry-Erase markers
- 4 boxes of CRAYOLA™ crayons (24 count)
- 2 boxes of CRAYOLA™ colored pencils (24 count)
- 3 large boxes of Kleenex™
- 24 small glue sticks (Elmer™)
- 6 MEAD™ composition notebooks (no spiral, hardcover, wide-ruled), in red, blue, yellow, green, purple, orange, or black
- 6 MEAD™ pocket folders with prongs (red, green, blue, yellow, purple, orange)
- 2 packages of sheet protectors 25 or 50 count
- 2 12oz bottles of antibacterial hand sanitizer (not soap!)
- 2 container of disinfectant wipes
- 2 packs of large PaperMate™ Pearl Pink rectangular erasers (6 count)
- 3 boxes of Ticonderoga™ #2 pencils (12 count)
- 3 boxes **each** of Ziploc™ plastic bags: gallon, quart, snack and 2-gallon sizes.
- 1 pair of headphones (no ear buds) (compatible with Apple iPad) (NOTE: Students are responsible for having an operative pair of headphones all year long, for school use only)

Fourth Grade

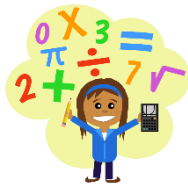
- 6 black and white composition books (wide ruled/no spirals)

- 1 box of 2 gallon Ziploc™ plastic freezer bags
- 4 boxes of tissue
- 3 bottles of hand sanitizer (12oz. or larger)
- 1 pencil pouch (cloth, that will fit in a binder)
- 2 boxes of crayons - 16 count or 24 count
- 4 packages of #2 pencils (**no mechanical** pencils)

SCHOOL DRESS CODE

GIRLS:

Yellow or White - blouses (Long or short sleeves)
Navy blue/khaki - jumpers, skirts, shorts, or slacks

(long or short sleeves)
Navy blue/khaki - trousers or shorts
Navy blue - cardigan sweater

STUDENTS NOT IN UNIFORM MUST BE DRESSED APPROPRIATELY (Mandatory)

Clothing should not distract or disrupt the educational process. This includes but is not limited to:

- **Shirt-tails & blouses tucked-in.**
- **No bagging/sagging pants** (pants should be belted at the waist)
- **No bare midriffs, halter tops, backless tops, blouse/shirts with spaghetti straps, tanks tops, see through shirts or blouses, lingerie/sleepwear or sleep caps, muscle shirts, short shorts, mini-skirts, excessively tight and form fitting clothes** (e.g. spandex clothing, leggings, stretch pants and biker shorts. Jeggings are allowed if worn with a long skirt or long tunic blouse that is not form fitting).
- **No lewd or suggestive language/symbols on clothing.**
- **No clothing worn as gang colors or in gang styles will be allowed.**
- **No slogans/pictures depicting violence or sexual innuendo will be allowed.**
- **No outer shirts should be removed at school.**
- **No hats and/or sunglasses are to be worn inside the building.**

The school administration reserves the right to determine when clothing does not meet the school standards: When a problem is identified, parents will be notified to bring more appropriate clothing to the school. If parents cannot be reached, or are not available to come in, the school may provide something for the students to wear temporarily.
