To be accepted into the dual enrollment program, you must be a high school student and meet placement testing requirements.

There are no "out of pocket" expenses for students and families. The cost of tuition and fees for MTC classes, held on high school campuses, is taken care of by the Lottery Tuition Assistance Program and Richland One.
