Your child is eligible to participate in the Comprehensive Remediation After-school Program. The purpose of the program is to provide extra academic assistance to identified students in all content areas.

This program will be provided free of charge at St. Andrews Middle School. After school instruction will focus on individual student deficiencies and student progress will be shared with you each marking period.
