Dear Parent/Guardians,

All students failing one course or more, will have the opportunity to recover up to two courses during our Summer Credit Recovery Program. The Eau Claire High School Summer Credit Recovery Program will be at Keenan High School this summer. Students will use Edgenuity, which is a software-based program designed to help students successfully receive unit credit(s) for courses they have previously failed. A certified teacher will support students with additional instruction and monitor their progress as they work through a self-paced, individualized program. There are two options for registration: An online registration link/QR code will be open on May 20 - 28 (will close at 11:59pm) and there will be onsite registration on May 30 from 8:30am-12:00pm and 1:00pm-3:30pm in the ECHS Library. The program will start June 5, 2024, and end on June 28th, 2024. Attached is some additional information for you to look over. Rules for Receiving Credit

Students must have earned 50 to a 59 in their class to participate in the Richland One Credit Recovery Summer Program. Students who attend and complete their class will receive a “P” for Passing, if requirements are not met a “NP” for Not Passing will be given. Credit received will not change a student’s GPA. The original failing grade will remain on the student’s report card and transcript.

Summer School Registration

There are two options for registration: An online registration link/QR code will be open on May 20 – 29 (will close at 11:59pm) and there will be onsite registration on June 3 and 4 from 8:30am–12:00pm and 1:00pm–3:30pm in the ECHS Guidance Department.
