ABOUT THE PROGRAM

WHY APPLY?

If you live in a low-food-access area, the GAP program can help. The City of Columbia, in partnership with Instacart, brings you accessible online grocery delivery*. If you are eligible, you could get food and home goods delivered without delivery fees for one year. Apply today!

HOW DOES IT WORK?

We score applicants based on their distance from a grocery store after verifying they qualify for need-based assistance. Points are added for dependents and lack of vehicle ownership. The higher the score, the sooner you could be benefiting from this service.



ELIGIBILITY

If you live over 1 mile from a grocery store and are eligible for need-based assistance, this program is for you.



SUPPORT

Parks and Recreation staff will verify eligibility, assist with applications, and provide technical assistance, if needed.



SIGN-UP

Visit the designated Parks and Recreation facility for your district or go to columbiasc.gov to apply online.

Note: This is a pilot program, and spaces are limited.

*Participants will receive a complimentary Instacart+ membership for unlimited free grocery delivery for orders over \$35 and a monthly \$5 stipend to assist with service fees.
