In addition, please send the following personal items on your child's **first day of school:**

-  A complete change of clothes in a labeled zip lock bag (**underwear**, socks, and an additional outfit that won't be missed) and a water bottle that is **leak-proof** and that **your child can open/close**.
-  A **PLAIN white canvas tote bag** (all students). These bags are available in the craft section of most stores. Bags should be large enough to hold a regular notebook. (We will decorate them) **Please do not** send a regular book bag or bag on wheels. Our cubbies cannot accommodate large items)
-  If eating a packed lunch from home **PLEASE** make sure it is a healthy option and that your child can **open/close** all container, bottles, bags, etc.

If you think your child will need a morning snack please send 1 item each day that is healthy and can be easily opened by your child. i.e.-snack size bags of fruits, veges., goldfish, etc. or a simple fruit bar. Please keep in mind they can eat a snack after doing two lessons in the morning.
