

All students will take the second round of the STAR assessments beginning December 1st. The assessment gives us a student's reading and math level and helps provide a standards-based intervention plan for academic improvement. Students who score at the reading intervention level in December will be removed from their related arts classes and placed in a reading support class. Please encourage your child to do his/her best on the STAR assessment.
