Dear Graduates,

Here are your updates for graduation on Thursday, June 2nd at 8:00 a.m. at the Lower Richland Football Stadium:

All graduates are required to have the 2022 robe, cap, tassel and diploma cover. The basic package starts at \$60 (cap, gown, tassel, and diploma cover). Expenses for these items are to be paid directly to Jostens and final balances must be paid by May 13th. Students cannot participate in graduation if they have a Jostens balance. <http://www.jostens.com>

All graduates need to be dressed accordingly to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Females- Black shoes (sandals, closed toe flat, open toe flat, or low wedge) any color dress, as long as it is not visible under your robe. If you are wearing pants, they must be black or navy.

Males- Black, or dark colored shoes. Black or navy blue pants, and a collared shirt if preferred.

Do not add anything to the gown that was not issued by the school.

YOU WILL NOT WALK ACROSS THE STAGE IF YOU ARE NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH GRADUATION ITEMS

Graduation Practice – Tuesday, May 31st – Wednesday, June 1, 2022 at 8:00 a.m. in the arena. Students must attend in order to participate. Students will be given 8 tickets at the end of practice on June 1st. Every person who enters the stadium will need a ticket regardless of age. Names will be called for pronunciation, seat assignments, ticket distribution, etc.

Ceremony Start Time- Graduating students and their parents **must arrive** 30-45 minutes before the ceremony starts for seating purposes. The gates will close 10 minutes before the ceremony begins. The ceremony will begin on time. No guests or graduates will be admitted once the ceremony begins.

Security Measures- The District's clear bag policy is in effect. Balloons, signs, or any other paraphernalia are not allowed in the stadium.
