EMPOWERING THE PARENT/ STUDENT PARTNERSHIP IN DIGITAL LEARNING

Parents, here are some ideas and language that can be used to support your child's digital experience. Ideas are organized to encourage the ongoing use of the 7 Habits language used in our school to empower leadership and foster independence. If your child cannot answer, empower him/her to ask the teacher during class, during academic enrichment, or on Wednesday.

Habits	Ideas	Language
Habit 1 Be Proactive	Discuss with your child the resources or other important information he/she has gathered before he/she starts.	What can you proactively do before you participate in this activity?
Habit 2 Begin with the End in Mind	Encourage your child to share his/her goals and "end in mind" for the work.	What is the "end in mind" for this activity?
Habit 3 Put First Things First	Ensure your child has the right technology (devices, sound, etc.) before he/she begins.	How will this (platform/activity) help you as a learner?
Habit 4 Think Win-Win	Decide on a win-win for both you and your child during the online time.	What will be a win-win for us as you accomplish this activity?
Habit 5 Seek First to Understand, Then to Be Understood	Find out if your child has questions, concerns, or needs before you share your thoughts and ideas.	What did you hear about this (platform/activity) and what do you need your teacher to know? When and how will you share this with your teacher?
Habit 6 Synergize	Ask your child what he/she needs to be successful.	Who can you go to for help or ideas?
Habit 7 Sharpen the Saw	Ensure your child has plenty to eat and drink and has a quiet space that is comfortable for him/her.	Where are you going to sit? What will your breaks look like?
