## ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

Please note that the state of South Carolina and Richland One have mandated that attendance be given a high priority. Attendance and truancy procedures will be strictly enforced.

### Reasons for excused absences include:

Contagious illness, doctor or dental appointment, serious illness, death in the family or illness, school sponsored field trips, and recognized religious holidays.

Any other reasons for requesting an excused absence must be submitted in writing to the principal in advance of the absences and should address the serious nature of the request for a student's absence to be excused. **Family vacations should be planned for times when school is not in session.**

Also, parents should limit tardies and early dismissals to no more than 10 per year.
