SCHOOL SAFETY

Thank you, parents, for your continued assistance in promoting a safe and secure learning environment in our school.

As we finish out the school year, please remember that all visitors must sign in and out in the main office. Visitors may need to provide their driver's license when signing in at the main office.

Students who arrive late should be signed in at the main office by a parent.

Students who are being dismissed early must be signed out in the main office. The main office will contact the classroom to call the student for early dismissal.

When having lunch with your child at school, please be mindful of your child's scheduled lunch time so that your child has a smooth transition back to their classroom and does not miss instruction.

Also, students who are car riders may be dropped off in the car line behind the school or at the designated drop off location on Ravenel Street. The car lane behind the school is for drop off only, and students and parents should not walk up the car line. Students who are walkers should enter only at our main entrance area beside the patio.

LIBRARY

All library books are to be returned to the library by May 18. Payment for lost or damaged books must be cash or money order payable to Rosewood Elementary School.



MEDICATION PICKUP

For safety reasons, we do not send medicines home with students. A parent/guardian must pick up the medicines before the end of the school year. If your child's medicine is not picked up by **Friday, June 1**, it must be destroyed. This does not apply to Epipens and inhalers. Please leave those items until the last day of school!

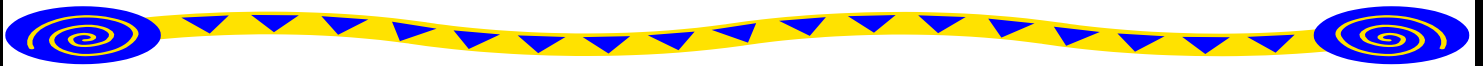
