Three Year Old Class

- ___ 1 roll of paper towels (select a size)

- ___ 1 container of foaming hand soap
- ___ 2 containers of alcohol wipes
- ___ 1 roll of paper towels (select a size)
- ___ 1 Blue plastic pocket folder

Five Year Old Class

- ___ 2 boxes of tissues
- ___ 2 containers of Lysol wipes
- ___ 1 primary composition journal (Staples has them)
- ___ 1 red plastic pocket folder
- ___ 1 roll of paper towels (select a size)
- ___ 1 can of Lysol spray

In addition, please send the following personal items on your child's **first day of school**:

- 👜 A complete change of clothes in a labeled zip lock bag (**underwear**, socks, and an additional outfit that won't be missed) and a water bottle that is **leak-proof** and that **your child can open/close**.
- 👜 A **PLAIN white canvas tote bag** (all students). These bags are available in the craft section of most stores. Bags should be large enough to hold a regular notebook. (We will decorate them) **Please do not** send a regular book bag or bag on wheels. Our cubbies cannot accommodate large items)
- 👜 If eating a packed lunch from home **PLEASE** make sure it is a healthy option and that your child can **open/close** all container, bottles, bags, etc.

In order to provide daily nutritious snacks for our students, parents will be assigned 2 specific snack weeks throughout the year. Snacks will be for the entire class (approximately 20 students) to share. (**If COVID protocol allows)
